DAY 1 SINGAPORE ► VALENCIA

Meals on Board

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport and depart to Valencia, the third largest city of Spain.

DAY 2 VALENCIA

Meals on Board, Seafood Paella Dinner

Embark on a sightseeing tour of Valencia where you can admire the unique Gothic exterior of the Valencia Cathedral, and stop for some photos at the imposing Towers of Serrano or Cuarte that were designed as defensive structures along the old city walls. Enjoy a traditional Valencian seafood paella dinner before turning in for the night.

DAY 3 VALENCIA

Breakfast

You will have some free time to explore Valencia, take this opportunity to drop by the Central Market in Valencia for food items or souvenirs. You can also join an excursion to visit Peniscola and enjoy the wonderful scenery along the Mediterranean coast.

DAY 4 VALENCIA ► CUENCA ► MADRID

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Make your way to Cuenca, an ancient walled city located about 950 meters above sea level. Discover a UNESCO World Heritage designation in the region of Castilla-La Mancha, situated between the Júcar and Huécar river canyons. The city is also known for its wealth of monuments. Its historic centre looks out over rocky canyon walls in the heart of the Cuenca Mountains. The Cathedral, Puente de San Pablo (Saint Paul Bridge) and the cobbled streets charm the most seasoned traveller. You will also have a good view of Casas Colgadas (Hanging Houses) built on the edge of the cliffs over a deep gorge. After lunch, continue to

Madrid, the central capital of Spain. make sure you are armed with a camera as you make a photo stop at the impressive Royal Palace of Madrid. Continue on to the Cibeles Fountain, a beautiful marble fountain of the Roman goddess of nature, Cybele, Madrid's most prominent symbols. Stop by Santiago Bernabéu Stadium – home to the Real Madrid football club, Puerta del Sol and Plaza Mayor for a fleeting glimpse into the heart of Madrid's culture.

DAY 5 MADRID

Breakfast

Enjoy the whole day free at leisure to explore Madrid on your own. You may wish to make an optional excursion to Toledo, the city of three cultures – Arabic, Christian and Jewish – and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

DAY 6 MADRID ► LAS ROZAS VILLAGE ► ZARAGOZA

Breakfast

Depart to Las Rozas Village which is a designer factory outlet. Enjoy reduced prices in more than 100 international and national luxury fashion and lifestyle boutiques. Thereafter, process to Zaragoza to retire for the night. Revel in the majestic architecture of the Nuestra Señora del Pilar Basilica in the city of Zaragoza, reputed to be the first church in history that is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary.

DAY 7 ZARAGOZA ► TARRAGONA ► BARCELONA

Breakfast, Dinner

Head on to Tarragona, an effervescent port city steeped in Roman history. Stroll along the Mediterranean Balcony located in central Tarragona, where you can enjoy the panoramic views of the beach and overlook the Roman Seaside Amphitheatre. Stop for a photo of the Roman Aqueduct Tarragona, also known as the 'Devil's Bridge', a part of the Archaeological Ensemble of Tarraco (listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2000). Continue to Barcelona and experience its full splendour through a tour of its city, where you can view the lauded art nouveau style buildings such as the Casa Batlló and Casa Milà along the elegant Passeig de Gràcia avenue

and the statuesque appearance of the La Sagrada Familia. Marvel at the towering Columbus Monument and the impressive Monumental Bullring before heading up to Montjuic Hill for a spectacular vista of the city and its harbour. Then, make your way to Las Ramblas, a tree-lined pedestrian mall that stretches for 1.2 kilometres along the street in central Barcelona.

DAY 8 BARCELONA

Breakfast

Enjoy a free day of leisure for some shopping or sightseeing at your pleasure in Barcelona. Explore the vibrant streets of the city and indulge in its quirkiness, present in their art, architecture and even cuisine. You may also wish to pay an optional visit to the Monastery of Montserrat situated on the Montserrat Mountain in Catalonia.

DAY 9 BARCELONA ► SINGAPORE

Breakfast, Meals on Board

Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure till it is time to transfer to the airport for your flight home.
