

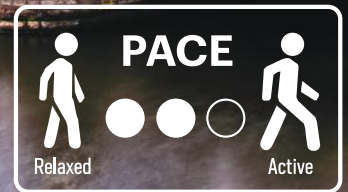

Visit the iconic **Fitzroy Gardens**, home to Captain Cook's Cottage and **the Shrine of Remembrance**, where Melbournians pay their respects to Australia's war veteran. Enjoy retail therapy at the **South Wharf DFO Outlet**.

Cafe, take a guided orchard tractor fruit tasting tour through the groves of stone fruit trees with orchard guide. Sampling different varieties of seasonal fruits. Visit **Yarra Valley Chocolaterie and Ice Creamery** and indulge in some quality chocolate and ice cream products while enjoying sweeping views of the valleys. End the day with a visit to **Something Aussie**, your one stop shop for all things Australian at the best price!
