



DAY 1

HOME ▶ ADDIS ABABA

Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport for your flight **Addis Ababa**, the capital and largest city of **Ethiopia**.

DAY 2

ADDIS ABABA

Lunch, Dinner

On arrival in Addis Ababa, transfer for breakfast before beginning the city tour with a drive up north to **Mount Entoto** for stunning views over the city. Continue visit the **Ethnographic Museum** which contains a large collection of Ethiopian handicrafts and historic artifacts. Next visit the **Trinity Cathedral**, the largest and most revered of all modern churches. After lunch, transfer to hotel check in and rest for the day.

DAY 3

ADDIS ABABA ▶ LALIBELA

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Head to the airport for your flight to **Lalibela**, the crown jewel of Ethiopia often referred to as 'Africa's Petra'. Tour the

magnificent **Rock-Hewn Churches**, a UNESCO World Heritage site. This group of 11 monolithic churches were carved directly into the stone mountainside at least 800 years ago. This complex boasts the largest monolithic church in the world, a maze of passageways and tunnels, intricately carved reliefs, and fabulous examples of icon paintings. You will see the first groups of churches are **Biete Medhane Alem**, **Bete Maryam**, **Bete Meskel**, **Bete Denagil** and **Beta Golgota**. Last church visit is **Bete Giorgis**, a free standing church with architectural elegance and perfection.


DAY 4

LALIBELA ▶ ADDIS ABABA ▶ LANGANO

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Catch your flight to Addis Ababa. Upon arrival continue your road to **Langano**. En route visit **Lake Ziway**, the largest of the upper Rift Valley lakes with an area of 400sq km. Its shores are lined with reeds and water lilies, sheltering a variety of water birds, such as flamingo. Proceeding to **Lake Langano**. The lake is the perfect place to relax and enjoy some water activities.

DAY 5 LANGANO ▶ ARBA MINCH

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Drive to **Arba Minch**, the largest town in southern Ethiopia. On the way, visit **Chencha Village** home of the Dorze people in the Guge Mountains. The Dorze are known for their tall, beehive-shaped bamboo houses. If the base becomes infested with termites, the entire house can be lifted and moved to another location. Take a leisurely walk around the village, observing daily life and watching the women weave. Continue to your lodge located at **Nechisar National Park**.

DAY 6 ARBA MINCH ▶ KONSO ▶ TURMI

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

With some of the most dramatic scenery in Africa, **Nechisar National Park** lies at the heart of the Rift Valley, covering Lakes Chamo and Abaya and the mountainous causeway between them known as the 'Bridge of God'. This morning you will enjoy a boat tour on **Lake Chamo**, which is inhabited by a significant number of hippo and giant crocodiles. Leaving Arba Minch, drive to **Konso Village** - a World Heritage listed site of cultural significance. A highland people, the Konso are known for the ancient and intricate terraces that encircle their well-planned villages. Late in the afternoon, you will arrive in **Turmi** and overnight.

DAY 7 OMO RIVER EXCURSION ▶ DASSANACH & KARO TRIBES

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After early breakfast, drive to **Omorate** nearby the Omo River and cross the river by local boat. This area is inhabited by the Daasanach (Galeb) people, known for their interesting house design and body painting. Next, you will visit Karo people at the village of **Murulle**, which at the shores of the Omo River. The Karo tribes are mainly known for their special hairstyle and body paintings. Take your time here to discover & experience their lifestyle then late afternoon drive back to Turmi.

DAY 8 TURMI ▶ KEY AFER ▶ JINKA

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Drive to **Jinka** and on your way you will visit various villages of the **Tsemay, Ari, and Benna** people. Tsemay are the least known people in this region of Ethiopia and share political and spiritual similarities with the Erbore people. They are farmers who practice flood cultivation of sorghum and maize and rear livestock. Stop at **Key Afer**, there is a colorful market on every Thursday and here you can see different ethnic groups have gathered to barter their goods.

DAY 9 JINKA ▶ MAGO NATIONAL PARK ▶ ADDIS ABABA

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Start your morning with an excursion to **Mago National Park**, one of Africa's vast wilderness areas. Visit the **Mursi Village** in the area that lies along the Mago River in the heart of the park. Mursi tribes are well known for their unique lip plates. Women wearing large clay plates into their lower lips to reveal her worth prior to being married. Drive back to Jinka and catch the flight to Addis Ababa.

DAY 10 ADDIS ABABA ▶ HOME

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast, free at own leisure till check out. After lunch, visit to the **National Museum** of Ethiopia, which houses the famous fossil of 'Lucy'. Next, strolling at the largest **Mercator market** (open air) for some last-minute shopping. In the evening, enjoy farewell dinner in one of the traditional Ethiopian restaurants with traditional music and dance from different ethnic groups. Then you will be transferred to airport for your flight home.

DAY 11 HOME SWEET HOME

Meal on board

For a uniquely African journey positively brimming with fascinating culture, immemorial historical remnants and coffee that is the stuff of legends.



SIMIEN MOUNTAINS NATIONAL PARK, ETHIOPIA

Ethiopia, a land that used to be synonymous with famines and drought, has since moved on from its tumultuous past to emerge as Africa's newest travel destination in recent years. Named as the top country to visit in Africa by Lonely Planet, Ethiopia is blessed with historical gems rooted in ancient Orthodox Christianity, beautiful rugged landscapes teeming with endemic wildlife and rich indigenous culture.

Also said to be the birthplace of coffee, Ethiopian coffee is known to be rich and aromatic, paired with an age-old daily ritual of a 'coffee ceremony' that is bound to enthrall your senses.

Physically, Ethiopia is one of Africa's most gorgeous countries and home to incredibly varied landscapes, from the magnificent peaks of the Simien Mountains to the active lava lakes of the Danakil. The country also boasts a vast expanse of lakes and rivers, such as Lake Tana of the Blue Nile and Lake Langano, a popular weekend retreat spot where you can engage in various water activities. Of all the lakes of Rift Valley south, Lake Abijatta may surprise you with a rare visual treat; hundreds of thousands of beautiful pink-hued flamingoes gather here to feed in its shallows, forming one of Africa's greatest ornithological spectacle.

Admire the beautiful woven patterned masterpieces by the Dorze tribe; be amazed at the elaborate body art and colourful accessories of the Karo people; and try not to be daunted at the sight of the Mursi women wearing huge ceramic plates in their lower lip.





DAY 1 HOME ▶ WINDHOEK

Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport and depart for Windhoek, Namibia's capital.

DAY 2 WINDHOEK ▶ SOSSUSVLEI

Lunch, Dinner

Upon arrival at the Windhoek airport, meet up with your local guide. Drive south to the world-famous **Sossusvlei**, and along the way you will pass through the picturesque **Spreetshoogte Pass**. You will have a stop over at the viewpoint to appreciate the endless view of the Namib Desert. Last but not least, check in at the hotel and rest for the day.

DAY 3 SOSSUSVLEI

Breakfast, Dinner

Rise early this morning for a magical excursion into the **Namib-Naukluft National Park**. Visit the **Dead Vlei**, where you will find clay pans covered in a crust of salt-rich sand, surrounded by burnt orange and red towering dunes. It is considered as one of the most stunning desert landscapes in Africa. Make a stop at **Dune 45**, the highest dune in Namibia. An optional climb to the top will reward you with views that are worthy of the effort. Next, stop at the **Sesriem Canyon**, a natural gorge carved out by the Tsauchab River.

DAY 4 SOSSUSVLEI ▶ SWAKOPMUND

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Depart for **Swakopmund** you'll pass through the **Welwitschia Plains**, where you can look out for the bizarre welwitschia plants, made of only 2 leaves that are gradually split into strips by the wind - some of which are over 1,500 years old. You'll also pass through the **Moonlandscape** where rippling hills and rocky valleys create an 'other-worldly' scene. Arriving at Swakopmund, Namibia's top coastal resort located in a charming and German-like town nestled between the desert and ocean.

DAY 5 SWAKOPMUND ▶ WALVIS BAY ▶ SWAKOPMUND

Breakfast, Dinner

Depart for a **harbour cruise** in the early morning at the greater bay area of **Walvis Bay**. Enjoy complimentary oysters and sparkling wine as you cruise to **Pelican Point**, home to a large colony of Cape fur seals. If you are lucky, you can glimpse the wonderful sight of gleaming bottlenose and Heaviside's dolphins swimming alongside the boat.

It also home to the 2,500 year old rock carvings, these simple sketches of lions, cattle and humans engraved into the red rock are humbling and beautiful – sure to be a real highlight of your trip to Namibia.

KHORIXAS ▶ ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Today, visit the unique local **Himba village** and interact with the villagers. The Himba are semi-nomadic pastoral people and are easily recognizable by their unique style of hair and dress. Enjoy a traditional Himba dance called Ondjongo performed by them at the end of the tour. After that, you will travel to one of Southern Africa's finest and most important Game Reserves - **Etosha National Park**. Etosha National Park is world renowned for its spectacular wildlife paradise. Experience an **evening game drive** as you search for elephants, lions, black and white rhinoceros, leopards, giraffe and various other animal species in their natural environment. This drive includes waterhole visits and park exploration, ending with a view of the sunset at one of their spectacular viewpoints before proceeding for dinner.

Exquisite decorations fill the walls of the prayer hall – a testimony to the 6000 master craftsmen who worked tirelessly to carve out intricate patterns and detailed designs by hand. Apart from the visual treat, the mosque also comes with a centrally heated floor for prayers, retractable roof and a stunning view of the vast Atlantic Ocean.







MAIDEN TOWER, AZERBAIJAN



HOLY TRINITY CATHEDRAL, GEORGIA

Located between the Black Sea to the west and the Caspian Sea to the east, Caucasus is occupied by Southern Russia, Georgia, Azerbaijan and Armenia. Besides housing these places, the mountainous area is home to Mount Elbrus, Europe's highest peak. Thanks to its historical highlights and its cultural insights, Caucasus has faced a steady growth of tourism in recent years.

Armenia Khor Virap Monastery

As a renowned tourist destination in Armenia, the Khor Virap Monastery is best known for being Grigor Luisavorich's (St. Gregory the Illuminator) prison for 13 years. The prisoner turned saint played a key role in Armenia's history - it's believed that he was sainted after he cured the ruler, King Tradt III of his illness. This act in turn Christian nation in the world. To this day, his actions still echo through time as many visit this holy site to pay homage to the saint. Besides its interesting history, the site is also steeped in natural beauty. Lake Sevan

Dubbed "the pearl of Armenian nature", Lake Sevan is located in the north-east of Yerevan in the city of Sevan. The lake is one of the most popular spots in the country as many of the locals come here to cool off in the pristine, blue waters in the hot summer. Apart from its natural attraction, the site is also home to the Sevanavank Monastery or the Black Monastery. Positioned on the northwestern part of the lake, the monastery is a prominent landmark and the perfect example of Armenian architecture.

Azerbaijan Maiden Tower

Also known as Giz Galasi, the Maiden Tower is considered the Eiffel tower of the Old City, Baku. The symbolic landmark is much loved in the city of Azerbaijan. Erected at the coast of Caspian Sea, it was included in the UNESCO World Heritage List in 2001. The cylindrical shaped tower stands at 29 metres tall offering rooftop views of Baku Bay, the Old City, the Baku Boulevard and the De Gaulle house. It was built in the 12th century, as part of the walled city of Baku. The Maiden Tower also houses a museum, which exhibits the history of Baku City.

Georgia Gergeti Trinity Church

There are no words capable of encapsulating the beauty of the Gergeti Trinity Church. The architectural gem, which is situated in the village of Gergeti at an elevation of 2170 meters, is one of Georgia's most iconic sights. As the seasons change, so does the view of this magnificent site. Positioned on top of a mountain, the church looks tiny against the imposing Mt. Kazbegi, but what it lacks in size, it makes up for in history - specifically 14 centuries of it.

Holy Trinity Cathedral

A towering sight on the hill of St. Ilya, the Holy Trinity Cathedral is the tallest church in Georgia. Measuring at 101 metres high, its golden dome can be viewed from nearly any point in Tbilisi. Built in 2004, the cathedral, also known as Sameba, consists of nine chapels, among which five are situated underground. Often regarded as a modern symbol of revival, Sameba boasts a distinctive arched exterior with exquisite fretwork, as well as beautiful frescoes created under the supervision of iconic painter Amiran Goglidze.





Petra, Jordan

Inscribed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1985, Petra once served as the capital of the ancient Nabataean Kingdom. The main attraction of Petra is the Al-Khazna (Treasury), the first of many monuments in the premise that you will see as you make your way out of the Siq – the main entrance that leads to Petra. With an imposing façade that stands 40 meters high, it is the city's most elaborate and iconic monument. The archaeological city was shrouded in obscurity after Saladin's conquest of the Middle East in 1189. After its rediscovery in 1812, by Johann Ludwig Burckhardt, Petra became one of the most spectacular sites in the Middle East. Petra's popularity grew to such an extent that it even caught the attention of Hollywood and was used as a film location for the Steven Spielberg movie, *Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade*.



Wadi Rum, Jordan

If there's a place on Earth that can depict the barren landscape of the red planet, it would be the Wadi Rum. In fact, it was the film location for the sci-fi movie, *The Martian*. Also known as the Valley of the Moon, Wadi Rum is situated in the south of Jordan and covers an area of 720 square kilometres. The protected area is mainly comprised of craggy, mountainous terrain and a vast, arid landscape that stretches as far as the eye can see. Apart from the Khazali Canyon, which are renowned for their rock inscriptions, other notable points of interest include the deep reddish, brown sand dunes standing against the mountains and the rock formation known as the "Seven Pillars of Wisdom" – soaring rock formations named after the autobiographical accounts of the British soldier, T.E. Lawrence ("Lawrence of Arabia").

Places to See in Your Lifetime

Dead Sea

Bordered by Jordan to the east and Israel and Palestine to the west, the Dead Sea is mostly comprised of the Jordan River, which flows from the north before finding its way into the lake. Littered with salt deposits along its shoreline, the turquoise blue waters contrast with the surrounding golden-brown landscape. The landlocked lake has the lowest elevation on Earth and the lowest body of water on the surface of the planet. Interestingly enough, it is the deepest hypersaline lake in the world – 420m below sea level. The lake's bottom accumulates high concentrations of sodium chloride, which in turn causes the deep water to "fossilise". Famed for its high salinity and mineral-rich mud, the Dead Sea is known for keeping bathers buoyant – thanks to its high saline levels, and its medicinal properties. Although, the Dead Sea is home to microbial life or microorganisms, which have evolved to survive the harsh conditions of the environment, fishes carried in by the Jordan river and other smaller streams are unable to survive in the hypersaline lake.



Jerusalem, Israel

Long venerated as a holy city in Judaism, Christianity and Islam, Jerusalem's recorded history spans over 3,000 years. Every year tourists from all over the world flock to visit the sacred and historical sights of this popular destination. Points of interest such as the Stations of the Cross, Garden Tomb and the famous Dome of the Rock, al-Aqsa mosque and the Western Wall encapsulate the rich, yet turbulent history of Jerusalem while resonating on a personal level with religious sects and world religions. Today's Jerusalem still retains much of its past – permeating the atmosphere of the city and lingering in the shadows of its holy sites. Apart from its deeply spiritual significance, modern-day Jerusalem paints itself as a metropolis – complete with restaurants, museums, shopping malls, and cafes.



Tel Aviv, Israel

Tel Aviv's contemporary and cosmopolitan vibe is a stark contrast to the archaic and timeless Jerusalem in many ways. As the second largest city in Israel, Tel Aviv is relatively more progressive as compared to its Middle Eastern counterparts. 


African Lion



Symbolic of the wilderness of South Africa, the Big Five are some of the most dangerous and elusive species of the animal kingdom. Coined by game hunters, the term, Big Five, represents the utter difficulty in capturing or even spotting these creatures. Hence, they have become hunting favourites, the coveted target and prize of modern hunters. These are the South African Big Five.



African Leopard

It has golden fur embellished with black spots, also known as rosettes that are sometimes circular and other times square-shaped. Fast and furious, this natural beauty is the ultimate athlete with the unrivalled ability to sprint at a speed of 60km/h and leap horizontally over a 6m distance, which is double the distance of their best vertical leap. Thanks to their hide and insane climbing skills, the agile African leopard easily blends into their surroundings and stays out of a reach at the top of a tree.




African Elephant

Taking the cake as the world's largest mammal, these giants average at a weight of about 6,350kg, according to the National Geographic. Known for their gentle nature, African elephants can be a fun bunch to watch especially during bath times when they make use of their trunks to spray water on themselves. While this behaviour may not scare off too many creatures, you wouldn't want to be near one when it's agitated. With a mammoth and muscular frame, they could crush you to bits in a second. As they were being widely poached for their ivories, a ban on it has helped protect the species from extinction.

Cape Buffalo

Marked by their recognisable horns that are likened to two hooks or one big moustache, Cape Buffalos are not to be messed with. Thanks to its sharp curved weapon, this burly animal has earned a nasty reputation for having fatally wounded more game hunters than any other beast in Africa. When a Cape Buffalo has been spotted, you'll be hard-pressed not to find an ox-pecker bird resting atop the mammal, pecking on its hide to remove parasites.



African Rhinoceros

The last mammal of the Big Five is the African Rhino that is split into two species, the Black rhino and the White rhino. The Black rhino normally survive as lone rangers, whereas the White rhino goes in groups, which may justify how Black rhinos are dwindling faster in numbers, being easier to corner and capture. Despite the distinction between the two species, rhinos are neither black nor white – they are grey.

1. RESERVATION, DEPOSIT & FULL PAYMENT

- 1.1 If your minimum deposit is less than the required amount, kindly top up the difference within the next two (2) days.

- 1.3 Full payment is required no later than twenty one (21) days prior to departure. In case of tours in peak season, full payment must be made one month before departure. If full payment is not received by the stipulated deadline, the Company reserves the right to forfeit the deposit and cancel the reservation. In such an event, the cancellation fee as stated in Section 2 is payable by the Customer.
- 1.4 By making deposit and balance payment, it is deemed that you have read, understood and accepted the Tour Booking Terms and Conditions in the booking form.
- 1.5 The Company reserves the right to request for a top-up on initial deposit for immediate issuance of air tickets, to avoid incurring additional surcharges.
- 1.6 Customers must top-up the deposits for ticket issuance as and when the air-tickets are required to be issued by the airlines at the stipulated deadline without prior notice. Failure to do so, the Company has the right to cancel the tour and the deposit will be forfeited.
- 1.7 Any amendment within **fourteen (14) days** or after tickets issued, amendment fee would be the same as cancellation fee stipulated in the Terms and Conditions.

2. CANCELLATION BY THE CUSTOMER

3. CANCELLATION BY THE COMPANY

At times due to low subscription for a group tour, the Company may choose to cancel the entire tour fourteen (14) days prior to departure.
- 3.2 The Company shall also not be held liable for any contingent costs incurred by the Customer arising from the cancellation.
- 3.3 The Company may recommend alternative tours either to the same destination or other tours, based on the current tour fare of that cancellation period. All prior special discounts given will be not extended for the alternative tours. Should the Customer decide not to accept the alternatives, a full refund on the amount paid by the Customer will be made accordingly by the Company without further obligation or liabilities on the part of the Company and that the Customers shall be deemed to have agreed to release the Company from all liabilities or damages in connection with the cancellation. There shall be no claim for inconvenience, loss of leave and transportation cost due to the cancellation of tour.

4. REFUND POLICY

- 5.4 Any change made by the Customer to the existing booking must be in writing or in person at least fourteen (14) days before the tour, after which strictly NO amendments allowed, or cancellation fee applies.
- 5.5 Any replacement or changes of passengers will be considered as a cancellation and not an amendment. This term is applicable to all cases, including but not restricted to the medical and the pregnancy cases.

6. AMENDMENT TO TOUR ITINERARY BY COMPANY

The Company makes reasonable effort to avoid changes in the itinerary. However, the Company reserves the right to make minor changes at any time due to unforeseen circumstances, especially during peak periods or in the event of other circumstances beyond our control.

7. EXTENSION OF STAY / DEVIATION

- 7.1 Extension of stay may be permitted at the end of tour, subject to the restriction of the air ticket, seat

availability and hotel confirmation prior to the commencement of the tour. **All requests must be made before issuance of air tickets.** If the extension of stay / deviation is unable to be confirmed three (3) weeks prior to the group's departure date, the passenger is deemed to stick to the original tour schedule. In the event that the original schedule has been changed by the Company, any extra cost will be borne by the Customer.

- 7.2 Cancellation fee is also applicable if the Customer cancels the booking due to extension / deviation is unable to confirm prior to departure.
- 7.3 Extension of stay / deviation will be at passenger's own expenses and transfer to the airport will not be provided.
- 7.4 It is the Customer's responsibility to hold firm confirmation of their return flight and to re-confirm their flight 72 hours prior to their return date.
- 7.5 The air ticket issued is a special ticket, restricted to specific airline only. It is non-negotiable, non-endorsable, non-reissuable, non-refundable & non-reroutable. Any alteration in routing or dates by the Customer is solely at his/her own risk. The Company and its associated agents will not be held responsible for any inconvenience caused and extra expenses incurred. No refunds will be made for any unused air ticket, accommodation, meals, or sightseeing in part or full.

8. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS, TRAVEL INSURANCE & TRAVEL VOUCHERS

- 8.1 **Passport and other Travel Documents**
It is Customer's sole responsibility to ensure that he / she has a valid passport with minimum six (6) months validity from the date of scheduled return to Singapore, as well as the necessary visas, vaccinations, health certificates and all necessary travel documents as required by various government authorities of the destinations of travel.
- 8.2 **Visa**
The Customer may seek advice from the Company on visa application; however, it is Customer's own responsibility to obtain a valid visa.
- 8.2.1 If for any reason, application for visa or exit permit is rejected, full refund less \$250.00 administrative fee (excluding visa application fees paid to the respective embassies) will be made if the result of the rejection is submitted to the Company at least forty five (45) days prior to departure. If less than forty five (45) days notice is given, relevant cancellation fee as stated under section Cancellation by the Customer will be applied.
- 8.2.2 It is customer responsibility to check that multi-entry Visas have the correct entry dates and destinations before travelling. Please be aware that some itineraries you may travel through a country without making an overnight stop but still require a VISA to enter/exit
- 8.2.3 In consideration for the interests of other passengers in the same group, the Company strongly discourages ALL passengers from applying Visa Upon Arrival at destiny country. The Company takes no responsibility being unable to wait for the passengers who apply Visa Upon Arrival at the Custom.
- 8.2.4 The Company will not be responsible for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of the tour fare if the Customer is deported or refused entry by immigration authorities on the tour for whatever reasons, including improper travel documents, quarantine, custom regulations, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may cause harm or damage to person or property.
- 8.2.5 For non-Singapore passport holders, please request the Company to check on Visa requirements. The Company renders assistance in Visa application wherever possible. The Company cannot, however, guarantee the approval of such Visa application. This service is subject to (auxiliary) fees. Please check with the Company on the amount.
- 8.3 **Travel Insurance**
- 8.3.1 Arrangement of travel insurance coverage is strongly recommended with respect to unforeseen circumstances such as flight

- cancellation, trip cancellation, loss of deposit, baggage, personal accident, injury, illness, etc. Under no circumstances shall the Company be construed as a carrier under a contract for safe carriage of the Customer or his / her baggage and other personal belongings.
- 8.3.2 The Company shall not be responsible for any loss or damage in relation to flight cancellation, trip cancellation, loss of personal baggage, accidents, injuries and illness.
- 8.3.3 Should there be any amendment to the date and duration of travel, it is Customer's responsibility to inform the travel insurance company to amend the date and duration of the insurance coverage.
- 8.3.4 The Company will be pleased to assist in the enquiries of any travel insurance and related matters.
- 8.4 **Travel Vouchers**
The Company issues travel vouchers from time to time as part of its promotional activities. The Terms and Conditions for the redemption of travel vouchers are clearly spelt out in the appropriate documents and shall be binding on the Customer.
- 9. GENERAL MATTERS RELATING TO TOURS**
- 9.1 **Accommodation**
Accommodation is as specified in the tour brochure / itinerary / tour booking form. In the event the specified accommodation is not available, every effort will be made to scout for an alternative in another accommodation of similar standard. Hotel room sizes, facilities and services may vary in different country. Accommodation for adults is based on twin-share, double or triple-share bedroom. Different room type might not be on the same level. Single room occupancy is at additional cost.
- 9.1.1 Room size is generally slightly smaller than you may be used to. Space is precious commodity in Europe and especially in its busiest cities. Many of the buildings will have been in existence for hundreds of years and were not built with the modern traveller in mind. The upside is that usually they are in excellent locations and have a fascinating story to tell.
- 9.1.2 Bed sizes may also differ. In Europe King and Queen – sized beds are very rare. Here double beds are the norm and you may often find that a double room consists of two single beds pushed together instead of a full bed but made up with one set of linen. You may also find that twin beds will be placed very close together.
- 9.1.3 A triple room is the same size as twin bedded room. The third bed is always a roll-away bed or sofa bed added into the room. As a result, you may feel the room is very cramped and small.
- 9.1.4 Europeans are very socially and environmentally conscious and especially the air conditioning in Europe. During Autumn and Winter seasons, the central air-condition is off in the hotel rooms. So, do not expect the air-condition is switch on in the room. You may open windows to let cold air in if applicable.
- 9.2 **Special Request**
If there are any requests regarding special meals, dietary requirements, adjoining rooms, flight seating arrangement and so on, please inform the Company upon booking. However, such requests are strictly subject to confirmation and availability by the airlines/hotels. There is No halal meal on tour.
- 9.3 **Baggage**
Normally customer is allowed check-in baggage not exceeding twenty (20) kilograms. Only one piece of hand luggage not exceeding seven (7) kilograms is allowed on board the aircraft. Excess baggage must be paid directly by the Customer. Depending on individual airline company policy.
- 9.4 **Meals**
- 9.4.1 Meals, including meals on board flights, are as indicated in the tour brochure / itinerary / tour booking form. If meals on board are not served due to whatever reasons, there shall be no refund or replacement.
- 9.4.2 You and your travelling companions will generally dine together at a designated time. Table will often vary in size and free seating enables you to dine with family members or new travelling companions each evening. A breakfast buffet is included daily and will reflect the local regions tastes and culture. Very occasionally, an early departure may result in a light breakfast box for you to take away if applicable. Lunches are sometimes included but are usually an opportunity for the guest to enjoy some free time to visit a local café, bar or restaurant and eat where the locals do. Your tour manager will be able to provide you with range of options to suit all tastes and preferences.
- 9.5 **Seat Rotation**
For the convenience of all members of the group, passengers may be requested to rotate their seating arrangements on the coach during the period of the tour. Please cooperate when requested upon to do so by the tour manager / tour leader / guide.
- 9.6 **Motor-coach**
For selected itinerary - Wifi on coach using 3G mobile network, it means that connection is slower than standard broadband and at times may not be available. It is good for checking emails, web browsing and updating social media accounts, but less so for streaming video or large photo uploads.
- 9.7 **Single Supplement**
For occupation of a single room, single supplement amount as indicated in the booking form is required.
- 9.8 **Suggested Excursion**
Optional list may be subject to change, depending on the time you are travelling or local circumstances including weather and days of the week. Further information will be provided by your Tour Manager / Guides during the tour
- 10. PRICING POLICIES**
- 10.1 **Tour Fare Includes**
Return economy class group tour air ticket, local transport, accommodation, admission fees, meals and sightseeing programme as stipulated in the tour brochure / itinerary / tour booking form.
- 10.2 **Tour Fare Excludes**
Airport taxes, airport security taxes, airline insurance surcharges, fuel taxes, visa fees, travel insurance, customs user fees as specified by the airlines and airport authorities; local transfer not stated in the itinerary (e.g. free & easy, deviation), laundry, excess baggage charges, beverages, room services, gratuities to drivers and tour managers / local guides and tips to hotel porters (if any); and personal expenses. Please refer to the Company for visa fees, gratuities to drivers and tour managers / local guides, and tips to hotel porters.
- 10.3 **Cancellation Fee**
For Clause 2 – Cancellation By The Customers - tour fare refers to selling tour fare plus airport taxes, airport security taxes, airline insurance surcharges and fuel taxes.
- 10.4 **Child Fare**
Child fare is applicable to children below twelve (12) years old on the scheduled date of departure & departure date from Singapore. The child fare is based on a twin-sharing accommodation with two adults and no additional bed will be provided. A surcharge will be imposed where an extra bed is required for the child or where the child occupies a room with only one adult.
- 10.5 **Mode of Payment**
Payment may be made in cash, by NETS, PAYNOW, AXS, cheques or credit cards. Cheques will only be accepted if presented to the Company at least seven (7) working days before scheduled tour departure. Credit card payment may incur additional surcharge for special promotion packages, you may refer to our staff for confirmation. Overseas Bank transfer may incur additional surcharge and to be borne by the Customer.
- 11. RESPONSIBILITY**
- 11.1 The Company acts as agent for the carriers, transportation companies, hotels and other principals of the tour packages. The Company accepts no responsibility for any injuries, losses, damages, accidents, flight cancellation, delays, theft, quarantine, customs regulations, strikes, weather hazards, political unrest, changes in itineraries, deportation or refusal of entry by Immigration Authorities resulting from improper travel documents, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may be caused to person or property. Any losses and/or expenses incurred are the responsibility of the passenger. All proper travel documentation is the sole responsibility of the Customer.
- 11.2 The failure of the Customer to follow reasonable instructions, including but not limited to check-in and check-out places or times or other cause and the losses and/or expenses resulting therefore shall be borne by the Customer.
- 11.3 The Company reserves the right to:
- 11.3.1 Alter tour itineraries, travel arrangements, accommodation due to unforeseen changes.
- 11.3.2 Cancel any reservations prior to departure for reasons, including but not limited to the insufficient number of participants. The Company will recommend alternative tours, preferably to the same destination or to other destination. Should the Customer decided not to accept the alternatives, the deposit or tour fare to be refunded without further obligation on the part of the Company, upon Customer's surrender to the Company of all documents issued by the Company for the purpose of the tour package.
- 11.3.3 Require any individual to withdraw from the tour if it is deemed that his/her behaviour is detrimental to or incompatible with the health, safety, interests, harmony and welfare of the other tour participants and the tour group as a whole. Under such circumstances, the Company shall be under no liability thereafter to any such person.
- 11.3.4 To specify the language in which the tour guide will conduct commentary in.
- 11.4 No tour guides, tour managers, tour leaders or other employees or agents of the Company are authorised to commit the Company to any liability and the Company shall not be bound by any statement or representation unless it is in writing and signed by a Management Executive of the Company.
- 11.5 All verbal agreements must be stated in writing and to be duly signed by the Manager.
- 11.6 The Company reserves the right to take photographs and films of the passenger while on tour with the Company, to be used for brochures advertising or publicity material without obtaining any further consent from the passenger.
- 11.7 All tour fares for the respective tour packages are correct at the time of reservation. The Company reserves the right to revise the tour fares and to determine the date of commencement of such revised tour fares.
- 12. COMPLAINT & CLAIM**
If you have a problem during your holidays please inform EU Holidays Tour Manager or local supplier immediately, who will try to make things right. If the matter was not resolved locally, please write to EU holidays Feedback department in writing within seven (7) days from the date of return. It is important to provide us the information quickly. Please quote you booking reference number and all relevant information. Failure to follow this procedure may delay or deny us the opportunity to investigate and rectify the problem, which may affect the way your complaint is dealt with and your rights under this contract.
- 13. MISCELLANEOUS**
The Company reserves the right to change, amend, insert or delete any Tour Booking Terms and Conditions containing in this document, as the case may be, without prior notice. The Tour Booking Terms and Conditions complement those Terms and Conditions contained in the relevant documents provided by third (3rd) party service providers such as airlines or cruise tickets, hotel check-ins etc.
