DAY 1 HOME ▶ ST. PETERSBURG

Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport and depart for **St Petersburg**, second largest city in **Russia**.

DAY 2 ST. PETERSBURG

Meals on Board

Upon arrival, enjoy the rest of the day free at leisure. Partygoers and fans of revelry will find plenty to enjoy within the city's burgeoning night scene, and the constantly evolving nightlife turn your night into a unique experience you won't soon forget.

Note: If you are taking the morning flight, it will become 9D7N tour instead.

DAY 3 ST. PETERSBURG

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Enjoy a city tour of St. Petersburg and explore the sights of the **Kazan Cathedral**, **Church of Our Savior on Spilled Blood** and the **St. Isaac's Cathedral**. We will also visit the **State Hermitage Museum**, which comprises of five buildings that were formerly the residence of the Tsars and home to one of the finest art collections in the world, with the bulk of the vast collection being found in the grand **Winter Palace**.

DAY 4 ST. PETERSBURG ▶ PETERHOF ▶ PUSHKIN ▶ ST. PETERSBURG

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Pay a visit to **Peterhof**, an imperial estate situated just west of St. Petersburg that is often referred as the 'Russian Versailles', the

favourite summer palace of Peter the Great. Marvel at the magnificent palace, their richly decorated interiors with gold, and beautiful fountains adorned with gold statues of ancient Greek and Roman gods and goddesses. We will then have lunch at the **Grand Orangerie Restaurant**, located at the lower garden of Peterhof. After visiting Peterhof, we will enjoy a visit to the town of **Pushkin**, a picturesque suburb in St. Petersburg. The Catherine Park, an inseparable part of the ensemble and a very poetic place, is a magnificent example of creative labor spanning several generations of talented Russian architects. During the **Catherine Palace** excursion, you will learn about the mysterious history the **Amber Room** and see its splendid interiors, designed by eminent architects, which was recently restored. At night, enjoy a **folk show and dinner with unlimited vodka and wine at the authentic Russian restaurant – Podvorye**, where President Putin held his 50th birthday celebration.

DAY 5 ST. PETERSBURG

Breakfast

Spend the day at your leisure today. Alternatively, you can choose to join an optional full-day trip to Veliky Novgorod. The city was once the former capital of Russia in the 9th century, this UNESCO-listed city consists of well-preserved medieval buildings and churches. Explore the riverside Kremlin and the St. Sophia Cathedral, see fresco-coated churches, and stroll around the reconstructed buildings and see the open-air Wooden Architecture Museum, which was built without nails.

DAY 6

ST. PETERSBURG ► MOSCOW

Breakfast, Dinner

Begin the day on-board a high-speed train that will take you to **Moscow**, the capital of Russia. Go on a sightseeing tour of the unique Russian city, which will bring you to view the **Red Square**, **GUM Department Store** and visit the **St. Basil's Cathedral**. As dusk falls, prepare yourself for a night of entertainment with a performance by the world-famous **Moscow State Circus**.

Note: Portage is included, 1 piece per pax, till/from the entrance of the carriage to the drop-off/pick-up point.

DAY 7

MOSCOW

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Kick off the day with an exhilarating adventure to the **Moscow Kremlin**, an old fortified complex in the heart of Moscow that has housed generations of Russian rulers and remains as the official residence of the President of the Russian Federation to this day. Home to some of the most beautiful Russian Orthodox monuments, make your way to the **Cathedral Square** to see the magnificent churches that have each played their part in history. Gaze in wonder at the architectural masterpieces of the **Assumption Cathedral**, the **Annunciation Cathedral** and the

Archangel's Cathedral, as well as the **Tsar Bell** and the **Tsar Cannon** that are displayed on the grounds of the Kremlin. For lunch, we will dine in the **Turandot Palace Restaurant**. The baroque interior of the place is unbelievably extravagant, with hand-painted furniture, gilded light fixtures and a fresco cupola ceiling. After lunch, embark on a **Moscow Metro Ride**, one of the most elaborate transport systems and beautiful railways in the world. We will also visit the **Izmailovo Market**, located not far from Partizanskaya metro station, where you can find original, peculiar, old fashioned articles steeped in history.

DAY 8

MOSCOW ► SERGIEV POSAD ► MOSCOW

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Take a side trip out of Moscow and head to the pilgrim town of **Sergiev Posad**, founded by the country's most revered monk, St. Sergius of Radonezh. Pay a visit to the **Trinity Sergius Lavra**, the most important landmark of this town as well as one of the most important monasteries of the Russian Orthodox Church. Then visit a **Matryoshka Doll Factory** to learn about the production of these traditional nesting 'Trinity' toys.

DAY 9

MOSCOW ► HOME

Breakfast

Enjoy the rest of the day free at leisure till it is time to transfer to the airport for your flight home.

Turandot Palace

Captivating diners with its decadent interiors and lavish ambience, the Turandot Palace lives up to its name in the quite literal sense. The menu, designed by London restaurateur Alan Yau of Hakkasan and Wagamama, features delectable Asian dishes including Japanese marble meat (Kobe), roasted Peking duck and even Sashimi. Be it the hefty, opulent chandeliers hanging from the intricately decorated ceilings or the sumptuous pan-Asian cuisine, the restaurant prides itself for its distinctive charm and its near-perfect embodiment of Puccini's famous opera, *Nessun Dorma*. Upon entering the Turandot Palace, it is clear that no expense was spared to embellish every corner of this place, down to the very last detail. In fact, it took six years and an estimated \$2 million to build this impressive place.

Podvorye Folk Show

If there is one place that will take your dining experience to new heights, it is the outstanding and unforgettable Podvorye Restaurant in Pavlovsk city. Situated within 30 km from St. Petersburg, complete with bear skins adorning the wooden interiors, the restaurant presents itself as a typical Russian log house/cabin. Renowned for being the country's most authentic Russian restaurant, the Podvorye has served scrumptious Russian cuisine of every kind since it first opened in 1993.

When you first enter the establishment, you will be greeted by the delectable smells of homemade sausages intermingled with the sweet scent of freshly made pancakes. Their extensive menu offers everything from shish kebabs and roasted deer meat to hot pancakes served with ice cream. Of course, no meal is complete without a little entertainment. At Podvorye, it comes in the form of a traditional folk show. Staff of the establishment wearing traditional attire accentuate the lively atmosphere with their musical performances and songs.

Grand Orangerie @ Peterhof Garden

Another place that greets you with a warm Russian hospitality is the Grand Orangerie in Peterhof Palace. Situated in the charming lower park gardens, the former greenhouse turned restaurant offers mouth-watering Russian cuisine coupled exceptional views of the stunning greenery surrounding Peterhof. Its high-quality service and affordable cuisine stems from its official partnership with the Peterhof Museum and Reserve. If you have trouble looking for the place, just keep your eyes peeled for the prominent Orangerie Fountain, which features a statue of Triton fighting a sea monster.

Moscow State Circus



DAY 1 HOME ▶ BEIJING

Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport and take-off to **Beijing**, China where we have a stopover before departing for **Irkutsk**, a city on the Angara River in eastern Siberia, Russia.

DAY 2 BEIJING ▶ IRKUTSK

Meals on Board, Lunch, Dinner

Once upon arrival, take on a city tour to the historic districts of the city, the place where Irkutsk was founded by the Cossack Yakov Pokhobov, its ancient churches, cultural sites and monuments. The tour continues with the visit to the **Historic Memorial Decembrists' Museum** (house-museum of Decembrist Sergei Volkonsky), where you are going to hear many stories about the life of Decembrists of Siberia.

DAY 3 IRKUTSK ▶ ARSHAN

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

We leave the big city behind this morning and head for **Arshan Village**, a small picturesque town situated in the republic of Burvatia at the foot of Eastern **Sayan Mountains**. Its known as "**Little Siberian Switzerland**" because of its healing hot springs that rise to the surface near Kyngarga river. Walking into the **Tunkinsky National Park**, take a short trek to the **Kyngarga Waterfall**.

DAY 4 ARSHAN ▶ TUNKA VALLEY ▶ ARSHAN

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

We'll spend the day exploring the village and its charming surroundings. Visiting the **local market** and the small **Buddhist Dastan** (monastery) hidden in the forest. A breath-taking drive will take us to **Zhemchug Village** located at the end of the **Tunkinsky Valley** with its vast steppes, horses and cows. Here you will have the chance to bathe in the **mineral springs**, which are so good for your skin, joints and the nerve system. On the way back, we pass by a small **local observatory** with telescopes and return to Arshan Village.

DAY 5 ARSHAN ▶ CIRCUMBAIKAL RAILWAY ▶ LISTVYANKA

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

In the morning we drive straight to **Slyudyanka Village** where we'll board the **Circumbaikal Train** to make a day trip on a former **Trans-Siberian railway** along the lake shore. Until the middle of the 20th century the Circumbaikal railway was part of the main line of Trans-Siberian Railway; later on however, a duplicate section of the railway was built. Sometimes called a unique achievement in engineering, the Circumbaikal is one of the picturesque sights of the area around **Lake Baikal**. The Circumbaikal contains thirty-eight tunnels with a total length of 9063m (the longest

of them, a tunnel through Cape Polovinny, is 777.5m long). There are also 15 stone galleries and 3 ferro-concrete galleries with apertures, 248 bridges and viaducts, and 268 retaining walls. We are going to enjoy a **day trip on board of the train** making several stops to wander around the tunnels, bridges on the coast of Baikal lakes with lots of wild flowers. After arriving to the port Baikal in the evening we take a ferry trip to **Listvyanka Village**.

DAY 6 LISTVYANKA ► IRKUTSK

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

We start the day exploring **Listvyanka Village** with its port and fish market. Next, we'll visit the **Church of Saint Nicholas** followed by the excursion in the **Baikal Limnological Museum**. Here you will learn a lot about the unique flora and fauna of the lake. If you don't suffer from dizziness, you can also enjoy the virtual diving to the bottom of the lake to see it more closely. Departure to the **Taltsy Museum of Wooden Architecture** that will tell you the history of native people of Siberia. Taltsy Museum opens its doors to all visitors, wishing to enjoy the beauty of different types of old wooden constructions – civil, religious and defensive – from the 17th to the 20th centuries. You will get to know a lot about the cultural heritage of Russian, Buryat, Tofalar and Evenks people. Then leisurely journey back to **Irkutsk**.

DAY 7 IRKUTSK ► OLKHON ISLAND

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner





Take a stroll around this charming and compact city, spend some time in one of the outdoor cafés and restaurants, visit the famous fish market, enjoy a trip on the **Fløibanen Funicular**. After embarkation, we invite you to enjoy our tasty dinner buffet, based on the best ingredients from the coast. We sail north from Bergen along the **Hjeltefjorden**, the same route the Vikings once plied to the Shetland Islands and beyond. Today we will head to the high north and afterwards, we will spend the rest of the evening relaxing and admiring the spectacular landscapes, either from deck or in our panorama lounges.

DAY 3 FLORØ ▶ MOLDE

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

We will set course for the spectacular UNESCO-listed **Geirangerfjord**, witness the 800-metre cliffs and impressive waterfalls en-route. Few large cities have managed to preserve their authenticity as effectively as Norway's third largest city, **Trondheim**. Viking king, Olav Tryggvason, founded this ancient city as early as 997. We will spend some time in this city before the ship sets northwest in the afternoon, passing the beautiful **Kjeungskjær lighthouse** and numerous charming islets and rocky outcrops. After passing through the narrow **Stokksund**, the ship will head towards the charming **Rørvik**.

DAY 5 BRØNNØYSUND ▶ SVOLVÆR

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Today we cross the **Arctic Circle!** This invisible line is situated at 66 degrees 33 minutes north and marks the border to the Arctic Region. In the summer, this means 24-hour daylight - often referred to as the 'midnight sun'. We will be near Ørnes, where you will find **Svartisen**, Norway's second largest glacier. Afterwards, the journey will continue along the beautiful coast of Helgeland to **Bodø**, where you will rejoice with your group on the ship. Later in the afternoon, the sight of the 1,000 m high **Lofoten Wall** will appear on the horizon. Tucked between majestic granite cliffs and white sandy beaches, Lofoten is an experience that is simply out of this world. The charms of the **Lofoten Islands** are revealed in the small, picturesque fishing villages with their bohemian ambience. Take a stroll between stockfish racks and 'rorbuer', the traditional fisherman's huts.

DAY 6 STOKMARKNES ▶ SKJERVØY

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

In the morning, we will briefly dock at Risøyhamn, Harstad and Finnsnes. The ship then continues to **Tromsø**, 'Capital of the Arctic', for a prolonged stay. Many epic Arctic expeditions used Tromsø as a

starting point. After a day in Tromsø, we continue our northbound journey. The ship is now sailing into waters towards the top of the world - North Cape.

DAY 7 ØKSFJORD ▶ BERLEVÅG

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Enjoy a magnificent sub-Arctic landscape as we cross the 71st parallel on our journey towards **North Cape**, one of the northernmost points on the European continent. You may see herds of grazing reindeer and small camps belonging to the indigenous Sámi people. After a brief and early stop in **Hammerfest** we will reach Havøysund. The ship arrives in **Honningsvåg**, the gateway to the spectacular North Cape. The ship then continues north, sailing into the heartland of the indigenous Sámi people. We pass their ancient sacred site, the rock formation Finnkirka, as we approach our next stop, the fishing village **Kjøllefjord**.

DAY 8 KIRKENES

Today, we will prepare to disembark the cruise. We will be reaching the nearby Vadsø early in the morning and after a hearty breakfast, we will arrive in **Kirkenes**, at 30° East, further east than Istanbul and St. Petersburg.

Kirkenes is also known as the capital of the Barents region and gateway to the east. Embark on a phenomenal **King Crab Safari** experience, where you will head out to the fjord by boat and try to catch the Arctic King Crab with your own hands (metaphorically, not literally) and learn how to cook and eat these huge creatures that can grow up to 15 kilograms in weight. Indulge in a seafood meal and savour the sweet freshness of the king crab.

DAY 9 KIRKENES ▶ OSLO

Breakfast

After arriving in **Oslo**, the capital of Norway, you will begin your exploration of the city by visiting **City Hall**, which is covered with a rainbow of motifs depicting the Norwegian history, culture and lifestyles, as well as the neoclassical structure of the Royal Palace. Last but not least, the **Vigeland Sculpture Park** is one attraction that is worth seeing. It is the life's work of the sculptor Gustav Vigeland, which features more than 200 life-sized sculptures in bronze, granite and cast iron.

DAY 10 OSLO ▶ HOME

Assemble at the airport and take-off to the city of **Vilnius**, Lithuania's capital, known for its baroque architecture, seen especially in its medieval Old Town.

DAY 2

VILNIUS

Meals on Board, Chinese Lunch, Dinner

Upon arrival Vilnius city tour. During sightseeing in Vilnius tourists visits **Old Town of Vilnius**, which is included to the UNESCO World Heritage List, looks like a maze of small streets. In the center of the Old Town stands the Cathedral with a bell tower. In the narrow old streets one will see numerous pieces of historical heritage, like **St. Anne's Church** - a gem of Gothic architecture, University building, **St. Peter -Paul Church**, as well as the ruins of the **Upper and Lower Castle**. We will go to the **Užupis District**, and head to **Hill of Three Crosses**. Legend has it that long ago seven Franciscan monks were crucified here, and four were thrown into the Vilnia River

afterwards. The first crosses were erected on the hill in the 17th century in memory of these martyrs. During Stalin's rule the three crosses were removed and buried. It was only on June 14, 1989, that a new memorial was unveiled, rebuild according to the original plans. These crosses are symbols of Lithuanian mourning and hope.

DAY 3

VILNIUS ▶ TRAKAI ▶ VILNIUS

Breakfast, Lunch, Lithuanian Dinner + Folk Show

Today, we will visit **Trakai**, the former capital of Lithuania, which is situated on an island in the middle of a lake. The 14th century red brick castle now houses the Art Museum. The castles of Trakai are the best known works of defensive architecture in Lithuania. The old town of Trakai, which includes the Island and the Peninsula Castles, surrounded by lakes, is one of the most impressive and most picturesque locations in Europe. Something special is awaiting for us as we have lunch and Kybyn tasting at local restaurant Kybynlar. There will be **kybyn cooking demonstration** and tasting of this traditional **karaim dish** in a real karaim community house, located in Trakai. From sights encapsulating the past, to traditions and practices as diverse as the countries themselves, Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania captivate travellers from all walks of life.

Latvia

Besides being known for its unspoiled countryside, Latvia is also famed for its medieval architecture and places steeped in historical significance. The capital city of Riga is famed for its age-old buildings and attractions that reflect the ancient history of Latvia.

The Dome Cathedral in Riga dates as far back as 1211, when the foundation stone was laid, it is the oldest and grandest church in Latvia, and to this day it remains actively utilised for hosting major concerts, various musical performances and official services. One of the main highlights of the cathedral is the enormous organ, which is believed to be around since the 16th century or earlier.

Situated in Riga, the Swedish Gate is one of the must-visit places in Riga Old Town. Erected in 1698, it is the only remaining gate from the medieval city walls. It was used by the Swedes to enter Riga when the city was a part of Sweden.

Today, the gate or wall is the part of the residential buildings in the area. Retaining its ancient facade, the distinct structure stands conspicuously among its relatively modern counterparts.

Estonia

Comprised of urban attractions and natural highlights, Estonia is renowned for its eclectic mix of attractions. Its dramatic sceneries contrast with many of its age-old buildings and structures. One place that is notable for its diversity is Tallinn, the capital city of Estonia.

From its vibrant nightlife to its rich cultural scene, the popular destination caters to travellers from every walk of life. Its medieval Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is comprised of medieval city walls and towers that have remained intact to this day. Within these fortified walls, you will find old buildings with red tile roofs, hidden courtyards and winding cobblestone streets.

Lithuania

Lithuania has always charmed visitors with its heterogenous offerings. For instance, Vilnius, land of baroque beauty, is the largest capital of Lithuania. It is home to people of different races, creeds and cultures such as Germans, Slavs and Jews. The city also houses buildings that encompass neoclassical architectural styles.

The Vilnius Cathedral Basilica, situated on the edge of the bustling Cathedral Square, is the main venue where many local events such as fairs, parades and concerts take place. The structure of the building is similar to that of a square Romanesque building. It includes a massive tower and is surrounded by more than 40 artworks dating as far back as the 16th-19th centuries. Rumours has it that if you step on the 'magic tile', which is located between the Vilnius Cathedral and the Bell Tower, close your eyes and turn around three times, your wishes will come true.

St. Anne's Church will also fascinate you with its unique exterior. Gothic masterpieces that were built in the end of the fourteenth century virtually remained unchanged until today. Countless arches, graceful towers and artworks captivate visitors from all the world. Located just opposite of St. Anne's Church is the Bernardine Church and Monastery. It is much more spacious and possesses a different architectural style, with strong Renaissance and Baroque features. Art lovers will be able to admire the sixteenth century wall paintings and the Lithuanian crucifix sculpture from the fifteenth century. While here, do visit the Gothic bell tower, standing 17 metres tall with spiral staircase that provides a panoramic view of the city.



DAY 4 GEILO ▶ HARDANGERFJORD ▶ BERGEN

Breakfast, Dinner

Today, we will make a stop at **Voringfossen**, the 83rd highest waterfall in Norway for a photoshoot before continuing to the **Hardangerfjord** region, the second longest fjord in Norway. The Hardangerfjord is 179km long and greatest depth is 900 meters. The definition of a fjord is a long, narrow inlet from the sea with steep sides or cliffs, created by glacial erosion during the ice ages. Arrive **Bergen**, a large Norwegian city with a small-town charm. Your exploration begins with a Bergen city tour- soak up the sights and sounds of the bustling **Fish Market** in the heart of the city; wander along the narrow alleyways and step into the smorgasbord of shops and galleries in **Bryggen**; and take the **Floibanen funicular** to the top of **Mount Floyen** for a fantastic bird's-eye view of the city.

DAY 5

BERGEN ▶ VOSS ▶ SKEI

Breakfast, Dinner

Travel to the region of Voss, consider an optional train ride by the Flam Railway, and embark on the most incredible train journey where you will be treated to endless panoramas of placid rivers, deep ravines, cascading waterfalls, and mountain farms clinging precariously to snow-capped peaks. You will embark on a **2-hour sightseeing cruise** within **Gudvangen and Flam** on the pristine waters of **Naerofjord** and prepare to be blown away by the spectacular vistas displayed before your very eyes. Naerofjord, is the world's narrowest fjord and is included in the UNESCO World Heritage List. Transfer to **Skei** for an overnight stay.

DAY 6

SKEI ▶ GEIRANGER ▶ OPPLAND COUNTY

Breakfast, Dinner

We will take a **scenic sightseeing cruise** across the deep blue waters of this UNESCO World Heritage Site, **Geirangerfjord**. The fjord offers archetypal scenery, encircled by high mountains, where abandoned farms

cling to the hillsides. The trip between Geiranger and **Hellesylt** takes in the **Knivsfla Waterfalls**, known as the Seven Sisters and Friaren (the Suitor). You will also sail close to the **Brudesloret (Bridal Veil) falls**. Along the Geirangerfjord, you will experience the very best of Norwegian nature, close up. Drive along **Ornevegen ("the Eagle Road")**, name given to the steepest part of the road up the mountainside from Geiranger to **Eidsdal**, 620 metres above sea level. Here, the road twists through eleven hairpin bends as it climbs up to **Stigrora**, 858 metres above sea level. The road is carved into the mountain and supported by stone walls. An impressive bridge carries the road across the **Stigfossen waterfall**. On this road, even the bravest can feel the adrenaline pumping through their veins. The **Trollstigen platform** and two viewpoints are designed by Reiulf Ramstad Architects. From the top, well protected against the elements by steel and glass, you can see all the way down the mountainside. The structure is designed so that it blends in with the surroundings. 

An impressive bridge carries the road across the **Stigfossen waterfall**. On this road, even the bravest can feel the adrenaline pumping through their veins. The **Trollstigen platform** and the two viewpoints are designed by Reiulf Ramstad Architects. From the top, well protected against the elements by steel and glass, you can see all the way down the mountainside. The structure is designed so that it blends in with the surroundings. Some parts are carved into the rock, whilst other parts are built on stone walls. Transfer to **Oppland County** for a pleasant night in the Norwegian countryside.

Ancient sherry cellar, in which a unique wine, called dry sherry, "gets old" in oak casks; Unusual museum labyrinth with its ancient myths about wine; **Dionis Fountain** – a symbol of Shabo that allows to face a miracle of wine producing; In afternoon, we head to **Belgorod-Dnestrovskiy Fortress**. You and your traveling companions are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following Terms and Conditions. EU Holidays Pte Ltd shall be referred to as "the Company" in the following:

1. RESERVATION, DEPOSIT & FULL PAYMENT

- 1.1 If your minimum deposit is less than the required amount, kindly top up the difference within the next two (2) days.

- 1.2 Payment of deposit does not constitute confirmation of the tour. All group tours are subject to a minimum group size (as determined by the Company) in order for the confirmation to be effected and for the departure to be finalised.
- 1.3 Full payment is required no later than twenty one (21) days prior to departure. In case of tours in peak season, full payment must be made one month before departure. If full payment is not received by the stipulated deadline, the Company reserves the right to forfeit the deposit and cancel the reservation. In such an event, the cancellation fee as stated in Section 2 is payable by the Customer.
- 1.4 By making deposit and balance payment, it is deemed that you have read, understood and accepted the Tour Booking Terms and Conditions in the booking form.
- 1.5 The Company reserves the right to request for a top-up on initial deposit for immediate issuance of air tickets, to avoid incurring additional surcharges.
- 1.6 Customers must top-up the deposits for ticket issuance as and when the air-tickets are required to be issued by the airlines at the stipulated deadline without prior notice. Failure to do so, the Company has the right to cancel the tour and the deposit will be forfeited.
- 1.7 Any amendment within **fourteen (14) days** or after tickets issued, amendment fee would be the same as cancellation fee stipulated in the Terms and Conditions.

2. CANCELLATION BY THE CUSTOMER

- 2.1 Cancellation of booking must be made in writing or in person to avoid any misunderstanding.
- 2.2 The following cancellation fees apply once any group tour package booking is made:

- 2.3 The above cancellation fees apply if the air-tickets are not issued. If the air-tickets are issued, the value of the air-tickets will be added onto the cancellation fees. Company reserves the right to issue air ticket without prior notice. If the deposit amount is insufficient to cover the cancellation fee, the Customers must pay for the difference.
- 2.4 'Working days' refers to Monday to Friday excluding public holidays.
- 2.5 For Free and Easy packages, administrative fees and / or one (1) night hotel rate will be imposed for those travel documents not issued. Once

issuance of travel documents, changes will not be allowed and has no refund value.

3. CANCELLATION BY THE COMPANY

- 3.1 The Company acts as an agent for service suppliers. After deposit or full payment has been made, all arrangements are still subject to final confirmation by service suppliers. At times due to low subscription for a group tour, the Company may choose to cancel the entire tour fourteen (14) days prior to departure.
- 3.2 The Company shall also not be held liable for any contingent costs incurred by the Customer arising from the cancellation.
- 3.3 The Company may recommend alternative tours either to the same destination or other tours, based on the current tour fare of that cancellation period. All prior special discounts given will be not extended for the alternative tours. Should the Customer decide not to accept the alternatives, a full refund on the amount paid by the Customer will be made accordingly by the Company without further obligation or liabilities on the part of the Company and that the Customers shall be deemed to have agreed to release the Company from all liabilities or damages in connection with the cancellation. There shall be no claim for inconvenience, loss of leave and transportation cost due to the cancellation of tour.

4. REFUND POLICY

- 4.1 No refund will be made with respect to accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours or any other services included in the tour fare but not utilised by the Customer, either in part or full, or when the Customer amends, cancels or otherwise changes in any arrangement after commencement of the tour
- 4.2 All refund will be made within fourteen (14) working days in a form of cheque. For credit card payment, refund will be made through the credit card company.
- 4.3 Air tickets with refund value will only be refunded to Customers within fourteen (14) working days after the respective airlines have refunded to the Company. The standard processing period for air tickets refund varies from three (3) to six (6) months (subject to individual airlines).
- 4.4 During peak period, the refund process may be longer due to increase in transactions.

5. AMENDMENT TO BOOKINGS (REQUESTED BY PASSENGERS)

- 5.1 For any changes in departure date or tour type, cancellation fees apply as listed under **Section 2** on Cancellation by the Customer.




8. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS, TRAVEL INSURANCE & TRAVEL VOUCHERS

- 8.1 **Passport and other Travel Documents**
It is Customer's sole responsibility to ensure that he / she has a valid passport with minimum six (6) months validity from the date of scheduled return to Singapore, as well as the necessary visas, vaccinations, health certificates and all necessary travel documents as required by various government authorities of the destinations of travel.
- 8.2 **Visa**
The Customer may seek advice from the Company on visa application; however, it is Customer's own responsibility to obtain a valid visa.
- 8.2.1 If for any reason, application for visa or exit permit is rejected, full refund less \$250.00 administrative fee (excluding visa application fees paid to the respective embassies) will be made if the result of the rejection is submitted to the Company at least forty five (45) days prior to departure. If less than forty five (45) days notice is given, relevant cancellation fee as stated under section Cancellation by the Customer will be applied.
- 8.2.2 It is customer responsibility to check that multi-entry Visas have the correct entry dates and destinations before travelling. Please be aware that some itineraries you may travel through a country without making an overnight stop but still require a VISA to enter/exit
- 8.2.3 In consideration for the interests of other passengers in the same group, the Company strongly discourages ALL passengers from applying Visa Upon Arrival at destiny country. The Company takes no responsibility being unable to wait for the passengers who apply Visa Upon Arrival at the Custom.
- 8.2.4 The Company will not be responsible for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of the tour fare if the Customer is deported or refused entry by immigration authorities on the tour for whatever reasons, including improper travel documents, quarantine, custom regulations, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may cause harm or damage to person or property.
- 8.2.5 For non-Singapore passport holders, please request the Company to check on Visa requirements. The Company renders assistance in Visa application wherever possible. The Company cannot, however, guarantee the approval of such Visa application. This service is subject to (auxiliary) fees. Please check with the Company on the amount.
- 8.3 **Travel Insurance**
- 8.3.1 Arrangement of travel insurance coverage is strongly recommended with respect to unforeseen circumstances such as flight




- cancellation, trip cancellation, loss of deposit, baggage, personal accident, injury, illness, etc. Under no circumstances shall the Company be construed as a carrier under a contract for safe carriage of the Customer or his / her baggage and other personal belongings.
- 8.3.2 The Company shall not be responsible for any loss or damage in relation to flight cancellation, trip cancellation, loss of personal baggage, accidents, injuries and illness.
- 8.3.3 Should there be any amendment to the date and duration of travel, it is Customer's responsibility to inform the travel insurance company to amend the date and duration of the insurance coverage.
- 8.3.4 The Company will be pleased to assist in the enquiries of any travel insurance and related matters.
- 8.4 **Travel Vouchers**
The Company issues travel vouchers from time to time as part of its promotional activities. The Terms and Conditions for the redemption of travel vouchers are clearly spelt out in the appropriate documents and shall be binding on the Customer.
- 9. GENERAL MATTERS RELATING TO TOURS**
- 9.1 **Accommodation**
Accommodation is as specified in the tour brochure / itinerary / tour booking form. In the event the specified accommodation is not available, every effort will be made to scout for an alternative in another accommodation of similar standard. Hotel room sizes, facilities and services may vary in different country. Accommodation for adults is based on twin-share, double or triple-share bedroom. Different room type might not be on the same level. Single room occupancy is at additional cost.
- 9.1.1 Room size is generally slightly smaller than you may be used to. Space is precious commodity in Europe and especially in its busiest cities. Many of the buildings will have been in existence for hundreds of years and were not built with the modern traveller in mind. The upside is that usually they are in excellent locations and have a fascinating story to tell.
- 9.1.2 Bed sizes may also differ. In Europe King and Queen – sized beds are very rare. Here double beds are the norm and you may often find that a double room consists of two single beds pushed together instead of a full bed but made up with one set of linen. You may also find that twin beds will be placed very close together.
- 9.1.3 A triple room is the same size as twin bedded room. The third bed is always a roll-away bed or sofa bed added into the room. As a result, you may feel the room is very cramped and small.
- 9.1.4 Europeans are very socially and environmentally conscious and especially the air conditioning in Europe. During Autumn and Winter seasons, the central air-condition is off in the hotel rooms. So, do not expect the air-condition is switch on in the room. You may open windows to let cold air in if applicable.
- 9.2 **Special Request**

- 11.1 The Company acts as agent for the carriers, transportation companies, hotels and other principals of the tour packages. The Company accepts no responsibility for any injuries, losses, damages, accidents, flight cancellation, delays, theft, quarantine, customs regulations, strikes, weather hazards, political unrest, changes in itineraries, deportation or refusal of entry by Immigration Authorities resulting from improper travel documents, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may be caused to person or property. Any losses and/or expenses incurred are the responsibility of the passenger. All proper travel documentation is the sole responsibility of the Customer.
- 11.2 The failure of the Customer to follow reasonable instructions, including but not limited to check-in and check-out places or times or other cause and the losses and/or expenses resulting therefore shall be borne by the Customer.
- 11.3 The Company reserves the right to:
- 11.3.1 Alter tour itineraries, travel arrangements, accommodation due to unforeseen changes.
- 11.3.2 Cancel any reservations prior to departure for reasons, including but not limited to the insufficient number of participants. The Company will recommend alternative tours, preferably to the same destination or to other destination. Should the Customer decided not to accept the alternatives, the deposit or tour fare to be refunded without further obligation on the part of the Company, upon Customer's surrender to the Company of all documents issued by the Company for the purpose of the tour package.
- 11.3.3 Require any individual to withdraw from the tour if it is deemed that his/her behaviour is detrimental to or incompatible with the health, safety, interests, harmony and welfare of the other tour participants and the tour group as a whole. Under such circumstances, the Company shall be under no liability thereafter to any such person.
- 11.3.4 To specify the language in which the tour guide will conduct commentary in.
- 11.4 No tour guides, tour managers, tour leaders or other employees or agents of the Company are authorised to commit the Company to any liability and the Company shall not be bound by any statement or representation unless it is in writing and signed by a Management Executive of the Company.
- 11.5 All verbal agreements must be stated in writing and to be duly signed by the Manager.
- 11.6 The Company reserves the right to take photographs and films of the passenger while on tour with the Company, to be used for brochures advertising or publicity material without obtaining any further consent from the passenger.
- 11.7 All tour fares for the respective tour packages are correct at the time of reservation. The Company reserves the right to revise the tour fares and to determine the date of commencement of such revised tour fares.
- 12. COMPLAINT & CLAIM**
If you have a problem during your holidays please inform EU Holidays Tour Manager or local supplier immediately, who will try to make things right.
