#### DAY 1

### HOME ▶ ANTANANARIVO

Assemble at the airport and depart for **Antananarivo**, the capital of Madagascar.

#### DAY 2

### ANTANANARIVO

*Meals on board, Dinner*

Upon arrival at the Kilimajaro Airport, you will be greeted and transferred to a city hotel for lunch. Thereafter enjoy a brief tour of Arusha enroute to hotel for check in and rest for the day.

#### DAY 3

### ANTANANARIVO ▶ MORONDAVA ▶ KIRINDY

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

After an early breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to the west of Madagascar, **Morondava**. Upon arrival, make your way to **Kirindy** on a 4WD vehicle, passing through some villages and the Baobabs Avenue. Arrive at the **Kirindy Forest Reserve**, a private reserve that protects one of the last remaining dry deciduous forests of Madagascar. Besides being able to spot the giant jumping rat, lemurs, reptiles and birds, it is also the best place in the whole island to encounter Madagascar's largest predator – the fossa.

#### DAY 4

### KIRINDY ▶ BELO SUR TSIRIBIHINA ▶ BEKOPAKA

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

Seize the opportunity to go on an early walk into the reserve for a short exploration before you leave for **Bekopaka**. Make a

transfer to Tsimafana to board a local ferry and cross the **Tsiribihina River**. Continue on your drive through the small town of **Belon'i Tsiribihina**, bypassing dry plains of bushes, palma and baobab trees. Cross the **Manambolo River** via a small local ferry to reach **Bekopaka**.

#### DAY 5

### BEKOPAKA

*Breakfast, Picnic Lunch, Dinner*

Start off the day with a visit to the **Tsingy de Bemaraha**, a spectacular mineral forest listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. The 'tsingy' limestone peaks are one of the most impressive landscapes in Madagascar, an intricate network of rifts, crevasses, and limestone blocks carved into sharp needles. Spend the afternoon free at leisure to explore on your own. You may wish to join an optional trip to visit the little **Tsingy**, which includes a pirogue ride up the river gorge to see the subterranean caves and other tombs of Sakalava.

Note: Involves 4-5hrs of trekking according to your physical condition.

#### DAY 6

### BEKOPAKA ▶ BELO SUR TSIRIBIHINA ▶ MORONDAVA

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

After breakfast, head back to **Morondava** via the same route as Day 4. Make a stop at the romantic **Baobab Amoureux** – two trees intertwined together in a lovely embrace, before proceeding to the iconic **Avenue of the Baobabs**. Admire the beautiful scenery as the sun sets, embracing the giant centennial trees in its warm orange glow.

## DAY 7 MORONDAVA (FREE DAY)

*Breakfast, Dinner*

Enjoy a free day at leisure exploring the sleepy town of **Morondava**, right in the middle of nowhere, forgotten and crushed under blazing sun. Here, you'll find a sort of quiet calm that pervades its streets, even the local market gives off a pretty laidback atmosphere. You may also visit the nearby fishing village Betania, where you can relax on the beach and watch the fishermen returning to shore with their catch for the day.

## DAY 8 MORONDAVA ▶ ANTSIRABE

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

It is a long scenic drive today as you are driven to the ancient colonial town of **Antsirabe**. On the way with a stop in **Miandrivazo** for lunch. Once you arrive,

go on a "pousse-pousse" (rickshaw) ride to explore the quaint little town, bringing you to the heart of the city to see its beautiful garden, elegant railway station and the old post office.

## DAY 9 ANTSIRABE ▶ ANDASIBE

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

The day starts with a drive to **Andasibe**, passing through staggering landscapes dotted with abundant rice paddies, chimney-less long clay red houses and thousands of roadside markets displaying a variety of handicrafts – all this against a glorious backdrop of golden grasslands and granite inselbergs. Along the way, stop by the **Reserve Peyrieras Madagascar Exotic**, located in a beautiful valley between a mango and lychee plantation. You will get to see different types of reptiles such as

chameleons, iguanas, geckos, frogs and many more. Thereafter, continue on to **Andasibe** for your night's stay.

## DAY 10 ANDASIBE ▶ ANTANANARIVO

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

Embark on an exploration of the **Analamazaotra Special Reserve**, known as the most accessible and famous rainforest and the shelter of the lemur Indri-Indri, found only in this part of the island. The reserve is also home to 12 others diurnal and nocturnal lemur species, large chameleons, and the rarely seen blue coua (bird). In the late afternoon, you will be heading back to Antananarivo.

## DAY 11 ANTANANARIVO ▶ DEPARTURE

*Breakfast, Meals on board*

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

## DAY 12 HOME SWEET HOME

# Going to Madagascar

## Island of the Lemurs

*The rugged island's signature animal might be the lemur, but there are many more amazing creatures to encounter, not to mention an incredible diversity that makes Madagascar so wonderfully unique.*

Located off the south-eastern coast of Africa, the world's fourth-largest island is renowned for its biodiversity and concentration of endemic species – close to 90% of the flora and fauna can only be found in Madagascar and nowhere else! Teeming with fascinating wildlife, vivid landscapes and a colourful kaleidoscope of local Malagasy culture and cuisine, Madagascar is undoubtedly a fascinating destination where your inner adventurer can be set free to explore.



### Key Attractions

#### Avenue of the Baobabs

Majestic and spellbinding, the dirt road that links Morondova and Belon'i Tsiribihina is home to a stunning spectacle of nature, featuring dozens of magnificent Baobab trees. Lined along both sides of the road, these ancient Baobabs are a lonely reminder of what used to be a dense tropical forest. Come at sunset and you'll be treated to an arresting sight – towering, murky silhouettes framed against a backdrop of purplish-orange glow.

#### Tsingy de Bemaraha National Park

Painstakingly shaped by time and the elements, the Tsingy de Bemaraha National Park comprises of two impressive karst plateaus reminiscent of an otherworldly landscape, covered with countless razor-sharp limestone spires and pinnacles. Labelled by the locals as 'tsingy' – an apt moniker that loosely translates as 'where one cannot walk barefoot', these jagged peaks were largely inaccessible until the 1990s when a network of aerial suspension bridges were set up.

### Best Time to Go

The best time to travel to Madagascar is between May to October, when temperatures are cool and pleasant. These months also coincide with Madagascar's dry season, where precipitation is at its lowest. Do bring warm clothes as winter nights in the central parts of Madagascar can get pretty cold – temperatures may fall to as low as 5°C!

### Health and Food Safety

Travellers are recommended to get anti-malaria medication as well as bring a good mosquito repellent to protect themselves from malaria. Visitors who have been to a yellow fever country will also need to carry proof of vaccination against yellow fever with them. Also, avoid consuming raw vegetables and do not drink from unstamped bottles of water.




#### Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport and depart for **Windhoek**, Namibia's capital.

This drive includes waterhole visits and park exploration, ending with a view of the sunset at one of their spectacular viewpoints before proceeding for dinner.

### DAY 4 ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK





## DAY 6

### SWAKOPMUND ▶ WALVIS BAY ▶ SWAKOPMUND

*Breakfast, Lunch, Seafood Dinner*

Your morning starts with a drive to **Walvis Bay**, where you'll embark on a **boat cruise** which offers plenty of marine life sightings, such as seals, pelicans and dolphins. Cruise to **Pelican Point**, home to a large colony of Cape fur seals and its landmark lighthouse. As you make your return to the waterfront, enjoy some fresh oysters paired with sparkling wine, savoury snacks and desserts. After which, proceed on a **Sandwich Harbour excursion** in a 4x4 vehicle, which will take you through scenic landscapes and if you're lucky, chance encounters with Namibian wildlife like antelopes, jackals and flamingos. En route, you'll get to enjoy the breathtaking landscape unique to the area, especially the south of Walvis Bay where huge sand dunes of the desert meet the rolling waves of the Atlantic Ocean. Thereafter, travel back to **Swakopmund** for a seafood feast before getting some rest.

## DAY 7

### SWAKOPMUND ▶ SOSSUSVLEI

*Breakfast, Lunch, Hotel Dinner*

Today, rise early and seize the chance to join an optional 1-hour quad bike tour racing in the dunes around Swakopmund and Walvis Bay. Then, depart Swakopmund for the Namib Desert, the gateway to the world-famous **Sossusvlei**, making a photo stop along the way at the **Tropic of Capricorn Crossing**, one of the five major circles of latitude. Drive through **Kuiseb**

**Pass**, one of the highest roads of Namibia that crosses the rugged **Kuiseb Canyon** and runs along the border of Namib-Naukluft Park between Solitaire and Walvis Bay. Once you arrive, have your dinner at the lodge and rest for the night.

## DAY 8

### SOSSUSVLEI

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

Visit the **Dead Vlei**, where you will find clay pans covered in a crust of salt-rich sand, surrounded by burnt orange and red soaring dunes. The scene set before your very eyes here is considered as one of the most stunning desert landscapes in Africa. Make a stop at **Dune 45**, likely to be the most photographed sand dune in Namibia. An optional climb to the top will reward you with views that are worthy of the effort. Next, stop by the **Sesriem Canyon**, a natural gorge carved out by the Tsauchab River. Enjoy a brief break as you stop for lunch at a lodge in Sossusvlei, before heading on an enchanting sundowner drive through the iconic red sand dunes of Namib Desert. End the day with a unique dinner right in the heart of the Namib Desert.

## DAY 9

### SOSSUSVLEI ▶ WINDHOEK

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

Depart for **Windhoek**, the capital city of Namibia. Take a city tour to view some of its better-known attractions, which include the **Christ Church, Tintenpalast, Parliament Gardens** and train station. Conclude your wonderful exploration of Namibia with a splendid dinner at Joe's Beerhouse.

## DAY 10

### WINDHOEK ▶ HOME

*Breakfast, Meals on Board*

Relax in the morning before transferring to the airport for your return flight home.

If one is looking for a different kind of excitement, the treacherous paths and rocky roads to the canyons might be more your

cup of tea. Indulge your dare-devil nature as you tiptoe extremely close to the edges of the Sesriem Canyon, where you will be presented with sheer thrilling views right below your feet.



### DAY 4 LAKE MANYARA ▶ MTO WA MBU ▶ NGORONGORO

## DAY 5 NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA ▶ SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

*Breakfast, Picnic Lunch, Dinner*

Today, we descend some 610 metres into the crater, which is home to an abundance of wildlife and a photogenic paradise, for a full day of game-viewing drive with picnic lunch. **Ngorongoro Crater**, the largest intact caldera in the world teams with an abundance of wildlife permanently resident on the crater floor. Prides of lions, herds of Cape buffalo, impala, Thompson gazelles, rhino, giraffes, golden & black-backed jackal, zebra, cheetah, leopard and the spotted hyena freely roam on the crater floor plains. Late afternoon, you will proceed to **Serengeti National Park**, one the best game parks in Tanzania. Enjoy enroute game viewing drive to the lodge for your next two consecutive nights.

## DAY 6 SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

*Breakfast, Picnic Lunch, Dinner*


Depart with picnic lunch boxes for a full day of game viewing drives on the vast Serengeti plains. Covering an area of 14,763 square kilometres, the world-famous **Serengeti National Park** is Tanzania's oldest

park, and one of the world's last great wildlife refuges. It is rated as one of the world's most spectacular natural events - every year over a million wildebeest, zebra and antelope migrate clockwise around the Serengeti-Masai Mara ecosystem, taking in two different countries and making time for birthing, courting and mating on the way. These move in an annual pattern which is predictable. After whole day game drive return to the lodge for dinner and rest.

## DAY 7 SERENGETI ▶ LAKE VICTORIA

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*


After breakfast, journey towards the south-eastern shores of **Lake Victoria** in Tanzania. Upon arrival check in and the rest of the afternoon is spent at leisure. Speke Bay, aptly named after the famous explorer John Hanning Speke, who, in 1858, discovered Lake Victoria to be the source of the Nile. In the late afternoon you will enjoy a **cruise on the lake**.

**MAASAI MARA (KENYA)**

*Breakfast, Lunch Box, Dinner*

After breakfast, head to the Isebania & Sirari border. Bid farewell to your Tanzania driver-guide as there will be a change of vehicle and guide for Kenya. Continue to **Masai Mara Game Reserve**, it is perhaps the only region left in **Kenya** where the visitor may see animals in the same super-abundance as existed a century ago. Enjoy game viewing en-route to the lodge.

**DAY 9**  
**MAASAI MARA**

*Breakfast, Picnic Lunch, Dinner*

You may consider take a balloon safari for a new perspective over the beautiful landscape at your own expenses. Enjoy breakfast then proceed on a full day of game viewing drives & adventure. Masai Mara is one of the world's top safari destinations, known for

its abundance of big cats – cheetahs, leopards, and lions – as well as the two million wildebeest, Thomson's gazelles, and zebra that migrate annually across the vast grasslands in search of water. The migrations will start around July and ends here in late October. Visit the **Mara River** area, there are at least ten crossing spots on the river alone, where you may be lucky enough to catch this breath-taking spectacle.

**DAY 10**  
**MAASAI MARA ▶ LAKE NAIVASHA**

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

Visit a traditional **Masai Manyatta** and experience the culture of this world famous community. The Masai still live as they did for centuries -interact with these nomadic people and experience their way of life as you learn about their customs and traditions. Thereafter, you will proceed to **Lake Naivasha** take a guided **boat ride**. Dead trees reach up out of the blue water

like grasping hands as a huge assortment of bird life moves about. The waters themselves are home to wallowing hippos, and long the shores, you'll spot Cape Buffalo and other herbivores. A visit to the **Crescent Island Sanctuary** offers a rare chance to literally walk with the animals.

Depart to **Nairobi**, you will be transferred to Carnivore Restaurant for lunch. # The Greatest Show on Earth: Africa's Wildebeest Migration Explained



## July to September:

During August and September, the herds gradually arrive in northern Serengeti, where they face their largest obstacle – the spectacular crossing of the Mara River. Often scenes of great panic and confusion, the fierce torrential waters, steep cliff sides and waiting predators take a heavy toll on the terrified wildebeest as they home in on sanctuary in the north. As these months afford visitors with the best chances to catch a rare glimpse of a dramatic river crossing – and everyone wants to see it – travelling during the peak season will be more expensive and accommodation bookings have to be made as early as one year in advance.



## April to June:


As the heavy rains set in, the huge herds of wildebeest begin their migratory trek up north in search of fresh grazing and the next water source. You'll be greeted by hectic scenes with series of moving columns heading towards Seronera and the western corridor, often times comprising hundreds of thousands of animals, including many zebras and a smattering of Thomson's and Grant's gazelles. The wildebeest migration follows the Mbalageti River to the south side of the Grumeti River, where they congregate in huge numbers before crossing. It's the luck of the draw whether they make it successfully to the other side or end up as a feast for the lurking crocodiles.

TANZANIA - THE GREAT MIGRATION AT SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK



Touted as one of the world's most magnificent wildlife spectacle, the great Serengeti wildebeest migration is an annual affair where vast numbers of white bearded wildebeest (approximately 1.5 million), along with hundreds of thousands of zebras, and smaller numbers of Grant's gazelle, Thomson's gazelle, eland and impala. A treacherous odyssey that takes place all year round, these wild animals trek their way across the massive Serengeti plains of Tanzania to Masai Mara in Kenya in a clockwise pattern. Dictated by the changing seasons and rainfall patterns, the migrating herds traverse almost 3,000 kilometres annually in search of lush grazing grounds and better-quality water sources.


Without a simple start or end point and no way to predict the precise timing of the animals' movement, planning your experience to see the famed wildebeest migration might prove a challenging feat. Now that's where we're here to help – we'll explain the broad patterns of this exciting phenomenon and the best places to view it from!



*October to December:*

In October, most of the wildebeest herds can be found in the Masai Mara, enjoying the remaining grass as they prepare to return back to the Serengeti. The month of November brings cooler weather and early rains to the Serengeti, propelling the wildebeest to begin its migration journey southwards, heading through western Loliondo and the Serengeti National Park's Lobo area. December sees the wildebeest clustered around the fresh grazing of Central Serengeti even as they continue moving further south and east to settle in for the calving season, and thus the entire cycle begins again.

*January to March:*

Witness the circle of life right before your very eyes, as the herds of the wildebeest migration arrive at the Southern grass plains of the Serengeti, around Ndutu and the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, for the calving season. Dispersed across these rich grasslands, the wildebeest produce about 8000 calves a day within a short 3-week window in February, and settle here to feed on the fresh, nutritious grass. This is where you'll also see lots of predator action – the vulnerable calves are easy pickings for the likes of lions, brown hyenas, leopards and wild dogs. When the heavy rains begin approaching in March, the herds start to gather in preparation for the next leg of their epic journey.





#### Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport for your flight **Addis Ababa**, the capital and largest city of **Ethiopia**.

### DAY 2 ADDIS ABABA

#### Lunch, Dinner

On arrival in Addis Ababa, transfer for breakfast before beginning the city tour with a drive up north to **Mount Entoto** for stunning views over the city. Continue visit the **Ethnographic Museum** which contains a large collection of Ethiopian handicrafts and historic artifacts. Next visit the **Trinity Cathedral**, the largest and most revered of all modern churches. After lunch, transfer to hotel check in and rest for the day.

### DAY 3 ADDIS ABABA ▶ LALIBELA

#### Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Head to the airport for your flight to **Lalibela**, the crown jewel of Ethiopia often referred to as 'Africa's Petra'. Tour the


magnificent **Rock-Hewn Churches**, a UNESCO World Heritage site. This group of 11 monolithic churches were carved directly into the stone mountainside at least 800 years ago. This complex boasts the largest monolithic church in the world, a maze of passageways and tunnels, intricately carved reliefs, and fabulous examples of icon paintings. You will see the first groups of churches are **Biete Medhane Alem**, **Bete Maryam**, **Bete Meskel**, **Bete Denagil** and **Beta Golgota**. Last church visit is **Bete Giorgis**, a free standing church with architectural elegance and perfection.

### DAY 4 LALIBELA ▶ ADDIS ABABA ▶ LANGANO

#### Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Catch your flight to Addis Ababa. Upon arrival continue your road to **Langano**. En route visit **Lake Ziway**, the largest of the upper Rift Valley lakes with an area of 400sq km. Its shores are lined with reeds and water lilies, sheltering a variety of water birds, such as flamingo. Proceeding to **Lake Langano**. The lake is the perfect place to relax and enjoy some water activities.

## DAY 5 LANGANO ▶ ARBA MINCH

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

Drive to **Arba Minch**, the largest town in southern Ethiopia. On the way, visit **Chencha Village** home of the Dorze people in the Guge Mountains. The Dorze are known for their tall, beehive-shaped bamboo houses. If the base becomes infested with termites, the entire house can be lifted and moved to another location. Take a leisurely walk around the village, observing daily life and watching the women weave. Continue to your lodge located at **Nechisar National Park**.

## DAY 6 ARBA MINCH ▶ KONSO ▶ TURMI

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

With some of the most dramatic scenery in Africa, **Nechisar National Park** lies at the heart of the Rift Valley, covering Lakes Chamo and Abaya and the mountainous causeway between them known as the 'Bridge of God'. This morning you will enjoy a boat tour on **Lake Chamo**, which is inhabited by a significant number of hippo and giant crocodiles. Leaving Arba Minch, drive to **Konso Village** - a World Heritage listed site of cultural significance. A highland people, the Konso are known for the ancient and intricate terraces that encircle their well-planned villages. Late in the afternoon, you will arrive in **Turmi** and overnight.

## DAY 7 OMO RIVER EXCURSION ▶ DASSANACH & KARO TRIBES

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

After early breakfast, drive to **Omorate** nearby the Omo River and cross the river by local boat. This area is inhabited by the Daasanach (Galeb) people, known for their interesting house design and body painting. Next, you will visit Karo people at the village of **Murulle**, which at the shores of the Omo River. The Karo tribes are mainly known for their special hairstyle and body paintings. Take your time here to discover & experience their lifestyle then late afternoon drive back to Turmi.

## DAY 8 TURMI ▶ KEY AFER ▶ JINKA

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

Drive to **Jinka** and on your way you will visit various villages of the **Tsemay, Ari, and Benna** people. Tsemay are the least known people in this region of Ethiopia and share political and spiritual similarities with the Erbare people. They are farmers who practice flood cultivation of sorghum and maize and rear livestock. Stop at **Key Afer**, there is a colorful market on every Thursday and here you can see different ethnic groups have gathered to barter their goods.

## DAY 9 JINKA ▶ MAGO NATIONAL PARK ▶ ADDIS ABABA

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

Start your morning with an excursion to **Mago National Park**, one of Africa's vast wilderness areas. Visit the **Mursi Village** in the area that lies along the Mago River in the heart of the park. Mursi tribes are well known for their unique lip plates. Women wearing large clay plates into their lower lips to reveal her worth prior to being married. Drive back to Jinka and catch the flight to Addis Ababa.

## DAY 10 ADDIS ABABA ▶ HOME

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

After breakfast, free at own leisure till check out. After lunch, visit to the **National Museum** of Ethiopia, which houses the famous fossil of 'Lucy'. Next, strolling at the largest **Mercator market** (open air) for some last-minute shopping. In the evening, enjoy farewell dinner in one of the traditional Ethiopian restaurants with traditional music and dance from different ethnic groups. Then you will be transferred to airport for your flight home.

For a uniquely African journey positively brimming with fascinating culture, immemorial historical remnants and coffee that is the stuff of legends.



SIMIEN MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK, ETHIOPIA

**E**thiopia, a land that used to be synonymous with famines and drought, has since moved on from its tumultuous past to emerge as Africa's newest travel destination in recent years. Named as the top country to visit in Africa by Lonely Planet, Ethiopia is blessed with historical gems rooted in ancient Orthodox Christianity, beautiful rugged landscapes teeming with endemic wildlife and rich indigenous culture.



THE LAND OF ORIGINS

Believed to be the land of origins, Ethiopia's history dates back to more than 3000 years of empires and kingdoms, among which includes the reign of the legendary Queen of Sheba. Leaving behind a legacy of medieval forts and palaces, the nation has also inherited a wealth of ancient churches and monasteries owing to its deep Orthodox Christian background. Also said to be the birthplace of coffee, Ethiopian coffee is known to be rich and aromatic, paired with an age-old daily ritual of a 'coffee ceremony' that is bound to enthrall your senses.

Physically, Ethiopia is one of Africa's most gorgeous countries and home to incredibly varied landscapes, from the magnificent peaks of the Simien Mountains to the active lava lakes of the Danakil. The country also boasts a vast expanse of lakes and rivers, such as Lake Tana of the Blue Nile and Lake Langano, a popular weekend retreat spot where you can engage in various water activities. Of all the lakes of Rift Valley south, Lake Abijatta may surprise you with a rare visual treat; hundreds of thousands of beautiful pink-hued flamingoes gather here to feed in its shallows, forming one of Africa's greatest ornithological spectacle.

KARO TRIBE

As the second largest populated nation in Africa, Ethiopia has an extremely diverse population with close to 80 different ethnic groups. A fascinating mix of culture and tradition, these small, indigenous communities have proudly retained their ancient customs and way of living, offering us a rarefied initiation into a forgotten world. Admire the beautiful woven patterned masterpieces by the Dorze tribe; be amazed at the elaborate body art and colourful accessories of the Karo people; and try not to be daunted at the sight of the Mursi women wearing huge ceramic plates in their lower lip.

*Be captivated by this region's diverse offerings.*

Located between the Black Sea to the west and the Caspian Sea to the east, Caucasus is occupied by Southern Russia, Georgia, Azerbaijan and Armenia. Besides housing these places, the mountainous area is home to Mount Elbrus, Europe's highest peak. Thanks to its historical highlights and its cultural insights, Caucasus has faced a steady growth of tourism in recent years.

### Lake Sevan

Dubbed "the pearl of Armenian nature", Lake Sevan is located in the north-east of Yerevan in the city of Sevan. The lake is one of the most popular spots in the country as many of the locals come here to cool off in the pristine, blue waters in the hot summer. Apart from its natural attraction, the site is also home to the Sevanavank Monastery or the Black Monastery. Positioned on the northwestern part of the lake, the monastery is a prominent landmark and the perfect example of Armenian architecture.

### Georgia

#### Gergeti Trinity Church

There are no words capable of encapsulating the beauty of the Gergeti Trinity Church. The architectural gem, which is situated in the village of Gergeti at an elevation of 2170 meters, is one of Georgia's most iconic sights. ### Armenia

#### Khor Virap Monastery

The prisoner turned saint played a key role in Armenia's history - it's believed that he was sainted after he cured the ruler, King Tradt III of his illness. This act in turn Christian nation in the world. To this day, his actions still echo through time as many visit this holy site to pay homage to the saint. Besides its interesting history, the site is also steeped in natural beauty. Set against the stunning snow-capped Mount Ararat, the monastery accentuates the beauty of the rugged mountainous terrain surrounding it, caused Armenia to become the first official

### Azerbaijan

#### Maiden Tower

Also known as Giz Galasi, the Maiden Tower is considered the Eiffel tower of the Old City, Baku. The symbolic landmark is much loved in the city of Azerbaijan. Erected at the coast of Caspian Sea, it was included in the UNESCO World Heritage List in 2001. The cylindrical shaped tower stands at 29 metres tall offering rooftop views of Baku Bay, the Old City, the Baku Boulevard and the De Gaulle house. It was built in the 12th century, as part of the walled city of Baku. The Maiden Tower also houses a museum, which exhibits the history of Baku City.

### Holy Trinity Cathedral

A towering sight on the hill of St. Ilya, the Holy Trinity Cathedral is the tallest church in Georgia. Measuring at 101 metres high, its golden dome can be viewed from nearly any point in Tbilisi. Built in 2004, the cathedral, also known as Sameba, consists of nine chapels, among which five are situated underground. Often regarded as a modern symbol of revival, Sameba boasts a distinctive arched exterior with exquisite fretwork, as well as beautiful frescoes created under the supervision of iconic painter Amiran Goglidze.







After lunch, walk along **Via Dolorosa** with its nine **Stations of the Cross** till you arrive at the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre** where Jesus was crucified and buried, and then rose again. Walk past **Temple Mount** to see the **Dome of the Rock**, which is sacred to both Jews and Muslims.

*Note: Temple Mount area is not open to tourists on Friday and Saturday.*

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

After breakfast, visit the **Israel Museum**, which houses the model of the city of Jerusalem as it looked like in 70 AD and the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are found. Drive to **Bethlehem** and visit **Manger Square** as well as the Church of the Nativity where Jesus was born. (*Visit to the Grotto of the Nativity may be skipped, especially during pilgrimage peak season as it may take up to 2-3 hours to enter the cave.*) On the way back to Jerusalem, make a stop at the **Garden Tomb** and drop by the **Mahane Yehuda Market**, a prime place to buy dried produce and local specialty food.

## DAY 8

### JERUSALEM ▶ HAIFA ▶ AKKO ▶ NAZARETH ▶ CANA ▶ TIBERIAS

*Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner*

Depart Jerusalem for **Haifa**. En route, stop for a panoramic view of the **Bahai Gardens** and the golden shrine. Drive towards the Mediterranean Coast to the ancient crusader port city of **Akko**, a fascinating UNESCO World Heritage town with new excavations that date back 1000 years. Highlights of the old city of Acre include the beautifully renovated **Knights' Halls of the Hospitaller Fortress** as well as the fascinating underground tunnels and pathways. After lunch, drive to **Nazareth**, where you'll visit the **Basilica of the Annunciation** in Jesus's hometown. Continue on to **Cana** for a brief stop at the **Wedding Church**, where Jesus changed water into wine. Thereafter, drive to **Tiberias** for an overnight stay.

### Petra, Jordan

Inscribed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1985, Petra once served as the capital of the ancient Nabataean Kingdom. The main attraction of Petra is the Al-Khazna (Treasury), the first of many monuments in the premise that you will see as you make your way out of the Siq – the main entrance that leads to Petra. With an imposing façade that stands 40 meters high, it is the city's most elaborate and iconic monument. The archaeological city was shrouded in obscurity after Saladin's conquest of the Middle East in 1189. After its rediscovery in 1812, by Johann Ludwig Burckhardt, Petra became one of the most spectacular sites in the Middle East. Petra's popularity grew to such an extent that it even caught the attention of Hollywood and was used as a film location for the Steven Spielberg movie, *Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade*.



### Wadi Rum, Jordan

If there's a place on Earth that can depict the barren landscape of the red planet, it would be the Wadi Rum. In fact, it was the film location for the sci-fi movie, *The Martian*. Also known as the Valley of the Moon, Wadi Rum is situated in the south of Jordan and covers an area of 720 square kilometres. The protected area is mainly comprised of craggy, mountainous terrain and a vast, arid landscape that stretches as far as the eye can see. Apart from the Khazali Canyon, which are renowned for their rock inscriptions, other notable points of interest include the deep reddish, brown sand dunes standing against the mountains and the rock formation known as the "Seven Pillars of Wisdom" – soaring rock formations named after the autobiographical accounts of the British soldier, T.E. Lawrence ("*Lawrence of Arabia*").

# Places to See in Your Lifetime

### Dead Sea

Bordered by Jordan to the east and Israel and Palestine to the west, the Dead Sea is mostly comprised of the Jordan River, which flows from the north before finding its way into the lake. Littered with salt deposits along its shoreline, the turquoise blue waters contrast with the surrounding golden-brown landscape. The landlocked lake has the lowest elevation on Earth and the lowest body of water on the surface of the planet. Interestingly enough, it is the deepest hypersaline lake in the world – 420m below sea level. The lake's bottom accumulates high concentrations of sodium chloride, which in turn causes the deep water to "fossilise". Famed for its high salinity and mineral-rich mud, the Dead Sea is known for keeping bathers buoyant – thanks to its high saline levels, and its medicinal properties. Although, the Dead Sea is home to microbial life or microorganisms, which have evolved to survive the harsh conditions of the environment, fishes carried in by the Jordan river and other smaller streams are unable to survive in the hypersaline lake.



### Jerusalem, Israel

Long venerated as a holy city in Judaism, Christianity and Islam, Jerusalem's recorded history spans over 3,000 years. Every year tourists from all over the world flock to visit the sacred and historical sights of this popular destination. Points of interest such as the Stations of the Cross, Garden Tomb and the famous Dome of the Rock, al-Aqsa mosque and the Western Wall encapsulate the rich, yet turbulent history of Jerusalem while resonating on a personal level with religious sects and world religions. Today's Jerusalem still retains much of its past – permeating the atmosphere of the city and lingering in the shadows of its holy sites. Apart from its deeply spiritual significance, modern-day Jerusalem paints itself as a metropolis – complete with restaurants, museums, shopping malls, and cafes.



### Tel Aviv, Israel

Tel Aviv's contemporary and cosmopolitan vibe is a stark contrast to the archaic and timeless Jerusalem in many ways. As the second largest city in Israel, Tel Aviv is relatively more progressive as compared to its Middle Eastern counterparts. 



You and your travelling companions are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following Terms and Conditions. EU Holidays Pte Ltd shall be referred to as "the Company" in the following:

### 1. RESERVATION, DEPOSIT & FULL PAYMENT

- 1.1 If your minimum deposit is less than the required amount, kindly top up the difference within the next two (2) days.

- 2.4 'Working days' refer to Mondays to Fridays, excluding public holidays.

- 2.5 For Free and Easy packages, administrative fees and / or minimum one (1) night hotel rate will be imposed for those travel documents not issued. Upon issuance of travel documents, changes will not be allowed and have no refund value.
- 2.6 For any cancellation of one customer in a twin/double sharing room, the other customer sharing the same room will need to top up an additional single supplement charge, unless the customer who cancelled had paid the full tour fare and taxes as the cancellation fee.

### 3. CANCELLATION BY THE COMPANY

- 3.1 The Company acts as an agent for service suppliers. After deposit or full payment has been made, all arrangements are still subject to final confirmation by service suppliers. At times due to low subscription for a group tour, the Company may choose to cancel the entire tour fourteen (14) days prior to departure.
- 3.2 The Company shall also not be held liable for any contingent costs incurred by the Customer arising from the cancellation.
- 3.3 The Company may recommend alternative tours either to the same destination or other tours, based on the current tour fare of that cancellation period. All prior special discounts given will be not extended for the alternative tours. Should the Customer decide not to accept the alternatives, a full refund on the amount paid by the Customer will be made accordingly by the Company without further obligation or liabilities on the part of the Company and that the Customer shall be deemed to have agreed to release the Company from all liabilities or damages in connection with the cancellation. There shall be no claim for inconvenience, loss of leave and transportation cost due to the cancellation of tour.

### 4. REFUND POLICY

- 4.1 No refunds will be made with respect to accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours or any other services included in the tour fare but not utilised by the Customer, either in part or full, or when the Customer amends, cancels or otherwise changes any arrangements after commencement of the tour.
- 4.2 All refunds will be made within fourteen (14) working days in a form of cheque. For credit card payments, refunds will be made through the credit card company.
- 4.3 Air tickets with refund value will only be refunded to Customers within **fourteen (14) working days** after the respective airlines have refunded to the Company. The standard processing period for air-ticket refunds vary from three (3) to six (6) months (subject to individual airlines). **However, Group and Promotional tickets are non-refundable.**
- 4.4 During peak period, the refund process may be longer due to increase in transactions.

### 5. AMENDMENT TO BOOKINGS (REQUESTED BY PASSENGERS)

- 5.1 For any changes in departure date or tour type, cancellation fees apply as listed under Section 2 on Cancellation by the Customer.
- 5.2 For every request made regardless of whether any previous amendment was confirmed by airlines, hotel or otherwise, there will be a minimum fee of \$250.00 per person per amendment. This does not include any other fees imposed by the airlines, ground operator or hotel.
- 5.3 A postponement of tour by the Customer for any reason is considered as cancellation. Under such circumstances, the above Cancellation Policies will apply accordingly.
- 5.4 Any changes made by the Customer to the existing booking must be in writing or in person at least fourteen (14) days before the tour, after which strictly NO amendments are allowed, or cancellation fee applies.
- 5.5 Any replacement or change of passengers will be considered as a cancellation and not an amendment. This term is applicable to all cases, including but not restricted to medical and pregnancy cases.

### 6. AMENDMENT TO TOUR ITINERARY BY COMPANY

- The Company makes reasonable effort to avoid changes in the itinerary. However, the Company reserves the right to make minor changes at any

time due to unforeseen circumstances, especially during peak periods or in the event of other circumstances beyond our control.

### 7. EXTENSION OF STAY / DEVIATION

- 7.1 Extension of stay may be permitted at the end of tour, subject to the restriction of the air ticket, seat availability and hotel confirmation prior to the commencement of the tour. All requests must be made before issuance of air tickets. If the extension of stay / deviation is unable to be confirmed three (3) weeks prior to the group's departure date, the passenger is deemed to stick to the original tour schedule. In the event that the original schedule has been changed by the Company, any extra cost will be borne by the Customer.
- 7.2 Cancellation fee is also applicable if the Customer cancels the booking because the extension / deviation is unable to be confirmed prior to departure.
- 7.3 Extension of stay / deviation will be at the Customer's own expense and transfer to the airport will not be provided.
- 7.4 It is the Customer's responsibility to hold firm confirmation of their return flight and to re-confirm their flight 72 hours prior to their return date.
- 7.5 The air ticket issued is a special ticket, restricted to the specific airline only. It is non-negotiable, non-endorsable, non-reissuable, non-refundable & non-reroutable. Any alteration in routing or dates by the Customer is solely at his/her own risk. The Company and its associated agents will not be held responsible for any inconvenience caused and extra expenses incurred. No refunds will be made for any unused air ticket, accommodation, meals, or sightseeing in part or full.

### 8. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS, TRAVEL INSURANCE & TRAVEL VOUCHERS

- 8.1 **Passport and other Travel Documents**  
It is the Customer's sole responsibility to ensure that he / she has a valid passport with minimum six (6) months validity from the date of scheduled return to Singapore, as well as the necessary visas, vaccinations, health certificates and all necessary travel documents as required by various government authorities of the destinations of travel.
- 8.2 **Visa**  
The Customer may seek advice from the Company on visa application; however, it is the Customer's own responsibility to obtain a valid visa.
- 8.2.1 If for any reason, application for visa or exit permit is rejected, full refund minus a \$250.00 administrative fee (excluding visa application fees paid to the respective embassies) will be made if the result of the rejection is submitted to the Company at least forty five (45) days prior to departure. If less than forty-five (45) days' notice is given, relevant cancellation fees as stated under the section Cancellation by the Customer will be applied.
- 8.2.2 It is the Customer's responsibility to check that multi-entry Visas have the correct entry dates and destinations before travelling. Please be aware that for some itineraries you may travel through a country without making an overnight stop but you will still require a Visa to enter/exit the country.
- 8.2.3 In consideration of the interests of other passengers in the same group, the Company strongly discourages all passengers from applying for Visa Upon Arrival at the destination country. The Company takes no responsibility for being unable to wait for passengers who apply for Visa Upon Arrival at the Customs.
- 8.2.4 The Company will not be responsible for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of the tour fare if the Customer is deported or refused entry by immigration authorities on the tour for whatever reasons, including improper travel documents, quarantine, custom regulations, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may cause harm or damage to person or property.
- 8.2.5 For non-Singapore passport holders, please request for the Company to check on Visa requirements. The Company renders assistance in Visa application wherever possible. The Company cannot, however, guarantee the approval of Visa applications. This service is subject to (auxiliary) fees. Please check with the Company on the amount.
- 8.3 **Travel Insurance**
- 8.3.1 Arrangement of travel insurance coverage is strongly recommended with respect to unforeseen

- circumstances such as flight cancellation, trip cancellation, loss of deposit, baggage, personal accident, injury, illness, etc. Under no circumstances shall the Company be construed as a carrier under a contract for safe carriage of the Customer or his / her baggage and other personal belongings.
- 8.3.2 The Company shall not be responsible for any loss or damage in relation to flight cancellation, trip cancellation, loss of personal baggage, accidents, injuries and illness.
- 8.3.3 Should there be any amendment to the date and duration of travel, it is the Customer's responsibility to inform the travel insurance company to amend the date and duration of the insurance coverage.
- 8.3.4 The Company will be pleased to assist in the enquiries of any travel insurance and related matters.
- 8.4 **Travel Vouchers**  
The Company issues travel vouchers from time to time as part of its promotional activities. The Terms and Conditions for the redemption of travel vouchers are clearly spelt out in the appropriate documents and shall be binding on the Customer.
9. **GENERAL MATTERS RELATING TO TOURS**
- 9.1 **Accommodation**  
Accommodation is as specified in the tour brochure / itinerary / tour booking form. In the event the specified accommodation is not available, every effort will be made to scout for an alternative in another accommodation of similar standard. Hotel room sizes, facilities and services may vary in different country. Accommodation for adults is based on twin-share, double or triple-share bedroom. Different room type might not be on the same level. Single room occupancy comes with an additional cost.
- 9.1.1 Room size is generally slightly smaller than what you may be used to. Space is precious commodity in Europe and especially in its busiest cities. Many of the buildings will have been in existence for hundreds of years and were not built with the modern traveller in mind. The upside is that they are usually in excellent locations and have a fascinating story to tell.
- 9.1.2 Bed sizes may also differ. In Europe, King and Queen-sized beds are very rare. Here, double beds are the norm and you may often find that a double room consists of two twin beds pushed together instead of a full bed, made up with one set of linen. You may also find that twin beds will be placed very close together.
- 9.1.3 A triple room is the same size as a twin-share room. The third bed is always a roll-away bed or sofa bed added into the room. As a result, you may feel that the room is very cramped and small.
- 9.1.4 Europeans are very socially and environmentally conscious, especially about air-conditioning in Europe. During autumn and winter seasons, the central air-conditioning will be switched off in the hotel rooms. So, do not expect that the air-conditioning will be switched on in the room. You may open the windows to let cold air in, where possible.
- 9.2 **Special Request**  
If there are any requests regarding special meals, dietary requirements, adjoining rooms, flight seating arrangement and so on, please inform the Company upon booking. However, such requests are strictly subject to confirmation and availability by the airlines/hotels. There are no halal meals on tour.
- 9.3 **Baggage**  
The Customer is usually allowed check-in baggage not exceeding twenty (20) kilograms. Only one piece of hand-luggage not exceeding seven (7) kilograms is allowed on board the aircraft. Excess baggage charges must be borne by the Customer and are subject to individual airlines' company policy.
- 9.4 **Meals**
- 9.4.1 Meals, including meals served on flights, are as indicated in the tour brochure / itinerary / tour booking form. In the event where in-flight meals are not served due to whatever reasons, there shall be no refund or replacement.
- 9.4.2 You and your travelling companions will generally dine together at a designated time. Table will often vary in size and free seating enables you to dine with family members or new travelling companions each evening. A breakfast buffet is included daily and will reflect the local regions tastes and culture. Very occasionally, an early departure may result in a light breakfast box for you to take away if applicable. Lunches are sometimes included but are usually an opportunity for the guest to enjoy some free time to visit a local café, bar or restaurant and eat where the locals do. Your tour manager will be able to provide you with a range of options to suit all tastes and preferences.
- 9.5 **Seat Rotation**  
For the convenience of all members of the group, passengers may be requested to rotate their seating arrangements on the coach during the period of the tour. Please cooperate when requested to do so by the tour manager / tour leader / guide.
- 9.6 **Motor-coach**  
For selected itineraries with Wi-Fi on coach using 3G mobile network, please be aware that the connection is slower than standard broadband and at times may not be available. It is good for checking emails, web browsing and updating social media accounts, but less so for streaming videos or large photo uploads.
- 9.7 **Single Room Supplement**  
Please note that customers paying for single room occupancy supplement charge will be allocated a single room. The single room supplement charge as indicated in the booking form applies. Hotels will try their best to upgrade twin/double room for guests who opt for single room occupancy, but this may not be possible in the event when hotel occupancy rate is high.
- 9.8 **Suggested Excursion**  
Optional list may be subject to change, depending on the time you are travelling or local circumstances including weather and days of the week. Further information will be provided by your Tour Manager / Guides during the tour.
- 9.9 **Flights**  
The tour group might be comprised of flights on different airlines, so the Tour Manager may not be on the same flight as the group. If the group is not on the same flight as the Tour Manager, the group will have to proceed to transit on their own. There will be a check-in staff at Singapore Changi Airport to assist the group to check in if the Tour Manager is not flying together.
10. **PRICING POLICIES**
- 10.1 **Tour Fare Includes**  
Return economy class group tour air ticket, local transport, accommodation, admission fees, meals and sightseeing programme as stipulated in the tour brochure / itinerary / tour booking form.
- 10.2 **Tour Fare Excludes**  
Airport taxes, airport security taxes, airline insurance surcharges, fuel taxes, visa fees, travel insurance, customs user fees as specified by the airlines and airport authorities; local transfer not stated in the itinerary (e.g. free & easy, deviation), laundry, excess baggage charges, beverages, room services, gratuities to drivers and tour managers / local guides and tips to hotel porters (if any); and personal expenses. Please refer to the Company for visa fees, gratuities to drivers and tour managers / local guides, and tips to hotel porters.
- 10.3 **Cancellation Fee**  
For Clause 2 – Cancellation By The Customer – tour fare refers to the selling tour fare plus airport taxes, airport security taxes, airline insurance surcharges and fuel taxes.
- 10.4 **Child Fare**  
Child fare is applicable to children below twelve (12) years old on the scheduled date of departure & departure date from Singapore. The child fare is based on a twin-sharing accommodation with two adults and no additional bed will be provided. A surcharge will be imposed where an extra bed is required for the child or where the child occupies a room with only one adult.
- 10.5 **Mode of Payment**  
Payment may be made in cash, by NETS, PAYNOW, AXS, cheques or credit cards. Cheques will only be accepted if presented to the Company at least seven (7) working days before scheduled tour departure. Credit card payment may incur additional surcharge for special promotion packages, you may refer to our staff for confirmation. Overseas Bank transfer may incur additional surcharge and to be borne by the Customer.
11. **RESPONSIBILITY**
- 11.1 The Company acts as an agent for the carriers, transportation companies, hotels and other principals of the tour packages. The Company accepts no responsibility for any injuries, losses, damages, accidents, flight cancellations, delays, theft, quarantine, customs regulations, strikes, weather hazards, political unrest, changes in itineraries, deportation or refusal of entry by Immigration Authorities resulting from improper travel documents, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may cause damage to person or property. Any losses and/or expenses incurred are the responsibility of the passenger. Ensuring all proper travel documentation is in place is the sole responsibility of the Customer.
- 11.2 The failure of the Customer to follow reasonable instructions, including but not limited to check-in and check-out places or times or other cause and the losses and/or expenses resulting therefore shall be borne by the Customer.
- 11.3 The Company reserves the right to:
- 11.3.1 Alter tour itineraries, travel arrangements, accommodation due to unforeseen changes.
- 11.3.2 Cancel any reservations prior to departure for reasons, including but not limited to insufficient number of participants. The Company will recommend alternative tours, preferably to the same destination or to other destinations. Should the Customer decide not to accept the alternatives, the deposit or tour fare is to be refunded without further obligation on the part of the Company, upon the Customer's surrender to the Company of all documents issued by the Company for the purpose of the tour package.
- 11.3.3 Require any individual to withdraw from the tour if it is deemed that his/her behaviour is detrimental to or incompatible with the health, safety, interests, harmony and welfare of the other tour participants and the tour group as a whole. Under such circumstances, the Company shall be under no liability thereafter to any such person.
- 11.3.4 To specify the language in which the tour guide will conduct commentary in.
- 11.4 No tour guides, tour managers, tour leaders or other employees or agents of the Company are authorised to commit the Company to any liability and the Company shall not be bound by any statement or representation unless it is in writing and signed by a Management Executive of the Company.
- 11.5 All verbal agreements must be stated in writing and duly signed by the Manager.
- 11.6 The Company reserves the right to take photographs and videos of the Customer while he/she is on tour with the Company, to be used for advertising in brochures or publicity materials without obtaining any further consent from the Customer.
- 11.7 All tour fares for the respective tour packages are correct at the time of reservation. The Company reserves the right to revise the tour fares and to determine the date of commencement of such revised tour fares.
12. **COMPLAINT & CLAIM**  
Should you encounter a problem during your tour, kindly inform the EU Holidays Tour Manager or local supplier immediately, who will try to make things right. If the matter was not resolved locally, please submit a feedback to EU Holidays in writing within seven (7) days from the date of return. It is important to provide us the information quickly. Please quote your booking reference number and all relevant information. Failure to follow this procedure may delay or deny us the opportunity to investigate and rectify the problem, which may affect the way your complaint is dealt with and your rights under this contract.
13. **MISCELLANEOUS**  
The Company reserves the right to change, amend, insert or delete any Tour Booking Terms and Conditions contained within this document, as the case may be, without prior notice. The Tour Booking Terms and Conditions complement those Terms and Conditions contained in the relevant documents provided by third (3rd) party service providers such as airlines or cruise tickets, hotel check-ins etc.


