Discover Sights as Old as Time

Steeped in natural beauty and architectural wonders that encapsulate ancient civilizations, Mexico is a cultural capital that offers views of dramatic sceneries of age-old monuments amidst lush greenery. Embark on an adventure to this idyllic North American country and discover the archaic mysteries that have stood the test of time. Although the site was inhabited between 100 B.C. and 650 A.D. the original inhabitants who occupied this pyramid city is unknown. When the Aztecs arrived on the Mexican Central Plateau in the early 14th century, they came across the abandoned ruins and called it Teotihuacan - the place where gods were born. Visitors exploring the site can climb the 243 steps to the top of the Pyramid of the Sun, and be enthralled by the structures erected close-by such as the Temple of Quetzalpapalotl, the Avenue of the Dead and the buildings surrounding them.

Mexico, Mexico City Xochimilco

Located just 28 km south of Mexico City, Xochimilco seems like the last place that you'd stumble upon when travelling through Mexico. Dubbed the "Venice of Mexico" this district is perfect for travellers looking for some respite from the densely populated and bustling capital. There are various points of interest in Xochimilco, but its most notable and by far the most popular is taking a leisurely ride on the colourfully painted and decorated *trajineras* - a traditional flat-bottomed boat. Similar to the gondolas in Venice, the boat is operated by a local, who will steer the boat at a relaxing pace. As you make your way down the canals, you will find yourself amongst boats with musicians playing live music. Be entertained by the lively beats of mariachi trios and marimba players as you take in the sights of the district. Do note that the cost of a ride goes by the hour for a boat, be wary of guides who quote a price for each person.

Teotihuacan

Built between the 1st and the 7th century, the holy city of Teotihuacan towers over the region and makes an exceptional addition to the dramatic scenery surrounding it. Interestingly enough, vast monuments such as the Temple of Quetzalcoatl and the Pyramids of the Sun and the Moon, are laid out according to geometric and symbolic principles.

Pyramids of the Sun and Moon

The Pyramid of the Sun is the largest man-made structure in Teotihuacan. Believed to have been utilised for religious and sacrificial purposes, the pyramid was built over a cave – which was considered the “womb of the universe”. Steeped in religious significance, the spot determined the alignment of the city. You might be a little intimidated by the 248 steps leading to the top, but the stunning vista that awaits you is worth the climb. Once reaching the top, you’ll have an unhindered and panoramic view of the Pyramid of the Moon and the Avenue of the Dead. While the Pyramid of the Sun is the largest structure in Teotihuacan, the Pyramid of the Moon follows behind, taking second place. Named by the Aztecs who were reportedly the first to discover the Teotihuacan, the pyramid much like its counterpart, is where sacrificial rituals took place. As the first pyramid to be built on the site, the approach to building the structure was similar to the mechanics of a *Russian Matryoshka nesting doll* – each pyramid was built over by another larger pyramid for each of the seven stages.

Mexico, Cancun Chichen Itza

Steeped in history – a thousand years to be precise – Chichen Itza remains as one of the greatest Mayan centres in history. At first sight, it may seem as though all the pyramids and temples are scattered about the site without any real purpose or pre-planning. However, this can’t be farther from the truth; the layout of the structures reflects specific astronomical events. How the Mayans were attuned to these cosmic events without the aid of any advanced technology still boggles the minds of many astronomers to this day. The place becomes especially significant during the March Spring Equinox, when the sun hits the nine main terraces at an odd angle creating an undulating shadow to slither along the side of the temple’s northern staircase.



Havana, Cuba

Cuba, Havana

As Cuba’s capital, Havana enchants many with its old town charm and quaint offerings. Apart from the city’s artistic allure and tumultuous past, Havana’s populace, although having lived through the hardest of times in history, exudes a hospitable and inviting demeanour to receptive travellers. Havana is renowned for its seemingly out-of-place old-school American cars that can be found throughout the city. Due to the ban on foreign imports placed by the late president, Fidel Castro, the residents have been unable to buy brand-new, foreign-made vehicles. Fortunately, this has worked in Havana’s favour. Take a ride in one of these American convertibles when exploring the city – a must if you’re looking to make the most out of your trip.

Cuba, Pinar Del Rio

In contrast to the vibrant capital of Havana, Pinar Del Rio has a subtle charm that grows overtime. The city’s main draw is its proximity to Vinales, a prominent destination known for being the highest – and the best, as far as quality goes – tobacco producing regions in Cuba. Find out more about the production process of Cuba’s famous cigars at the Cigar Factory, and if you’re parched for a drink wrap up your tour with a visit to the Rum Factory – where you’ll get an opportunity to taste the strong yet exquisite Cuban Rum. Apart from indulging in Cuba’s best produces, you might also want to explore the *Cueva del Indio* (Cave of the Indian), situated 8 km north of Vinales. Named after the Guanahatabey Amerindians – natives of the region – the *Cueva del Indio* boasts the largest system of underground caves in Cuba.

Machu Picchu

1 Dominating all others, the most enthralling spot in all of South America is Machu Picchu. Dating back to the 15th century, the ancient site is allegedly the last Incan city in Peru. Its primeval presence will transport you into the mysterious world of yesteryear. To reach the ruins, you would have to journey 2,430m above the sea level to the top of the mountain. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, the abandoned grounds blend into the steep, rocky terrain and green plains. To get the best views, head to the highest point for a panorama of the almost systematically placed rows of stonewalls.

TOP 5 Most Breath-taking Sights in South America

In Latin America, home to such nations as Brazil, Argentina, Chile and Peru, there is no shortage of beauty, both natural and manufactured. We provide you with a run-down of the most picturesque attractions in the continent that promises to take your breath away.



Iguazu Falls

5 Straddling between the border of Brazil and Argentina is the arc-shaped waterfall, Iguazu Falls. The gargantuan natural landmark spans an impressive 2,700m across from end to end, making it one of the world's largest cataracts. Watch in awe as the curtain of water cascade down an 80m distance. A train ride takes you to the waterfall, but if you prefer to be airborne, you can hop on to a helicopter as well. Found in the heart of the Iguazu National Park, it is enveloped in dense greenery, which also makes for an impressive sight. Diverse and eye-catching, the wildlife there, such as howler monkeys, jaguars and tapirs, can be easily spotted.



Uyuni Salt Flats

2 At 10,582sqkm, Bolivia's Uyuni Salt Flats is the largest of its kind in the world. Unlike the sand dunes of the Ica Desert, this vast stretch of land has a level surface coated with a snowy white salt crust. What's more, the unbelievably breath-taking panorama looks like a giant mirror that reflects the sky, hence creating the illusion of a reduced gap between the Earth and sky.

Torres Del Paine

3 Coming in third is the Torres del Paine National Park in Chile. Picturesque mountains and glaciers, almost too impressive to seem real, sit among winding rivers and lakes. The protected area may be populated with stunning flora and fauna, but the show-stealer remains to be the trio of mountain peaks known as Torres del Paine, the park's namesake. Other odd-shaped, snow-capped Alps command attention as well.



Ica Desert

4 Venture towards southern Peru and you will find the city of Ica, within which lies the renowned Ica Desert. An endless landscape of sand dunes dipping in and out of the horizon, the barren land is not a sight commonly seen in urban cities. Take advantage of the soft terrain to do some sandboarding or roam around in sand buggies. Don't forget to make a pit stop at Huacachina, a puny village in the Ica Region, a lone settlement surrounded by the expanse of sand. The spectacular desert oasis, built around a lake, is surprisingly inhabited by only a hundred over people.

Enjoy a full-day excursion of this surreal, natural landscape, with its expansive crystalline terrain, colourful lagoons, surrounding mountain ranges and volcanoes. You will visit the famous **Train Cemetery**, **Tunupa Volcano lookout**, **salt water springs**, and observe bizarre stone formations sculpted by wind erosion.

Important: Rainy season is from Nov to Apr, if there is water on the Salt Pans, transportation will not be able to enter. However, we will get as close as possible and still the view will be beautiful, especially because the Salt Pans becomes a giant mirror that reflects colors from the sky

The highlight of your journey today will be the rocky outcrop of **Isla Incahuasi**, with unusual rock formations and a forest of giant cacti, situated in the middle of **Salar de Uyuni**, the world's largest salt flat. On the way visit the **Altiplanic Lagoons: Kañapa, Hedionda, Ch'iyar Quta** and **Ramaditas**, each one of them with a different colour due to the different minerals of the zone. With luck, you will be able to spot flamingos and other wildlife in the area.

Breakfast, Box Lunch

After breakfast, visit the Siloli Desert where it is possible to see an interesting rocky formation known as **Stone Tree**. Enter the **National Reserve of Andean Fauna Eduardo Avaroa** and visit the **Laguna Colorada** (Red Lagoon) that is very impressive for its red colour, due to a fine reddish sediment accumulation in the surface, as well as the pigmentation of certain type of seaweed. This lagoon is populated by three species of flamingos. The trip continues towards **Sol de Mañana**, this is a place where it is possible to appreciate fumes, geysers and volcanic holes. The final part of the descent leads us to the **Laguna Verde** (Green Lagoon). Looking like a giant emerald, it is framed by Licancabur Volcano. Its intense green colour is due to its high magnesium content. Return to Uyuni in time for your flight back to La Paz.

DAY 11

Breakfast, Meals on Board

Tour Booking Terms and Conditions (Full version)

You and your traveling companions are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following Terms and Conditions. EU Holidays Pte Ltd shall be referred to as "the Company" in the following:

1. RESERVATION, DEPOSIT & FULL PAYMENT

1.1 If your minimum deposit is less than the required amount, kindly top up the difference within the next two (2) days.

- 1.2 Payment of deposit does not constitute confirmation of the tour. All group tours are subject to a minimum group size (as determined by the Company) in order for the confirmation to be effected and for the departure to be finalised.
- 1.3 Full payment is required no later than twenty one (21) days prior to departure. In case of tours in peak season, full payment must be made one month before departure. If full payment is not received by the stipulated deadline, the Company reserves the right to forfeit the deposit and cancel the reservation. In such an event, the cancellation fee as stated in Section 2 is payable by the Customer.
- 1.4 By making deposit and balance payment, it is deemed that you have read, understood and accepted the Tour Booking Terms and Conditions in the booking form.
- 1.5 The Company reserves the right to request for a top-up on initial deposit for immediate issuance of air tickets, to avoid incurring additional surcharges.
- 1.6 Customers must top-up the deposits for ticket issuance as and when the air-tickets are required to be issued by the airlines at the stipulated deadline without prior notice. Failure to do so, the Company has the right to cancel the tour and the deposit will be forfeited.
- 1.7 Any amendment within **fourteen (14) days** or after tickets issued, amendment fee would be the same as cancellation fee stipulated in the Terms and Conditions.

2. CANCELLATION BY THE CUSTOMER

- 2.1 Cancellation of booking must be made in writing or in person to avoid any misunderstanding.
- 2.2 The following cancellation fees apply once any group tour package booking is made:

- 2.3 The above cancellation fees apply if the air-tickets are not issued. If the air-tickets are issued, the value of the air-tickets will be added onto the cancellation fees. Company deserve the right to issue air ticket without prior notice. If the deposit amount is insufficient to cover the cancellation fee, the Customers must pay for the difference.
- 2.4 'Working days' refers to Monday to Friday excluding public holidays.
- 2.5 For Free and Easy packages, administrative fees and / or one (1) night hotel rate will be imposed for those travel documents not issued. Once

issuance of travel documents, changes will not be allowed and has no refund value.

3. CANCELLATION BY THE COMPANY

- 3.1 The Company acts as an agent for service suppliers. After deposit or full payment has been made, all arrangements are still subject to final confirmation by service suppliers. At times due to low subscription for a group tour, the Company may choose to cancel the entire tour fourteen (14) days prior to departure.
- 3.2 The Company shall also not be held liable for any contingent costs incurred by the Customer arising from the cancellation.
- 3.3 The Company may recommend alternative tours either to the same destination or other tours, based on the current tour fare of that cancellation period. All prior special discounts given will be not extended for the alternative tours. Should the Customer decide not to accept the alternatives, a full refund on the amount paid by the Customer will be made accordingly by the Company without further obligation or liabilities on the part of the Company and that the Customers shall be deemed to have agreed to release the Company from all liabilities or damages in connection with the cancellation. There shall be no claim for inconvenience, loss of leave and transportation cost due to the cancellation of tour.

4. REFUND POLICY

- 4.1 No refund will be made with respect to accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours or any other services included in the tour fare but not utilised by the Customer, either in part or full, or when the Customer amends, cancels or otherwise changes in any arrangement after commencement of the tour
- 4.2 All refund will be made within fourteen (14) working days in a form of cheque. For credit card payment, refund will be made through the credit card company.
- 4.3 Air tickets with refund value will only be refunded to Customers within fourteen (14) working days after the respective airlines have refunded to the Company. The standard processing period for air tickets refund varies from three (3) to six (6) months (subject to individual airlines).
- 4.4 During peak period, the refund process may be longer due to increase in transactions.

5. AMENDMENT TO BOOKINGS (REQUESTED BY PASSENGERS)

- 5.1 For any changes in departure date or tour type, cancellation fees apply as listed under **Section 2** on Cancellation by the Customer.
- 5.2 For every request made regardless of whether any previous amendment was confirmed by airlines, hotel or otherwise, there will be a minimum fee of \$250.00 per person per amendment. This does not include any other fees imposed by the airlines, ground operator or hotel.
- 5.3 A postponement of tour by Customers for any reason is considered as cancellation. Under such circumstances, the above Cancellation Policies will apply accordingly.
- 5.4 Any change made by the Customer to the existing booking must be in writing or in person at least fourteen (14) days before the tour, after which strictly NO amendments allowed, or cancellation fee applies.
- 5.5 Any replacement or changes of passengers will be considered as a cancellation and not an amendment. This term is applicable to all cases, including but not restricted to the medical and the pregnancy cases.

6. AMENDMENT TO TOUR ITINERARY BY COMPANY

The Company makes reasonable effort to avoid changes in the itinerary. However, the Company reserves the right to make minor changes at any time due to unforeseen circumstances, especially during peak periods or in the event of other circumstances beyond our control.

7. EXTENSION OF STAY / DEVIATION

- 7.1 Extension of stay may be permitted at the end of tour, subject to the restriction of the air ticket, seat

availability and hotel confirmation prior to the commencement of the tour. **All requests must be made before issuance of air tickets.** If the extension of stay / deviation is unable to be confirmed three (3) weeks prior to the group's departure date, the passenger is deemed to stick to the original tour schedule. In the event that the original schedule has been changed by the Company, any extra cost will be borne by the Customer.

- 7.2 Cancellation fee is also applicable if the Customer cancels the booking due to extension / deviation is unable to confirm prior to departure.
- 7.3 Extension of stay / deviation will be at passenger's own expenses and transfer to the airport will not be provided.
- 7.4 It is the Customer's responsibility to hold firm confirmation of their return flight and to re-confirm their flight 72 hours prior to their return date.
- 7.5 The air ticket issued is a special ticket, restricted to specific airline only. It is non-negotiable, non-endorsable, non-reissuable, non-refundable & non-reroutable. Any alteration in routing or dates by the Customer is solely at his/her own risk. The Company and its associated agents will not be held responsible for any inconvenience caused and extra expenses incurred. No refunds will be made for any unused air ticket, accommodation, meals, or sightseeing in part or full.

8. TRAVEL DOCUMENTS, TRAVEL INSURANCE & TRAVEL VOUCHERS

- 8.1 **Passport and other Travel Documents**
It is Customer's sole responsibility to ensure that he / she has a valid passport with minimum six (6) months validity from the date of scheduled return to Singapore, as well as the necessary visas, vaccinations, health certificates and all necessary travel documents as required by various government authorities of the destinations of travel.
- 8.2 **Visa**
The Customer may seek advice from the Company on visa application; however, it is Customer's own responsibility to obtain a valid visa.
- 8.2.1 If for any reason, application for visa or exit permit is rejected, full refund less \$250.00 administrative fee (excluding visa application fees paid to the respective embassies) will be made if the result of the rejection is submitted to the Company at least forty five (45) days prior to departure. If less than forty five (45) days notice is given, relevant cancellation fee as stated under section Cancellation by the Customer will be applied.
- 8.2.2 It is customer responsibility to check that multi-entry Visas have the correct entry dates and destinations before travelling. Please be aware that some itineraries you may travel through a country without making an overnight stop but still require a VISA to enter/exit
- 8.2.3 In consideration for the interests of other passengers in the same group, the Company strongly discourages ALL passengers from applying Visa Upon Arrival at destiny country. The Company takes no responsibility being unable to wait for the passengers who apply Visa Upon Arrival at the Custom.
- 8.2.4 The Company will not be responsible for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of the tour fare if the Customer is deported or refused entry by immigration authorities on the tour for whatever reasons, including improper travel documents, quarantine, custom regulations, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may cause harm or damage to person or property.
- 8.2.5 For non-Singapore passport holders, please request the Company to check on Visa requirements. The Company renders assistance in Visa application wherever possible. The Company cannot, however, guarantee the approval of such Visa application. This service is subject to (auxiliary) fees. Please check with the Company on the amount.
- 8.3 **Travel Insurance**
- 8.3.1 Arrangement of travel insurance coverage is strongly recommended with respect to unforeseen circumstances such as flight

- cancellation, trip cancellation, loss of deposit, baggage, personal accident, injury, illness, etc. Under no circumstances shall the Company be construed as a carrier under a contract for safe carriage of the Customer or his / her baggage and other personal belongings.
- 8.3.2 The Company shall not be responsible for any loss or damage in relation to flight cancellation, trip cancellation, loss of personal baggage, accidents, injuries and illness.
- 8.3.3 Should there be any amendment to the date and duration of travel, it is Customer's responsibility to inform the travel insurance company to amend the date and duration of the insurance coverage.
- 8.3.4 The Company will be pleased to assist in the enquiries of any travel insurance and related matters.
- 8.4 **Travel Vouchers**
The Company issues travel vouchers from time to time as part of its promotional activities. The Terms and Conditions for the redemption of travel vouchers are clearly spelt out in the appropriate documents and shall be binding on the Customer.
- 9. GENERAL MATTERS RELATING TO TOURS**
- 9.1 **Accommodation**
Accommodation is as specified in the tour brochure / itinerary / tour booking form. In the event the specified accommodation is not available, every effort will be made to scout for an alternative in another accommodation of similar standard. Hotel room sizes, facilities and services may vary in different country. Accommodation for adults is based on twin-share, double or triple-share bedroom. Different room type might not be on the same level. Single room occupancy is at additional cost.
- 9.1.1 Room size is generally slightly smaller than you may be used to. Space is precious commodity in Europe and especially in its busiest cities. Many of the buildings will have been in existence for hundreds of years and were not built with the modern traveller in mind. The upside is that usually they are in excellent locations and have a fascinating story to tell.
- 9.1.2 Bed sizes may also differ. In Europe King and Queen – sized beds are very rare. Here double beds are the norm and you may often find that a double room consists of two single beds pushed together instead of a full bed but made up with one set of linen. You may also find that twin beds will be placed very close together.
- 9.1.3 A triple room is the same size as twin bedded room. The third bed is always a roll-away bed or sofa bed added into the room. As a result, you may feel the room is very cramped and small.
- 9.1.4 Europeans are very socially and environmentally conscious and especially the air conditioning in Europe. During Autumn and Winter seasons, the central air-condition is off in the hotel rooms. So, do not expect the air-condition is switch on in the room. You may open windows to let cold air in if applicable.
- 9.2 **Special Request**
If there are any requests regarding special meals, dietary requirements, adjoining rooms, flight seating arrangement and so on, please inform the Company upon booking. However, such requests are strictly subject to confirmation and availability by the airlines/hotels. There is No halal meal on tour.
- 9.3 **Baggage**
Normally customer is allowed check-in baggage not exceeding twenty (20) kilograms. Only one piece of hand luggage not exceeding seven (7) kilograms is allowed on board the aircraft. Excess baggage must be paid directly by the Customer. Depending on individual airline company policy.
- 9.4 **Meals**
- 9.4.1 Meals, including meals on board flights, are as indicated in the tour brochure / itinerary / tour booking form. If meals on board are not served due to whatever reasons, there shall be no refund or replacement.
- 9.4.2 You and your travelling companions will generally dine together at a designated time. Table will often vary in size and free seating enables you to dine with family members or new travelling companions each evening. A breakfast buffet is included daily and will reflect the local regions tastes and culture. Very occasionally, an early departure may result in a light breakfast box for you to take away if applicable. Lunches are sometimes included but are usually an opportunity for the guest to enjoy some free time to visit a local café, bar or restaurant and eat where the locals do. Your tour manager will be able to provide you with range of options to suit all tastes and preferences.
- 9.5 **Seat Rotation**
For the convenience of all members of the group, passengers may be requested to rotate their seating arrangements on the coach during the period of the tour. Please cooperate when requested upon to do so by the tour manager / tour leader / guide.
- 9.6 **Motor-coach**
For selected itinerary - Wifi on coach using 3G mobile network, it means that connection is slower than standard broadband and at times may not be available. It is good for checking emails, web browsing and updating social media accounts, but less so for streaming video or large photo uploads.
- 9.7 **Single Supplement**
For occupation of a single room, single supplement amount as indicated in the booking form is required.
- 9.8 **Suggested Excursion**
Optional list may be subject to change, depending on the time you are travelling or local circumstances including weather and days of the week. Further information will be provided by your Tour Manager / Guides during the tour
- 10. PRICING POLICIES**
- 10.1 **Tour Fare Includes**
Return economy class group tour air ticket, local transport, accommodation, admission fees, meals and sightseeing programme as stipulated in the tour brochure / itinerary / tour booking form.
- 10.2 **Tour Fare Excludes**
Airport taxes, airport security taxes, airline insurance surcharges, fuel taxes, visa fees, travel insurance, customs user fees as specified by the airlines and airport authorities; local transfer not stated in the itinerary (e.g. free & easy, deviation), laundry, excess baggage charges, beverages, room services, gratuities to drivers and tour managers / local guides and tips to hotel porters (if any); and personal expenses. Please refer to the Company for visa fees, gratuities to drivers and tour managers / local guides, and tips to hotel porters.
- 10.3 **Cancellation Fee**
For Clause 2 – Cancellation By The Customers - tour fare refers to selling tour fare plus airport taxes, airport security taxes, airline insurance surcharges and fuel taxes.
- 10.4 **Child Fare**
Child fare is applicable to children below twelve (12) years old on the scheduled date of departure & departure date from Singapore. The child fare is based on a twin-sharing accommodation with two adults and no additional bed will be provided. A surcharge will be imposed where an extra bed is required for the child or where the child occupies a room with only one adult.
- 10.5 **Mode of Payment**
Payment may be made in cash, by NETS, PAYNOW, AXS, cheques or credit cards. Cheques will only be accepted if presented to the Company at least seven (7) working days before scheduled tour departure. Credit card payment may incur additional surcharge for special promotion packages, you may refer to our staff for confirmation. Overseas Bank transfer may incur additional surcharge and to be borne by the Customer.
- 11. RESPONSIBILITY**
- 11.1 The Company acts as agent for the carriers, transportation companies, hotels and other principals of the tour packages. The Company accepts no responsibility for any injuries, losses, damages, accidents, flight cancellation, delays, theft, quarantine, customs regulations, strikes, weather hazards, political unrest, changes in itineraries, deportation or refusal of entry by Immigration Authorities resulting from improper travel documents, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may be caused to person or property. Any losses and/or expenses incurred are the responsibility of the passenger. All proper travel documentation is the sole responsibility of the Customer.
- 11.2 The failure of the Customer to follow reasonable instructions, including but not limited to check-in and check-out places or times or other cause and the losses and/or expenses resulting therefore shall be borne by the Customer.
- 11.3 The Company reserves the right to:
- 11.3.1 Alter tour itineraries, travel arrangements, accommodation due to unforeseen changes.
- 11.3.2 Cancel any reservations prior to departure for reasons, including but not limited to the insufficient number of participants. The Company will recommend alternative tours, preferably to the same destination or to other destination. Should the Customer decided not to accept the alternatives, the deposit or tour fare to be refunded without further obligation on the part of the Company, upon Customer's surrender to the Company of all documents issued by the Company for the purpose of the tour package.
- 11.3.3 Require any individual to withdraw from the tour if it is deemed that his/her behaviour is detrimental to or incompatible with the health, safety, interests, harmony and welfare of the other tour participants and the tour group as a whole. Under such circumstances, the Company shall be under no liability thereafter to any such person.
- 11.3.4 To specify the language in which the tour guide will conduct commentary in.
- 11.4 No tour guides, tour managers, tour leaders or other employees or agents of the Company are authorised to commit the Company to any liability and the Company shall not be bound by any statement or representation unless it is in writing and signed by a Management Executive of the Company.
- 11.5 All verbal agreements must be stated in writing and to be duly signed by the Manager.
- 11.6 The Company reserves the right to take photographs and films of the passenger while on tour with the Company, to be used for brochures advertising or publicity material without obtaining any further consent from the passenger.
- 11.7 All tour fares for the respective tour packages are correct at the time of reservation. The Company reserves the right to revise the tour fares and to determine the date of commencement of such revised tour fares.
- 12. COMPLAINT & CLAIM**
If you have a problem during your holidays please inform EU Holidays Tour Manager or local supplier immediately, who will try to make things right. If the matter was not resolved locally, please write to EU holidays Feedback department in writing within seven (7) days from the date of return. It is important to provide us the information quickly. Please quote you booking reference number and all relevant information. Failure to follow this procedure may delay or deny us the opportunity to investigate and rectify the problem, which may affect the way your complaint is dealt with and your rights under this contract.
- 13. MISCELLANEOUS**
The Company reserves the right to change, amend, insert or delete any Tour Booking Terms and Conditions containing in this document, as the case may be, without prior notice. The Tour Booking Terms and Conditions complement those Terms and Conditions contained in the relevant documents provided by third (3rd) party service providers such as airlines or cruise tickets, hotel check-ins etc.
