RÖMER CHRISTMAS MARKET, FRANKFURT

DAY 1
HOME > FRANKFURT

Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport and take-off to **Frankfurt**, the business and financial centre of **Germany**.

DAY 2
FRANKFURT > STUTTART

Lunch – Local Fare

Set off on your romantic getaway as you depart from Frankfurt to **Stuttgart**, and enjoy the spread of lush valleys and landscapes along the way. Once you arrive, embark on an orientation tour of this green city, which brings you to view the **Old Castle** that dates back to the 10th century, the **Baroque-style New Castle**, **Schillerplatz** as well as the opulent **Staatstheater Stuttgart**.

DAY 3
STUTTART > SCHWANGAU > STUTTART

Breakfast, Dinner – Local Fare

Take a side trip out of Stuttgart and make your way to **Schwangau** for an up-close view of the famous castle known as the icon of romance and fairytales – the **Neuschwanstein Castle**. The inspiration for the castle featured in Disney's classic fairytale "The Sleeping Beauty", this picturesque clifftop castle was built for King Ludwig II between 1869 and 1886 and was meant to "embody the true spirit of the medieval German castle". We recommend walking up to the **Marienbrücke** – the suspension footbridge behind the castle, the perfect spot for beautiful pictures of the castle with Schwangau in the background. Next, make a point to visit the less famous but equally important neighbouring castle, **Hohenschwangau**, the former Bavarian ruling house. Thereafter, return to your hotel in Stuttgart to rest for the night.

DAY 4
STUTTART > NUREMBERG > STUTTART

Breakfast, Dinner – Chinese Fare

Journey to **Nuremberg**, known as the 'unofficial capital' of the Holy Roman Empire due to its historical and geographical importance. Embark on a tour of the medieval city and take in the sights of **Nuremberg Castle**, the **Hospital of the Holy Spirit**, **Nuremberg Hauptmarkt** and its famous fountain, the **Schöner Brunnen**.

DAY 5
STUTTART > WÜRZBURG > STUTTART

Breakfast, Dinner – Local Fare

Travel to **Würzburg**, a city situated in the northern tip of **Bavaria**. Located at the **Main River**, **Würzburg** is set in a beautiful hilly location and lies smack in the middle of one of Germany's largest wine-producing regions. In addition to excellent white wine and restaurants, Würzburg also offers visitors a wide array of historic art and architecture spanning the Romanesque, Gothic, Renaissance, and Baroque and Rococo periods. Visit popular attractions such as the UNESCO World Heritage Site **Würzburg Residence** and its gorgeous **Court Gardens**, **Alte Mainbrücke**, **Fortress Marienberg** as well as **St. Mary's Church**.

DAY 6
STUTTART

Breakfast

Enjoy a free day of leisure for you to do some shopping or make up your own sightseeing itinerary. If you're at a loss what to do, why not take an optional trip to nearby cities like **Vaduz** in **Liechtenstein** or **Lucerne** in **Switzerland** where excitement await. Optional: Full day tour

DAY 7
STUTTART > FRANKFURT

Breakfast, Dinner – Chinese Fare

Make your way back to Frankfurt for a tour of the city. Be amazed by the beautiful Renaissance frescoes of the Gothic-style **Cathedral of St. Bartholomew**, and proceed to visit Germany's important political symbol – **St. Paul's Church**. Next, view the Renaissance exterior of the **Old Opera House**, and admire the gabled façade of Frankfurt's city hall building – the **Römer**, especially its renowned balcony from which many famous people have waved to a cheering crowd below.

DAY 8
