出发前往杜塞尔多夫
机上用餐
集合于机场, 办理登记手续乘搭豪华客机飞往杜塞尔多夫。

第2天
杜塞尔多夫 ▶ 罗滕堡 ▶ 比尔森
机上用餐/晚餐
抵达后, 继续前往有『中世纪宝石』美誉的 - 罗滕堡, 市内完整无缺的中世纪街道、住家, 在欧洲仍属罕见, 一进城门仿若穿越时光隧道, 进入中古世纪浪漫的世界。漫步于古色古香之市街风情。续程驱车前往黄金啤酒的故乡-比尔森, 《世界原本一片黑暗, 直到1842年后开始发光, 因为皮尔森创造了黄金啤酒》! 这虽然是一句广告词, 却也道出了皮尔森啤酒在捷克人心中崇高的地位。

第3天
比尔森 ▶ 布拉格
早餐/晚餐
前往有“百塔之城”的布拉格也是捷克共和国的首都。近距离看看著名的布拉格城堡和其中的标志性建筑 - 布拉格的精神象征圣维特大教堂, 保存最完好的罗马式教堂圣乔治大教堂和旧皇宫。十字标志性的查理大桥, 然后继续进入旧城区的天文钟, 是城市的镇馆之宝之一。然后进入布拉格的最后一站 - 瓦茨拉夫广场, 一个布拉格充满活力的社会和商业中心。您也可以自费选择参观温泉之旅的温泉小镇卡罗维利瓦利享受他们著名的治疗热温泉理疗。

第4天
布拉格 ▶ 布拉迪斯拉发
早餐/晚餐
前往布拉迪斯拉发-是斯洛伐克共和国的首都和最大城市。布拉迪斯拉发位于斯洛伐克西南部, 多瑙河的左畔, 紧邻奥地利和匈牙利两国边境, 是世界上唯一与邻国接壤的首都。徒步游览布拉迪斯拉发包括: 老城, 布拉迪斯拉发城堡, 宫殿格拉萨科维茨, 大主教宫殿。

第5天
布拉迪斯拉发 ▶ 布达佩斯
早餐/晚餐
前往匈牙利的首都-布达佩斯。通过导游的带领认识布达佩斯真正的文化, 布达佩斯也被称为“温泉城市”。参观的第一站是著名的马加什教堂, 是布达佩斯最古老的建筑现今已有700多年的历史, 壁画是著名的匈牙利画家作品之一。接下来, 启程到下一个景点-盖勒特山。鸟瞰整个城市的最佳点。继续前往渔人城堡的观赏塔楼美丽的景色, 介于壮丽的英雄广场和世纪坛中间, 沿着时尚购物街 - 瓦茨街逛逛。下午友情推荐可以自费乘搭游船游览于多瑙河观看两岸美丽的景色。

第6天
布达佩斯 ▶ 维也纳
早餐/晚餐
从匈牙利出发前往音乐之都—维也纳, 也是奥地利的首都。(友情建议可以自费前往著名的直销工厂, 享受购物乐趣)。抵达后, 停围绕着环城大道观赏其丰富的公园和纪念碑, 国家歌剧院, 雄伟的国会大厦和市政厅和霍夫堡皇宫。最后参观最重要的哥特式结构, 在奥地利著名的圣斯蒂芬大教堂。晚上友情推荐可以自费观赏维也纳的音乐会, 在任何一个著名的音乐厅享受充满音乐的夜晚。

第7天
维也纳 ▶ 萨尔斯堡 ▶ 慕尼黑
早餐/午餐
出发前往萨尔斯堡。游览著名电影“音乐之声”在萨尔斯堡市的优美景色。华尔兹通过米拉贝尔宫郁郁葱葱的花园, 并参观著名的古典音乐神童莫扎特的诞生地, 位于9号的粮食胡同。继续在步行游览萨尔斯堡老城欣赏巴洛克和中世纪建筑的合奏, 以及宏伟小区广场落以其美丽的喷泉。继续前往慕尼黑 - 巴伐利亚州的首府。

第8天
慕尼黑 ▶ 海德堡 ▶ 杜塞尔多夫

抵达后续驱车前往位于内卡河畔古城与大学交织而成的文化都市-海德堡。随后浏览古城, 在此一弥漫啤酒芳香及爱情恋曲的古城中, 寻找传说中学生王子的踪影。继续前往塞尔多夫, 是德国西部以其时尚界和艺术界闻名的城市。它是由莱茵河区分成东岸的现代商业区和西部的老城区。在老城区徒步游览13世纪的圣兰波杜斯教堂和城堡塔。稍后在国王大道享受购物的乐趣。



DAY 1 DEPARTURE TO DUSSELDORF

Meals On Board

Assemble at Airport for our maiden flight to Dusseldorf, where your holiday will begin!

DAY 2 DUSSELDORF > ROTHENBURG OB DER TAUBER > PILSEN

Meals On Board, Dinner

Upon arrival, transfer to **Rothenburg ob der Tauber**. Rothenburg ob der Tauber is a **German** town in northern **Bavaria** known for its medieval architecture. Half-timbered houses line the cobblestone lanes of its old town. The town walls include many preserved gatehouses and towers, plus a covered walkway on top. St. Jakob's Church houses an intricate, late Gothic altarpiece by woodcarver Tilman Riemenschneider. The medieval Town Hall has a tower with panoramic views. Continue to **Plzeň**, also called **Pilsen** in English and German, a city in Western **Bohemia**, which is also the fourth most populous city in the **Czech Republic**.

DAY 3 PILSEN > PRAGUE

Breakfast, Dinner

Begin with a half-day walking tour of the city nicknamed the 'City of a Hundred Spires'. Get an up-close look at the famous **Prague Castle** and the symbolic structures housed within it – the state's spiritual symbol **St. Vitus Cathedral**, the best preserved **Romanesque**

church **St. George's Basilica** and the **Old Royal Palace**. Cross the iconic **Charles Bridge** and proceed into the **Old Town** for a glimpse of the **Astronomical Clock**, one of the greatest treasures of the city. Then head towards the last stop of the day – **Wenceslas Square**, the vibrant social and commercial centre of Prague. You may also wish to make an optional trip to a famous spa town – **Karlovy Vary**.

DAY 4 PRAGUE > BRATISLAVA

Breakfast, Dinner

Journey to **Bratislava**, the political, economic and cultural centre of **Slovakia**, and along the way, you may wish to make an optional pit stop at the **Designer Outlet Parndorf** near **Vienna** for a spot of shopping. Set off on a sightseeing tour of the city's main attractions – visit the Old Town for a view of some of the oldest historical buildings, the unique **Bratislava Castle** that resembles an upturned table atop a hill, the **Grassalkovich Palace** which is the current seat of the **President of Slovakia**, and the most beautiful building in Bratislava, the renowned **Primate's Palace**.

DAY 5 BRATISLAVA > BUDAPEST

Breakfast, Dinner

Get to know the true culture of **Budapest**, also known as the 'City of Baths' through a guided city tour that will help you pack as much as possible into your exploration of the city. The first stop of the tour is the renowned **Matthias Church**, one of the oldest buildings in Budapest with over

700 years of history and frescoes done by famous Hungarian painters. Next, head up to **Gellért Hill** next for some of the best panoramic views of the entire city. Continue on to the impressive **Heroes' Square** and the **Millennium Monument** located in its middle, and stroll along the fashionable shopping street, **Váci Utca**. If time permits, you may wish to embark on an optional **Danube river cruise** that covers the most fascinating sights in Budapest.

DAY 6 BUDAPEST > VIENNA

Breakfast, Dinner

Continue to **Vienna** - the 'city of music' as the sun sets. Embark on a city tour of this romantic capital of **Austria**, Vienna. Continue to the glorious Ringstrasse with its wealth of parks and monuments, the **Vienna State Opera house**, the majestic **Reichsrat Parliament Building** and **Rathaus** (city hall); and the **Hofburg Imperial Palace**. Last but not least, end the day with a visit to one of the most important Gothic structures in Austria – **St. Stephen's Cathedral**. Along the way to Vienna, you may wish to visit the Designer Outlet Parndorf for a spot of shopping. We recommend attending a Concert show at any of the concert halls to conclude your evening.

DAY 7 VIENNA > SALZBURG > MUNICH

Breakfast, Lunch

Discover the beautiful setting of the famous film "The Sound of Music" in the city of Salzburg. Waltz through the lush gardens of **Mirabell Palace**, and visit the birthplace of famous classical music prodigy **Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart** at No. 9 **Getreidegasse**. Continue on the walking tour to the **Old Town** of Salzburg to admire the ensemble of baroque and medieval buildings, and drop by the magnificent **Residence Square** with its beautiful fountain. Transfer to **Munich** for your overnight stay.

DAY 8 MUNICH > HEIDELBERG > DUSSELDORF

Breakfast, Dinner

Arrive at **Heidelberg**, a town situated on the **Neckar River** in southwestern Germany, known for its distinguished 14th-century university. Visit the baroque **Altstadt** (Old Town) and to Dusseldorf - is a city in western Germany known for its fashion industry and art scene. It's divided by the **Rhine River**, with its **Old Town** on the East bank and its modern commercial areas to the west. In the Old Town, **St. Lambertus Church** and **Castle Tower** both date to the 13th century. Streets such as **Königsalle** are lined with boutiques.

DAY 9 DUSSELDORF

Breakfast, Meals on Board

Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure till it is time to transfer to the airport for your flight home.
