### DAY 1 HOME ▶ MANCHESTER

#### Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport and depart for Manchester, a major city in the northwest of England with a rich industrial heritage.

Note: If group use morning flight, itinerary will start from DAY2 and become 9D7N.

### DAY 2 MANCHESTER

#### Meals on Board, Dinner

Upon arrival, embark on an orientation tour to see the **Beetham Tower**, **Phones 4U Arena**, and the **Manchester Opera House**. Free at leisure till transfer to hotel for overnight.

### DAY 3 MANCHESTER ▶ LAKE DISTRICT ▶ EDINBURGH

#### Breakfast, Dinner

Drive along the scenic **Lake District** and immerse yourself in the gorgeous scenery that stretches out before you, keeping in mind that these views were the inspiration for the poem *Daffodils* written by William Wordsworth. You may wish to go on an

optional boat tour on **Lake Windermere**, a beautiful waterway that is also England's largest natural lake. Then, transfer to **Edinburgh** for overnight stay.

### DAY 4 EDINBURGH ▶ YORK

#### Breakfast, Dinner

Begin the day with an exploration of hilly Edinburgh, the capital of Scotland, through a city tour that brings you to visit the city's main attractions. Start off with a photo stop outside the **Edinburgh Castle**, an iconic symbol that has withstood the test of time, witnessing many events in the history of Scotland's royalty. Then, trail along the **Royal Mile** and enjoy the sights and sounds of this busy old street, passing by the **St. Giles Cathedral** to arrive at **Holyrood Palace**, the official residence of The Queen. In the afternoon, enjoy a scenic drive to **Scottish Highlands**. The next destination for the day is **York**, a walled city situated at the confluence of the Rivers Ouse and Foss in North Yorkshire. Photo stop outside the **York Minster**, an imposing Gothic cathedral that boasts some of the most amazing medieval stained glass windows.

## DAY 5 YORK > STRATFORD - UPON-AVON > COVENTRY

*Breakfast, Dinner*

Journey to **Stratford-upon-Avon**, the birthplace of famous poet William Shakespeare. Free at leisure to explore the charming cobbled streets of this Warwickshire country town. Thereafter, continue on to Coventry for overnight stay.

*Breakfast, Dinner*

Depart to Oxford for a guided walking tour, which will bring you to see main attraction, especially a few of **Oxford University** colleges to learn how the University works and its incredible history. Then, depart to **Bicester Designer Factory** outlet. Enjoy free shopping time in the luxury village-style shopping area showcasing leading fashion brands at discounted prices, before transfer to **London**, capital of England.

## DAY 7 LONDON

Head off on a guided city tour of London and take in the sights of **Trafalgar Square**, **Whitehall**, the **Prime Minister's Office** at 10 **Downing Street**, **Houses of Parliament**, **Big Ben**, **Westminster Abbey** and **Buckingham Palace**.
