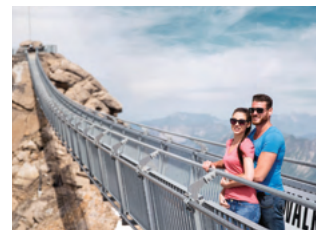

DAY 1

HOME ► ZAGREB

Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport for your flight to **Zagreb** – the capital of **Croatia**.

DAY 2

ZAGREB

Meals on Board, Dinner

Upon arrival, transfer to **Zagreb** and start off with a guided walking tour of the Upper and Lower Town – catch a glimpse of top attractions like **King Tomislav Square**, the **Stone Gate**, **St. Mark's Square** and **St. Mark's Church**, the **Strossmayer Promenade**, **Zagreb Cathedral**, **Ban Jelacic Square** and **Dolac Market**. Enjoy the rest of the day free at leisure to do some souvenir shopping or simply bask in the lively street atmosphere of the city.

DAY 3

ZAGREB ► SARAJEVO

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner – Beef Sahan
Journey to Bosnia and Herzegovina and head for its capital, Sarajevo. Enjoy a walking tour of the city's Old Town – stroll past the **Emperor's Mosque**, the largest mosque in the Balkans; the **Eternal Flame** and the



Sarajevo Roses that are scattered throughout the city. Visit **Sarajevo Tunnel**, also known as the Tunnel of Hope, which was an underground tunnel constructed during the Siege of Sarajevo during the Bosnian War. Then travel to Mostar, a picturesque city spanning a deep valley of the Neretva River.

DAY 4

SARAJEVO ► MOSTAR ► DUBROVNIK

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Proceed to **Mostar** today, where you will follow your tour guide to the magnificent **Old Bridge** for an extraordinary panorama over the river. Bask in the lively atmosphere of the **Old Bazaar**, which winds along one of the oldest parts of Mostar. Next, continue to **Blagaj** to admire the beautiful Dervish monastery of **Blagaj Tekija** that's nearly 600 years old. Thereafter, travel to Dubrovnik, the Pearl of the Adriatic. Starting from **Pile Gate**, walk along the elegant **Stradun Street** and soak up the buzzing atmosphere. Stroll past **Onofrio Fountain** for a look at the Romanesque-Gothic architecture of the Franciscan Monastery. Wander along the limestone-clad promenade until you reach the beautiful Renaissance-era **Sponza**

Palace, which houses the state archives. Other highlights you'll come across include the **City Bell Tower**, **Orlando's Column**, and the **Church of St. Blaise**, which is dedicated to the patron saint of Dubrovnik.

DAY 5

DUBROVNIK

Breakfast

Enjoy a free day of leisure for some shopping or sightseeing at your pleasure in **Dubrovnik**. You may wish to embark on an optional half-day tour of **Montenegro Blue**. Surrounded by high mountains reflected in the blue waters, the fjord-shaped Bay of Kotor is one of the most spectacular landscapes on the Mediterranean. Drive along the bay past **Risan** and the picturesque Perast to reach the UNESCO World Heritage Site.

DAY 6

DUBROVNIK ► SPLIT ► ZADAR

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Wander through the Croatian countryside to wind up in **Split**, a town on Croatia's Dalmatian Coast that was founded by Emperor

Diocletian in AD 305 to construct his retirement palace. Tour this seaside city with a guide, who will bring you to enter the massive **Diocletian's Palace** and explore all its nooks and crannies, including the remains of the original palace, and the **Peristil Square**. Visit Stella Croatica, a family-run traditional estate, as you learn more about olive oil production and its different varieties as well as the local ingredients and Mediterranean delicacies. Then continue to **Zadar**, a city built in the centre of the Croatian Adriatic that's steeped in three thousand years of tumultuous history. Embark on a guided promenade of the city and visit the **Western Quay** for an close-up look at the **Sea Organ** and the Monument to the Sun, followed by **St. Donatus' Church**, the **Roman Forum**, **St. Anastasia's Cathedral**, **St. Mary's Church**, and the **Lion's Gate**.

DAY 7

ZADAR ► PLITVICE ► ISTRIA

Breakfast, Lunch - Roasted Suckling Pig, Dinner

A drive through the Croatian highlands reveals the splendid alpine scenery as you arrive in one of Europe's most impressive national

parks – the **Plitvice Lakes National Park**. Take pleasure in a guided tour of the beautiful landscapes within the UNESCO National Heritage Park, adorned with sixteen lakes that are interconnected by a series of waterfalls and deep woodland populated by deer, bears, wolves, boars, and rare bird species. Savour the riveting beauty of nature from a different perspective on the waters as you join an **Electric Boat Ride**.

Note: In the event of bad weather conditions where the boat ride is unable to proceed, there will be no replacement activity.

DAY 8 ISTRIA ► MOTOVUN ► POSTOJNA CAVE ► LJUBLJANA

Breakfast, Truffles & Risotto Lunch, Chinese Dinner

After breakfast, journey to the Istrian peninsula, a region in northwest Croatia. Set off on a walking tour into the forest, accompanied by well-trained truffle dogs and their owners, to hunt for underground Istrian treasure – the elusive **truffle**, before doing some **truffle tasting**. Next, move on to **Motovun** for a walking tour in the **medieval old town**. Perched on a steep 277-meter-high hill, you'll see a magnificent view over the hilly landscape of Istria, and main

attractions like the **historic town walls** and **medieval alleys**. After which, journey to Postojna and embark on a unique cave tour of the renowned **Postojna Cave** – one of the world's largest karst monuments. Board the unique **Electric Train** for an exciting adventure through dark passages to the Great Mountain, where you will disembark and continue foot across the **Russian Bridge** into the caves comprising of the Spaghetti Hall, the White Hall, and the Red Hall. Press on further to view the renowned stalagmites in the Brilliant Passage and get a look at the **Vivarium Proteus**, otherwise known as the human fish. Finally, head to the capital of **Slovenia, Ljubljana**.

DAY 9 LJUBLJANA ► BLED ► LJUBLJANA

Breakfast, Lunch in Bled Castle with Bled Cream Cake, Dinner



After breakfast, make a photo stop at the stunning **Lake Bled**. This alpine lake holds the only island in Slovenia in its centre and is noted to be a world-renowned paradise for centuries. Next, you may wish to join an optional excursion to visit Lake Bohinj, the largest glacial lake in Slovenia. Visit Bled Castle, which overlooks the lake, and enjoy a delicious local lunch there. Continue to **Ljubljana** and embark on a guided tour of the **Old Town** for some of the best-preserved medieval houses, visit the open-air **Central Market**, the baroque **Town Hall**, the stunning **Robba Fountain**, and the grandiose **Triple Bridge** and **Dragon Bridge**. Last on our schedule is to undergo the requisite Covid-19 test together as a group.

DAY 10 LJUBLJANA ► ZAGREB

Breakfast, Meals on Board

Make a pit-stop at the **McArthurGlen Designer Outlet** for some last-minute shopping before proceeding to the airport for your flight home.

HOME ▶ PRAGUE

Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport and depart for **Prague**, the capital of the Czech Republic.

DAY 2

PRAGUE

Dinner – Charles Bridge Restaurant

Once you arrive, begin with walking tour of the city nicknamed the '**City of a Hundred Spires**'. Get an up-close look at the famous **Prague Castle** and the state's spiritual symbol **St. Vitus Cathedral**, the best-preserved Romanesque church **St. George's Basilica** and the **Old Royal Palace**. Cross the iconic **Charles Bridge** and proceed to the **Old Town** for a glimpse of the **Astronomical Clock**, one of the greatest treasures of the city. Then head towards the last stop of the day: **Wenceslas Square**, the vibrant social and commercial centre of Prague. Enjoy a delightful welcome Czech cuisine at the restaurant set in a stunning location right beside Charles Bridge, where you 'll get a spectacular view overlooking the Charles Bridge.

DAY 3 PRAGUE

Breakfast

Enjoy a free day of leisure for some shopping or sightseeing at your pleasure. You may wish to embark on an excursion to the UNESCO-listed town of Cesky Krumlov. Travel through the scenic Bohemian countryside to arrive in the medieval town. See the church of St. Vitus, the historic town center and the Cesky Krumlov Castle, dating back to 1240.

Optional: Cesky Krumlov

DAY 4 PRAGUE ► DRESDEN ► BERLIN

Breakfast, Dinner-Pork Knuckle with Beer

Enroute, stop at **Dresden** along the way to enjoy art treasures, architectural sights and alluring landscape. Explore the city on foot for a tour of the **Church of Our Lady**, **Semper Opera House**, the **Zwinger** and the **Saxon Wall**. Continue to historic **Berlin**, whose once-turbulent history has shaped its rebirth as the charismatic capital of Germany. Enjoy city guided tour for an exploration of 'East meets West' and delve into the story behind their

reunification. See the imposing **Brandenburg Gate**, **Unter den Linden** and the **Reichstag** building, with its famous glass dome. See the site of **Checkpoint Charlie** and touch a remaining section of the **Berlin Wall** to learn more about Berlin's WWII and Cold War past.

DAY 5 BERLIN ► KRAKÓW

Breakfast, Polish Dinner

Today, cross into **Poland** to arrive at the enchanting city of **Krakow**. A leisurely walk through the beautiful streets of Krakow and visit the **Royal Castle** and Cathedral on Wawel Hill, recognised as the most historically and culturally significant site in Poland. Continue through the **Old Town** with a view of the **St. Mary's Church** and the medieval masterpiece of the **Cloth Hall**.

DAY 6 KRAKÓW

Breakfast

Take a trip out of town to the infamous **Auschwitz Concentration Camp** for a historical tour. Formerly Nazi Germany's concentration

camp, its main purpose was to carry out the extermination of Jews through forced and demanding labour, mass executions, and human experiments. In 1979, Auschwitz was recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and in 2007, UNESCO named it as 'Auschwitz Birkenau German Nazi Concentration and Extermination Camp (1940-1945)'.

Note: In the event we are unable to visit Auschwitz Concentration Camp, we will reimburse each pax with S\$80 EU Voucher.

DAY 7 KRAKÓW ► DONOVALY ► BUDAPEST

Breakfast, Dinner – Roasted Duck with Hungarian Folk Show + Wine

This morning, visit to the renowned **Wieliczka Salt Mine**, UNESCO World Heritage-listed site just outside Krakow and marvel at the unique sculptures and setting of this 800-year-old salt mine. See chambers, chapels and even salt chandeliers as you follow the guide 135 m (440 ft) underground.

Afterwards, cross over the border into **Slovakia** and travel through **Donovaly**, going past the **Tatra Mountains**. Carry on to **Budapest**, the capital of Hungary. Enjoy a sumptuous dinner with wine tonight while being entertained by a **Hungarian Folk Show**.

DAY 8 BUDAPEST

Breakfast, Dinner - Halászbástya Restaurant

Get to know the true culture of **Budapest**, also known as the 'City of Baths' through a guided city tour that will help you pack as much as possible into your exploration of the city. The first stop of the tour is the renowned **Matthias Church**, one of the oldest buildings in Budapest with over 700 years of history and frescoes created by famous Hungarian painters. Next, head up to **Gellért Hill** for some of the best. Continue on to **Fisherman's Bastion** for a view of the beautiful turrets, see the impressive **Heroes' Square** and the Millennium Monument located in its middle, and stroll along the

Step foot into the renowned **Schönbrunn Palace** and revel in the stunning interior of the massive 1,441-room baroque complex – think white porcelain tile stoves, exquisite bohemian crystal chandeliers and white-lacquered ceilings and walls covered in gold leaf ornamentation. Next, continue to the glorious **Ringstrasse** with its wealth of parks and monuments, the **State Opera House**, the majestic **Reichsrat Parliament Building** and

Rathaus and the **Hofburg Imperial Palace**. End the tour with a visit to one of the most important Gothic structures in Austria – **St. Stephen's Cathedral**.

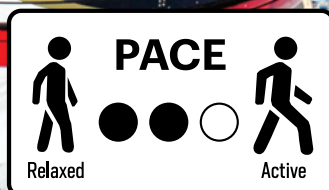

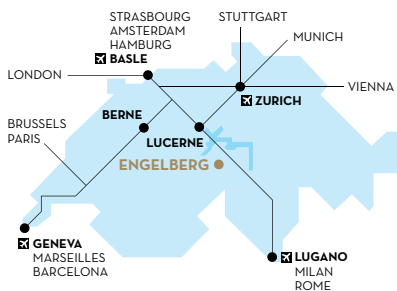

Breakfast, Lunch (3-course meal on train)

Get set for an incredible ride onboard the **Glacier Express** – the world's most famous panorama train. The ride travels across the Alps and connects fashionable Zermatt at the foot of the Matterhorn with the equally sophisticated St. Moritz. On the 8-hour journey through the mountainous Cantons of Valais, Uri and Grisons, the train dives through 91 tunnels and chugs across 291 bridges. 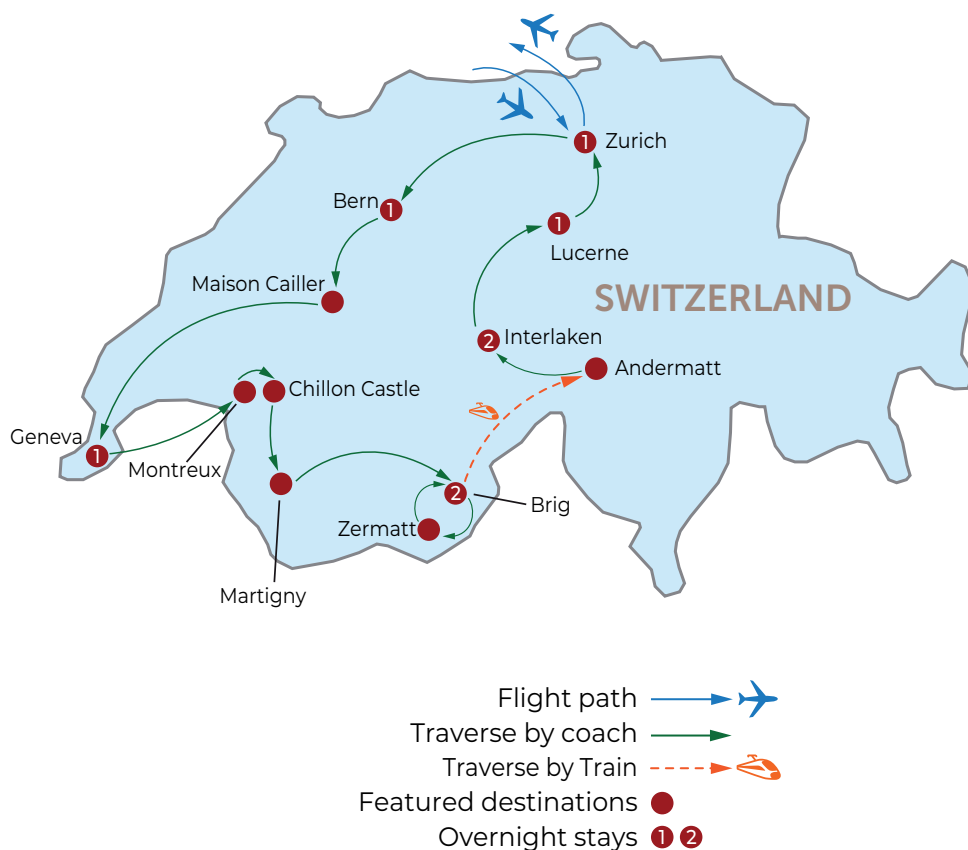

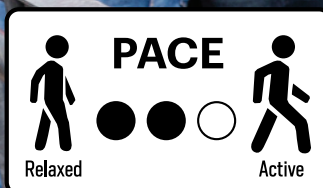

the **Stockholm City Hall**. The three crowns perched atop the 106-metre-tall tower forms a silhouette that is instantly recognizable within the city. This romantic structure also hosts the prestigious Noble Prize banquets in its Blue and Golden Halls, with the latter featuring 18 million gold mosaic tiles. Continue to the **Old Town** to view the magnificent structures of the **Cathedral** and the **Royal Palace**. We will also visit the **Vasa Museum**, located in the Vasa ship which capsized and sank in Stockholm in 1628. After 333 years on the sea bed the mighty warship was salvaged and is now the world's only preserved 17th century ship and the most visited museum in Scandinavia. If time permits, you can consider an optional visit to the Drottningholm Palace, one of the Sweden's Royal Palaces, which is situated on the island Lovon.

DAY 3

STOCKHOLM ▶ KARLSTAD ▶ HARMAR

Breakfast, Dinner

Today depart for **Karlstad**, a city on the Klarälven River in Varmland Country, Sweden. It's known for the neighbouring Lake Vanern to the south. The **Old Stonebridge** is the country's longest Stonebridge and one of Karlstad's most photographed locations. We will then cross the border to **Sweden** and arrive at Harmar for the night.

DAY 4

HARMAR ▶ GEIRANGERFJORD ▶ GEIRANGER

Breakfast, Dinner

Drive along **Ornevegen** ("the Eagle Road"), name given to the steepest part of the road up the mountainside from Geiranger to **Eidsdal**, 620 metres above sea level. Here, the road twists through eleven hairpin bends as it climbs up to **Stigrora**, 858 metres above sea level. The road is carved into the mountain and supported by stone walls. An impressive bridge carries the road across the **Stigfossen waterfall**. On this road, even the bravest can feel the adrenaline pumping through

their veins. The **Trollstigen platform** and two viewpoints are designed by Reiulf Ramstad Architects. From the top, well protected against the elements by steel and glass, you can see all the way down the mountainside. The structure is designed so that it blends in with the surroundings. Some parts are carved into the rock, whilst other parts are built on the stone walls. We will then take a **scenic sightseeing cruise** across the deep blue waters of this UNESCO World Heritage Site, **Geirangerfjord**. The fjord offers archetypal scenery, encircled by high mountains, where abandoned farms cling to the hillslides. The trip between Geiranger and **Hellesylt** takes in the **Knivsfla Waterfalls**, known as the Seven Sisters and Friaren (the Suitor). You will also sail close to the **Brudesloret (Bridal Veil) falls**. Along the Geirangerfjord, you will experience the very best of Norwegian nature, close up. Transfer to Geiranger for a night stay by the fjords.

Note: Trollstigen platform will only be available subject to road conditions.

DAY 5

GEIRANGER ▶ SOGNEFJORD

Breakfast, Dinner

In the morning, consider an optional

excursion to take the Briksdal Troll Car at Briksdal which takes you to the stand about 700m away from the glacier. You will have a nice walk to the glacier, into the Jostedal Glacier national park, before the troll car takes you back to starting point again. Enroute to Sognefjord, make a photostop at the **Kaupanger Stave Church**, which has been in continuous use for more than 800 years, making it a great example of local culture, history and heritage. Upon arriving at the **Sognefjord** region, you will embark on a **2-hour sightseeing cruise** within **Cudvangen and Flam** on the pristine waters of Nærøfjord and prepare to be blown away by the spectacular vistas displayed before your very eyes. **Nærøfjord**, is the world's narrowest fjord and is included in the UNESCO World Heritage List. Transfer to Sognefjord for an overnight stay.

DAY 6

SOGNEFJORD ▶ BERGEN

Breakfast, Dinner

Today consider an optional train ride by the Flam Railway, and embark on the most incredible train journey where you will be treated to endless panoramas of placid rivers, deep ravines, cascading waterfalls, and mountain farms clinging

precipitously to snow-capped peaks. Then travel to **Bergen**, a large Norwegian city with a small-town charm. Your exploration begins with a Bergen city tour- soak up the sights and sounds of the bustling **Fish Market** in the heart of the city; wander along the narrow alleyways and step into the smorgasbord of shops and galleries in **Bryggen**; then take the **Ulriken cable car** to the highest of Bergen's seven mountains and enjoy the spectacular scenery and mountain terrain above the city streets. From the summit, you can enjoy magnificent views of Bergen and the surrounding area - the sea, the islands, fjords and mountains.

DAY 7 BERGEN ▶ HARDANGERFJORD ▶ GOL

Breakfast, Dinner

We will move on today to the **Hardangerfjord** region, the second longest fjord in Norway. The **Hardangerfjord** is 179km long and greatest depth is 900 metres. The definition of a fjord is a long, narrow inlet from the sea with steep sides or cliffs, created by glacial erosion during the ice ages. We will then make a photo-stop at **Steinsdalsfossen**, which has a fall of

50m and is special because you can walk safe and dry behind it. The fall occurred in 1699 when the river changed course and there is a footpath to and from as well as under the waterfall. We will then pass by the Hardanger Bridge and make a stop at **Voringfossen**, the 83rd highest waterfall in Norway for a photo before continuing to Gol for the night.

DAY 8 GOL ▶ OSLO ▶ OVERNIGHT CRUISE

Breakfast, Dinner

Make our way to **Oslo**, capital of **Norway** and begin your exploration of the city by visiting the **City Hall** that is covered with a rainbow of motifs depicting the Norwegian history, culture and lifestyle, as well as the neo-classical structure of the **Royal Palace**. Last but not least, the **Vigeland Sculpture Park** is one attraction worth seeing, the life's work of sculptor Gustav Vigeland that features more than 200 life-sized sculptor in bronze, granite and cast iron. After which, we will take an overnight cruise to **Copenhagen**, the capital of **Denmark**.

DAY 9

OVERNIGHT CRUISE ▶ COPENHAGEN

Breakfast, Dinner

Arrive at the lovely city of Copenhagen and go on a city tour to take in the sights of the famous amusement park **Tivoli Gardens**, the **City Hall Square**, **Hans Christian Andersen Statue**, and **Christiansborg Palace**. Stop by **The Little Mermaid sculpture**, which was inspired from the fairytale and the mystical **Gefion Fountain**. If traffic conditions are fair, we will make an additional pit stop at **Nyhavn** for some picturesque photos.

DAY 10

COPENHAGEN ▶ HOME

Enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure till it is the time to transfer to the airport for your flight home.

Today, you will also have the chance to see the **Diamond Beach**. This beach is called Diamond Beach because of

the ice-chunks. Polished by the sea, they look like ice-diamonds. Our last stop will be **Svartifoss Waterfall**. Svartifoss is one of the most incredible and glorious waterfalls in Iceland - its name literally means 'the Black Waterfall'. Svartifoss means black falls because the waterfall is surrounded by dark lava columns.

DAY 4 SOUTH COAST ▶ VIK

Breakfast, Dinner

Drive towards **Vik**, a picturesque town located on the most southern point of Iceland. The road to this place is a story for itself, from volcanic beaches to glacier and incredible stone formations. The city is located on a **beach of black sand**. You will have the opportunity to enjoy a stroll along the black sandy shores of **Reynisfjara Beach** and see the magic of nature in the form of its famous basalt columns that stacks up into the shape of a pyramid. Consider an optional to the Sólheimajökull glacier, where you can embark on a glacier hike where an experienced guide will start off with a safety briefing and a short lesson on how to utilise crampons and an ice pick.

DAY 5 VIK ▶ SOUTH SHORE ▶ SELFOSS

Breakfast, Dinner

This morning, we will make our way to **Skogafoss waterfall**, one of the biggest waterfalls in the country. Due to the amount of spray the waterfall consistently produces, a single or double rainbow is normally visible on sunny days. Finally, head on a scenic drive with a view of Iceland's natural beauty and stop at the unique **Seljalandsfoss waterfall**, a narrow cascade plunging over a 60-metre high cliff. You may even venture on the footpath leading to the back of the waterfall for a different perspective and equally breath-taking pictures. After which, we will visit a farm where you can enjoy **Horse Show**, featuring the Icelandic Horses! These horses are a unique breed of smallish horses that came to Iceland with the first settlers from Norway 1100 years ago. Our last stop will be the **Secret Lagoon Hot Spring**. The Secret Lagoon is a natural thermal pool, the steam rising into the air gives the place a surreal and mystical feel. You will have some time to enjoy in this Secret Lagoon, a truly enjoyable way to end the day with a warm relaxing nature bath.

DAY 6 SELFOSS ▶ GOLDEN CIRCLE ▶ HUSAFALL

Breakfast, Dinner

Embark on Iceland's classic **sightseeing tour - the Golden Circle Tour** - to discover some of the most spectacular scenery and historic sites in Iceland. The first stop will be at **Thingvellir National Park**, a place of historical significance and geological interest. You can also visit the **Althing**, an open-air assembly in the park where Iceland's oldest existing parliament first assembled in 930 AD. Next, admire Iceland's most popular waterfall, the **Gullfoss**, and if you're lucky, you might even be able to catch sight of a rainbow arching over the tumbling waters flowing into the deep gorge. Continue on to the nearby geothermal area, a site bubbling with activity and an abundance of hot springs. Here, you will be able to view the lively **Strokkur geyser** which spouts water 30 metres into the air every 15 minutes. Tonight, we will drive towards West Iceland and into Husafell.

Depart for the **Langjökull glacier**, Iceland's second largest glacier. Board a **monster truck** for a once in a lifetime adventure deep inside one of the world's largest man made **ice caverns**. The caverns are composed of an extensive system of tunnels and chambers that stretch close to 300 metres into the solid ice cap towards a breath taking natural ice cave at the heart of the glacier. Then we will proceed to Europe's most powerful geothermal area, **Deildartunguhver**, for a photo stop. Tonight, we will make our way back to the Reykjavik city.

Enjoy a free day at leisure, shopping, sightseeing and exploring the city. You may consider an optional trip to the Snaefellsnes Peninsula where you enjoy a journey up close to the volcanic Snæfellsjökull glacier and visit spectacular places in the surrounding National Park, like Kirkjufell church-shaped mountain with Kirkjufellsfoss waterfall, Gerðuberg basalt columns, bird cliffs at Arnarstapi and view of Snæfellsjökull volcano glacier. If not, there are also many other day tours and activities that you can join depending on what you will like.

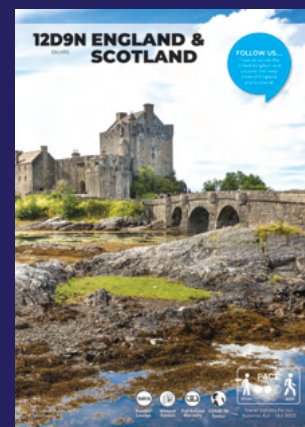
