### DAY 3 SUNSHINE COAST > FRASER ISLAND > SUNSHINE COAST

#### Breakfast, Lunch

Board the "Warrior" 4WD vehicle and tour Fraser Island, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Your day of discovery begins as you depart from the Sunshine Coast and head across to the Noosa River, bound for the Cooloolaba National Park. Here you will see the **Teewah Beach** and **Rainbow Beach**, where you will stop for morning tea on the beach. Continue your journey and travel along the spectacular **75 Mile Beach** and explore the magnificent wilderness with a guided **rainforest walk**. On for a refreshing swim in the pristine waters of **Lake McKenzie** followed by an authentic Aussie lunch tops off a perfect day of discovery on the World's largest sand island! Make your way back through the towering **forests of Satinay** and **Brushbox** and navigate your way down to the 'sandy highway' before returning back to Sunshine Coast.

#### Note:

(1) You'll need to have a day pack ready when you board for day's tour – e.g. swimwear, towel, hat, sunscreen, insect repellent, camera, water bottle and comfortable walking shoes. Wearing beach sandals or similar footwear is advisable.

### DAY 4 SUNSHINE COAST

#### Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Start your morning with a trip to the **Original Eumundi Markets**, which will operate every Wednesday and Saturday. It will feature over 600 stalls bursting with handmade or home-grown produce as well as original artworks, fashion accessories and skincare products that you can bring home as gifts. Head to **The Ginger Factory**, one of Sunshine Coast's most popular attractions. Tour the factory on a 100-year-old cane train, stop by the gift shop to purchase souvenirs, and sample some fresh ginger ice cream. Then, make a quick stop at **Nutworks and the Chocolate Factory**, where you can uncover the history and health benefits of Australia's macadamia nut. Watch how chocolates and confectionery are made and treat yourself to some delicious samples. Make your trip memorable by taking a selfie with the **Big Pineapple**, and while here climb the steps inside the structure. Board the Historic Train and explore your

surroundings, you will also get a chance to pass by neighboring zoo animals. Don't forget to get some coffee and homemade delights the Pineapple Shop and Café.

### DAY 5 SUNSHINE COAST > BRISBANE

#### Breakfast

Begin the day with a visit to the **Australia Zoo**, the most famous zoological park in the country. Enjoy an action-packed, fun-filled day at the Australia Zoo. Get up close and personal with over 1,200 native and exotic animals. Hand feed kangaroos, cuddle with a koala and watch the jaw-snapping action of crocs in the world-famous Crocoseum! Visit the adjoining Wildlife Hospital, the largest and busiest of its kind in the world. Enjoy your day at Australia's most interactive conservation and zoological destination. Join a Brisbane city tour and learn about the historical significance of buildings such as **City Hall, Parliament House, St John's Cathedral and Treasury Casino**.

### DAY 6 BRISBANE > SINGAPORE
