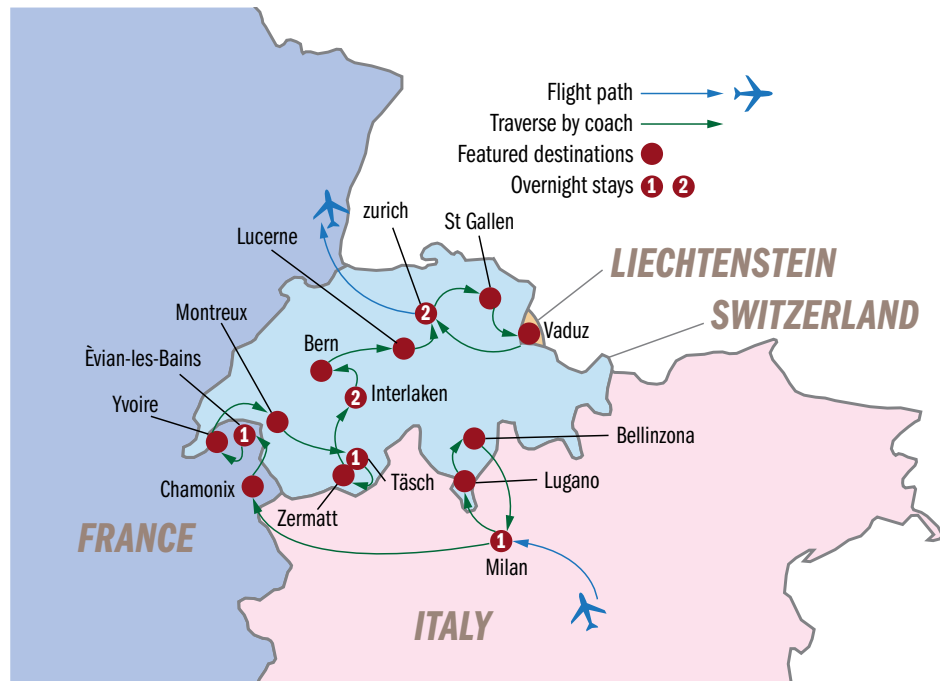

DAY 1

SINGAPORE > MILAN

Meals on Board

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and take-off to the fashion capital of Italy, Milan.

DAY 2

MILAN > BELLINZONA > LUGANO > MILAN

Meals on Board, Dinner – Chinese Fare

Start off the day by making your way to Bellinzona, the capital of Switzerland's Ticino region. Begin your tour in the Old Town of this Italianate city brimming with charming merchants' houses, stone gateways, alluring balconies with wrought iron railings and inn signs from a bygone era. Also, don't miss the impressive and majestic fortifications of castles Castelgrande, Castello di Montebello and Castello di Sasso Corbaro, which are listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Following that, proceed to Lugano for an orientation tour that covers a vast array of attractions including parks and flowers, museums, villas and Lombardy-styled buildings. Then, head back to Milan and embark on an exploration of the city led by a tour guide – see the majestic Sforza Castle, stop by the elaborate Gothic Milan Cathedral and the lavish La Scala Opera House for some pictures, and take a leisure stroll through the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II and Piazza della Scala – where a statue monument of Leonardo da Vinci is located.

DAY 3

MILAN > CHAMONIX > MONT BLANC > ÉVIAN-LES-BAINS

Breakfast, Lunch – Western Fare

Journey to the famous ski village, Chamonix, and get to the Aiguille du Midi peak via a cable car for a impressive view of Mont

Blanc, the highest mountain in the Alps and Western Europe. Embrace the magnificent views across the whole mountain range from 3842 metres above sea level. Take a "Step into the Void" on the Aiguille du Midi Skywalk for an arresting view down the highest attraction in Europe, and make sure to enter the glass room installation that allows for a thrilling experience of being suspended in air at a height of 1035 metres above the mountainside. Then, go on a jaunt to Évian-les-Bains, which is renowned for its Evian springs and source of the famous Evian mineral water.

DAY 4

ÉVIAN-LES-BAINS > YVOIRE > GENEVA > MONTREUX > TASCH

Breakfast, Dinner – Western Fare

Begin with a tour of Yvoire, a modest medieval village located on the shore of Lake Geneva. With 700 years of history, this hidden gem is not only classified as one of France's most beautiful villages, but also ranked as one of the International Laureates of Floral Decorations. Next, commence on a guided excursion of Geneva, where you get to check out the World Health Organization headquarters, the International Labour Organization, the headquarters of the International Committee of the Red Cross and the United Nations Office. Pay a visit to the Jet d'Eau and drop by the L'horloge fleurie, a massive clock decorated by seasonal floral arrangements. After that, head to Montreux for a visit to the Montreux Marché de Noël Christmas Market, where you can do some shopping or immerse yourself in the Christmas spirit and festivities. Proceed to Tasch for a good night's rest.

DAY 5 ZERMATT ▶ INTERLAKEN

Breakfast, Dinner – Swiss Fondue Combo

Zermatt – an old, idyllic village nestled in a deep valley enclosed between steeply scarp mountains and situated right at the foot of the Matterhorn, is your destination for this morning. A special, car-free place that is best explored on foot, Zermatt draws you in with its charming cobbled streets and lovely horse-drawn carriages – a scene straight out of a storybook. Explore the old part of the village, where you will find traditional barns, stores, stables and old houses constructed from larch timber with rock slab roofings and supported by stilts based on flat stone slabs. Then, enjoy some free time at leisure to explore Zermatt on your own. Thereafter, make your way to Interlaken for an orientation tour of the scenic resort town that is presided over by the mighty Mt. Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau. As night falls, indulge in a unique 4-course Swiss fondue combo dinner at the famous Swiss-themed Bebbis Restaurant.

DAY 6 INTERLAKEN ▶ GRINDELWALD ▶ INTERLAKEN

Breakfast

Prepare for a day filled with endless fun and activities as you board a specially designed Snow Bus for a comfortable ride up to Mt. Bussalp. Enjoy marvellous views of the Jungfrau's snowy peaks as you sledge through the various obstacle courses on the 7.6km long sledge run; the longest in Europe. You may also wish to embark on an optional scenic railway trip to Kleine Scheidegg mountain pass, a famous ski resort area, to

admire the passing scenic valleys and the Glacier Falls, as well as the iconic peaks of Mt. Eiger, Monch and Jungfrau.

DAY 7 INTERLAKEN ▶ BERN ▶ LUCERNE ▶ ZURICH REGION

Breakfast

Proceed to Bern, where you can enjoy an orientation tour of the city – explore its UNESCO World Heritage Site Old Town on foot and visit the Bear Pit, the astronomical clock tower Zytglogge and the Einstein House. Next, travel to Lucerne and embark on a tour to visit the Old Chapel Bridge – the oldest wooden bridge in Switzerland, the Old Town with its unspoiled buildings covered with colourful murals and the Lion Monument. Retire for the night at a scenic lakeside resort in Zurich.

DAY 8 ZURICH ▶ ST. GALLEN ▶ VADUZ ▶ ZURICH

Breakfast

Kick off the day with a trip down to St. Gallen – a charming, traffic-free metropolis situated in eastern Switzerland between Lake Constance and Appenzellerland. Make sure to visit their UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Abbey precinct with its famous Baroque cathedral and the Abbey Library, which is home to 170,000 old documents – some over a thousand years old – as well as Switzerland's most beautiful Rococo hall. St. Gallen is also well-known for its exquisite oriels and the unique Stadtlounge, an art project that transformed the Bleicheli district into a massive recreation space drenched in red. After which, move along to

Liechtenstein and enjoy a guided tour of its capital, Vaduz – a cultural treasure trove filled with impressive architecture and a variety of museums. View the statuesque Vaduz Castle, the neo-Gothic Cathedral of St. Florin and the Vaduz City Hall. Head back to your lakeside hotel to rest for the night.

DAY 9 ZURICH ▶ SINGAPORE

Breakfast, Meals on Board

Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure till it is time to transfer to the airport for your flight home.
