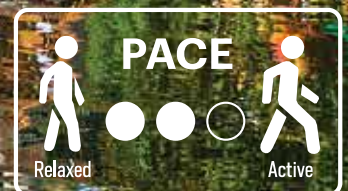

DAY 2

MUNICH > FUSSEN > WATTENS > SALZBURG

Dinner

Once you arrive, make your way to the town of **Fussen** to outview the **Neuschwanstein Castle**, which was built as a place of retreat for the King Ludwig II and transformed into a medieval dream world filled with all of his longing and ideals. Thereafter, drive on to **Wattens** and stop by the **Swarovski Crystal World**, a glittering fantasy world housing the world's biggest crystal, before proceeding to **Salzburg** for the night.

DAY 3

SALZBURG > HALLSTATT > VIENNA

Breakfast, Vienna Ribs Dinner

Discover the beautiful setting of the famous film **"The Sound of Music"** in the city of Salzburg. Waltz through the lush gardens of **Mirabell Palace**, and visit the **birthplace** of famous classical music prodigy Wolfgang **Amadeus Mozart** at **No. 9 Getreidegasse**.

Continue on the walking tour to the **Old Town of Salzburg** to admire the ensemble of baroque and medieval buildings, and drop by the magnificent Residence Square with its beautiful fountain. Next, proceed to **Hallstatt**, an incredibly gorgeous village that sits along the banks of Lake Hallstatt in the mountainous region of **Salzkammergut**.

The salt mines in the mountains above the village has made Hallstatt world-famous, along with the glistening views of the surrounding lake and mountain peaks. Later,

Step foot in the renowned **Schönbrunn Palace** and revel in the stunning interior of the massive baroque complex – think exquisite bohemian crystal chandeliers and white-lacquered ceilings and walls covered in gold leaf ornamentation. Then, continue to the glorious **Ringstrasse** with its wealth of parks and monuments, the **State Opera house**, the majestic **Reichsrat Parliament Building** and **Rathaus (city hall)**, and the **Hofburg Imperial Palace**. Last but not least, end the day with a visit to one of the most important Gothic structures in Austria – **St. Stephen's Cathedral**. Afterwards, carry on to **Budapest**, the capital of Hungary. Along the way, you may make a pit stop at the **Designer Outlet Parndorf** for a spot of shopping. As dusk descends, enjoy a sumptuous dinner while being entertained with a **Hungarian folk show**.

in Budapest with over 700 years of history and frescoes done by famous Hungarian painters. Next, head up to **Gellért Hill** next for some of the best panoramic views of the entire city. Continue on to **Fisherman's Bastion** for a view of the beautiful turrets, see the impressive **Heroes' Square** and the **Millennium Monument** located in its middle, and stroll along the fashionable shopping street, **Váci Utca**. At noon, enjoy a delightful meals aboard Danube River Cruise that covers the most fascinating sights in Budapest. We recommend an optional tour to discover the scenic riverside town - **Szentendre Artist Village**.

DAY 6 BUDAPEST > DONOVALY > KRAKÓW

Breakfast, Dinner

Head on a scenic drive to **Kraków** by crossing over the border into **Slovakia** to wind through **Donovaly** and past the **Tatra Mountains**. Proceed to the renowned **Wieliczka Salt Mine**, a world class monument of Poland that is among the UNESCO's World Cultural and Natural Heritage List. Embark on a magical journey through the saline labyrinth to learn more about the history and traditions of **Wieliczka**, and get a closer look at the various salt formations and deposits.

DAY 7 KRAKÓW

Breakfast, Dinner

Embark on a half day walking tour of **Kraków** and its captivating medieval structures. Visit the Gothic-Renaissance **Wawel Royal Castle**, and venture down to the historic **Old Town** to explore Europe's largest market square along with medieval houses, palaces and churches. Move on to visit the Jagiellonian University, Poland's most revered university dating all the way back to 13th century, and marvel over the spectacular interior of **St. Mary's Basilica** and the medieval masterpiece of the **Cloth Hall**. Continue to take a trip out of town to the infamous **Auschwitz Concentration Camp** for a historical tour. Auschwitz was Nazi Germany's **concentration camps** and the establishment of the main extermination camp. Auschwitz camp the main purpose is to carry out the killing of Jews or to be extremely demanding work of its inmates, mass executions carried out inhuman or human experiments. In **1979, the UNESCO World Heritage Auschwitz**. In **2007, UNESCO named the camp "Auschwitz - Birkenau German Nazi concentration and extermination camp (1940- 1945)".**

DAY 8 KRAKÓW > WROCLAW

Breakfast, Dinner

Journey on to **Wrocław**, the historical capital of **Lower Silesia** in Western Poland. The

town's perch upon the **Odra River** along with the veritable maze of islands and bridges have thus earned it the nickname 'Venice of Poland'. Mill about the **Old Town of Wrocław**, a remarkable area filled with Baroque splendour that was painfully reconstructed after WWII. Next, have a blast at the vibrant **Market Square**, which is bursting at the seams with cafes, restaurants, shops and hotels.

DAY 9 WROCLAW > BERLIN

Breakfast, Dinner – German Pork Knuckle

Make your way to Berlin and start off with a half day city tour to get a feel of its dynamic culture and turbulent past. Start with the beautiful **Unter den Linden**, an elegant boulevard in the heart of Berlin connecting the **Brandenburg Gate** to the **Schlossbrücke bridge**. Visit the Reichstag, the seat of the German Parliament that reflects the tumultuous history of Germany, followed by the symbolic Brandenburg Gate. Next, stop by the famous East – West German border crossing **Checkpoint Charlie**, which is also the scene of various thrillers and espionage novels. Last but not least comes the main highlight of the tour: the **Berlin Wall**. Trail along the double row of cobblestones that formed the symbolic boundary separating the democratic East Berlin from communist West Berlin.

DAY 10 BERLIN > DRESDEN > PRAGUE

Breakfast, Dinner

Carry on to **Prague**, but make a pit stop at **Dresden** along the way for their significant art treasure, architectural sights and alluring landscape. Explore the city on foot for a tour of **The Church of Our Lady (Frauenkirche)**, the **Semper Opera House**, the **Zwinger Palace** and the **Saxon Wall**. We continue our journey towards the Capital of **Czech Republic - Prague**, known as **Praha**.

DAY 11 PRAGUE

Begin with a half-day walking tour of the city nicknamed the '**City of a Hundred Spires**'. Then head towards the last stop of the day – **Wenceslas Square**, the vibrant social and commercial centre of Prague. You may also wish to make an optional

trip to the spa town **Karlovy Vary**, famous for their therapeutic thermal spa treatments.

第一天 本地 ▶ 慕尼黑

(机上用餐)

团员在机场集合,准备飞往慕尼黑,巴伐利亚州的首府。

第二天 慕尼黑 ▶ 弗尔森 ▶ 登斯 ▶ 萨尔茨堡

(晚餐)

抵达慕尼黑,转接送前往菲尔森镇外观新天鹅堡,是欧洲所有的宫殿和城堡著名的城堡之一。其最大的吸引力在于,新天鹅堡始建于国王路德维希二世,现今变成了一个中世纪的梦幻城堡。此后,前往瓦腾斯和经停施华洛世奇水晶世界,一个闪闪发光的水晶幻想世界。其后前往萨尔茨堡。

第三天 萨尔斯堡 ▶ 哈尔施塔特 ▶ 维也纳

(早餐,维也纳猪骨排晚餐)

徒步游览著名电影“音乐之声”在萨尔茨堡市的优美景色。华尔兹通过米拉贝尔宫郁郁葱葱的花园,并参观著名的古典音乐神童莫扎特的诞生地,位於9号的粮食胡同。继续在步行游览萨尔茨堡老城欣赏巴洛克和中世纪建筑的合奏,以及宏伟小区广场落以其美丽的喷泉。转移到哈尔施塔特-位于哈尔施塔特湖。自2009年以来哈尔施塔特著名的是产盐。继续前往的“音乐之城”,维也纳。(晚上友情推荐可以自费观赏维也纳的音乐会,在任何一个著名的音乐厅享受充满音乐的夜晚。)

第四天 维也纳 ▶ 潘多夫直销工厂 ▶ 布达佩斯

(早餐,匈牙利民歌舞晚餐)

踏上奥地利,维也纳的浪漫之都的一个难忘的都市之旅。游览著名的美泉宫,陶醉在庞大的1441间客房巴洛克式的复杂的令人惊叹的内饰,白色瓷砖灶,精致的波希米亚水晶吊灯和白色漆的天花板和墙壁覆盖金箔装饰。然后,继续围绕着环城大道观赏其丰富的公园和纪念碑,国家歌剧院,雄伟的国会大厦和市政厅和霍夫堡皇宫。最后参观最重要的哥特式结构,在奥地利著名的圣斯蒂芬大教堂。随后,前往匈牙利的首都-布达佩斯,途径潘多夫直销工厂享受为购物乐趣。晚餐安排享受丰盛的晚餐,同时观赏道地的匈牙利民间歌舞表演。

第五天 布达佩斯

(早餐,多瑙河游船午餐)

通过导游的带领认识布达佩斯真正的文化,布达佩斯也被称为“温泉城市”。参观的第一站是著名的马加什教堂,是布达佩斯最古老的建筑现今已有700多年的历史,壁画是著名的匈牙利画家作品之一。接下来,启程到下一个景点-盖勒特山。鸟瞰整个城市的最佳点。继续前往渔人城堡的观赏塔楼美丽的景色,介于壮丽的英雄广场和世纪坛中间,沿着时尚购物街-瓦茨街逛逛。乘搭多瑙河游船享用多瑙河游轮午餐。下午友情推荐可以自费

游览风景秀丽的江边小镇-圣安德烈艺术村。其余时间自由活动。

第六天 布达佩斯 ▶ 多诺瓦利 ▶ 克拉科夫

(早餐,晚餐)

前往克拉科夫跨越边界进入斯洛伐克途经多诺瓦利和塔特拉山。继续前往著名的维利奇卡盐矿,位于波兰克拉科夫附近,是一个从13世纪起就开采的盐矿,目前已基本停产。盐矿有327米深,超过300公里长。盐矿中有房间、礼拜堂、和地下湖泊等,宛如一座地下城市。1978年,维利奇卡盐矿被联合国教科文组织登录为世界遗产。

第七天 克拉科夫

(早餐,晚餐)

徒步游览克拉科夫及其迷人的中世纪结构。访问哥特式-文艺复兴时期的瓦维尔皇家城堡和历史悠久的老城。游览欧洲最大的市集广场以及中世纪房屋,宫殿和教堂。圣玛丽大教堂的壮观内饰和布馆的中世纪的杰作。前往臭名昭著的奥斯威辛集中营的历史之旅。奥斯威辛集中营是纳粹德国时期建立最主要的集中营和灭绝营。奥斯威辛集中营於1940年4月27日,由纳粹德国亲卫队领导人希姆莱下令建造。主要的目的是进行杀害犹太人或是对其收容者进行极为严苛的工作、集体处决或是进行不人道的人体实验。1979年,联合国教科文组织将奥斯威辛集中营列入世界文化遗产。並命名為「奥斯威辛-比克瑙 德國納粹集中和滅絕營(1940-1945年)」。

第八天 克拉科夫 ▶ 弗罗茨瓦夫

(早餐,晚餐)

旅途前往弗罗茨瓦夫,又或港譯樂斯拉夫,是波兰城市,位于波兰西南部的奥得河畔,自1999年起是下西里西亚省的省会。拥有过为数众多的哥特式、文艺复兴式、巴洛克式、古典主义,直到现代主义、后现代主义等各种风格的精美建筑。虽然其中有70%毁于二战末期的战火,但还是为数不少的建筑物幸存了下来,或是在战后得到恢复。也因此赢得了个别名“波兰的威尼斯”。参观热闹的集市广场,这是个充满咖啡馆,餐馆,商店和酒店的接缝处。

第九天 弗罗茨瓦夫 ▶ 柏林

(早餐,晚餐-德国猪脚)

启程前往德国的首都-柏林。抵達後開始城市游覽體驗其多姿多彩的动荡历史和动态文化。穿梭于美丽的菩提树下-是一条东西走向的林荫大道,从西端的勃兰登堡门向东延伸到施普雷河中间的博物馆岛和柏林大教堂,曾经是柏林的首屈一指的景观长廊。外观国会大厦-是德国联邦议院的会址。接下来,经停查理检查哨,位於柏林市中心的腓特烈大街上,是冷戰時期柏林圍牆邊東德與西柏林進出的一個檢查點。最后来参观柏林的主要亮点:柏林墙。它是第二次世界大戰後德國分裂和冷戰的重要標誌性建築,也成为了分割东西欧的铁幕的一个象征。

第十天 柏林 ▶ 德累斯顿 ▶ 布拉格

(早餐,晚餐)

启程前往布拉格,途径德累斯顿-是德國萨克森自由州的首府,德国东部重要的文化、政治和经济中心。由于德累斯顿温和的气候和合适的城市建设位置,以及易北河上精美的巴洛克式建筑,使德累斯顿得到“易北河畔的佛罗伦萨”的美称。徒步探索城市之美包括圣母教堂,森帕歌剧院,茨温格宫和撒克逊长墙之旅。而后前往捷克的首都-有着欧洲最美城市之称的-布拉格。(友情推荐可以自费游览德国百斯泰一个由岩石形成的锯齿状岩石桥)

第十一天 布拉格

(早餐)

徒步游览欧洲最美的城市,也被称为“百塔之城”。近距离看看著名的布拉格城堡和其中的标志性建筑-布拉格的精神象征圣维特大教堂,保存最完好的罗马式教堂圣乔治大教堂和旧皇宫。十字标志性的查理大桥,然后继续进入旧城区的天文钟,是城市的镇馆之宝之一。然后进入布拉格的最后一站-瓦茨拉夫广场,一个布拉格充满活力的社会和商业中心。下午时间自由活动。(友情建议可以自费选择参观温泉之旅的温泉小镇卡罗维利瓦利享受他们著名的治疗热温泉理疗。)

第十二天 布拉格 ▶ 家园

(早餐,机上用餐)

享受自由活动时间至转移送往机场办理登机手续飞返美丽的家园。
