

DAY 1 SINGAPORE > DUSSELDORF

Meals on Board

Assemble at Singapore Changi International Airport for our maiden flight to **Dusseldorf**, where your holiday begins!

DAY 2 DUSSELDORF > HEIDELBERG > KARLSRUHE

Meals on Board, Dinner

Upon arrival, travel to **Heidelberg**. Heidelberg is a town on the **Neckar River** in southwestern Germany, known for its distinguished 14th-century university. Visit the baroque Altstadt (Old Town). Overnight at **Karlsruhe**.

DAY 3 KARLSRUHE > ROTHENBURG OB DER TAUBER > NUREMBURG

Breakfast, Dinner

Make your way to **Rothenburg ob der tauber** a German town in northern Bavaria known for its medieval architecture. Half-timbered houses line the cobblestone lanes of its old town. The town walls include many preserved gate houses and towers, plus a covered walkway on top. **St. Jakob's Church** houses an intricate, late Gothic altarpiece by woodcarver Tilman Riemenschneider. The medieval Town Hall has a tower with panoramic views. After that, travel to **Nuremburg**, a city on the **River Pegnitz** and the **Rhine–Main–Danube Canal** in the German state of Bavaria, in the administrative region of Middle Franconia.

DAY 4 NUREMBURG > VIENNA

Breakfast, Dinner

Journey to **Vienna** - the '**City of Music**' as the sun goes down. Embark on a city tour of this romantic Capital of Austria, Vienna. Continue

to the glorious **Ringstrasse** with its wealth of parks and monuments, the **State Opera House**, the majestic **Reichsrat Parliament Building** and **Rathaus (City Hall)**, and the **Hofburg Imperial Palace**. Last but not least, ends the day with a visit to one of the most important Gothic structures in Austria – **St. Stephen's Cathedral**. We recommend an optional excursion of **Concert show** at any of the concert hall for your evening's enjoyment.

DAY 5 VIENNA > BUDAPEST

Breakfast, Dinner

After having a hearty breakfast, travel to **Budapest**, also known as the '**City of Baths**' through a guided city tour that will help you pack as much as possible into your exploration of the city. The first stop of the tour is the renowned **Matthias Church**, one of the oldest buildings in Budapest with over 700 years of history and frescoes done by famous Hungarian painters. Next, head up to **Gellért Hill** for some of the best panoramic views of the entire city. Continue on to the impressive **Heroes' Square** and the Millennium Monument located in its middle, and stroll along the fashionable shopping street, **Váci Utca**. Along the way to Budapest, recommend an excursion that you may wish to visit the **Designer Outlet Parndorf** for a spot of shopping, riverside town - **Szentendre Artist Village**.

city nicknamed the '**City of a Hundred Spires**'. Get an up-close look at the famous **Prague Castle** and the symbolic structures housed within it – the state's spiritual symbol **St. Vitus Cathedral**, the best preserved Romanesque church **St. George's Basilica** and the **Old Royal Palace**. Cross the iconic **Charles Bridge** and proceed into the **Old Town** for a glimpse of the **Astronomical Clock**, one of the greatest treasures of the city. Then head towards the last stop of the day – **Wenceslas Square**, the vibrant social and commercial centre of Prague.

DAY 7 PRAGUE ▶ DRESDEN ▶ LEIPZIG

Breakfast, Lunch

Kick off the day to **Dresden** for their significant art treasure, architectural sights and alluring landscape. Explore the city on foot for a tour of **The Church of Our Lady** (Frauenkirche), the **Semper Opera House**, the **Zwinger Palace** and the **Saxon Wall**. Continue to

Leipzig. We recommend an excursion to the **Bastei**, it has been a tourist attraction for over 200 years. In 1824, a wooden bridge was constructed to link several rocks for the visitors.

DAY 8 LEIPZIG ▶ DUSSELDORF

Breakfast, Dinner

Journey on to **Dusseldorf** - a city in western Germany known for its fashion industry and art scene. It's divided by the Rhine River, with its Old Town on the east bank and modern commercial areas to the west. In the **Old Town**, **St. Lambertus Church** and **Castle Tower** both date to the 13th century. Streets such as **Königsalle** are lined with boutiques.

DAY 9 DUSSELDORF ▶ SINGAPORE
