### DAY 1

#### HOME ► WELLINGTON

Meal on Board

Assemble at the airport for your flight to **Wellington**, the capital of New Zealand.

### DAY 2

#### WELLINGTON

Dinner

Upon arrival, proceed to explore the city sights of Wellington. Pass by the neoclassical **Parliament House** and learn about the unusual architectural design of the Beehive (aka Executive Wing). See other local landmarks such as heritage-listed **Old St Paul's Church**, a fine example of Gothic Revival architecture. You're driven to the summit of **Mt Victoria** to view Wellington from above. Enjoy a panorama that includes **Wellington Harbour**, a blue bay nestled within the southern tip of New Zealand's North Island.

### DAY 3

#### WELLINGTON ► TAUPO ► ROTORUA

Breakfast, Hangi Dinner

Board your coach for your journey north out of the capital city, along the Kapiti Coast and over the Manawatu Plain to Palmerston North before skirting the volcanic plateau to Taupo. **Lake Taupo** is world renowned for its fighting rainbow trout and is New Zealand's largest lake. Brief stop at **Hukka Honey Hive** to have a unique taste experience with 100% pure New Zealand honey, honey wine (mead) and liqueurs. Stop to view the mighty **Huka Falls** and travel past massive pine forests to reach **Rotorua**, centre of Maori Culture and famous for its geysers, boiling mud pools and steaming creates. Tonight, you will be treated to a traditional Maori hangi (feast) and cultural performance featuring Maori songs, chants and dance including the stirring haka.

# 10D8N NEW ZEALAND HIGHLIGHTS

## DAY 4 ROTORUA > MATAMATA > AUCKLAND

*Breakfast, Marquee Festive Feast*

Today visit to **Te Puia Thermal Reserve**, you will see boiling mud pools and the mighty Pohutu geyser. Be enthralled by the Maori culture of wood carving, flax weaving demonstration and the replicas of the Maori buildings here. Continue your tour with a photo stop at **Rotorua Lakefront** and the iconic **Government Gardens**. Thereafter, proceed to Matamata experience the real Middle-earth with a visit to the Hobbiton Movie Set, featured in The Lord of the Rings and The Hobbit films. Enjoy a fabulous **festive feast** at the Green Dragon In. Continue travel to **Auckland**, take in city highlights such as historical buildings in downtown Auckland, scroll along the shopping district **Queen Street**, the waterfront beaches along **Tamaki Drive**, and views of the **Hauraki Gulf**.

## DAY 5 AUCKLAND > CHRISTCHURCH > DUNEDIN

*Breakfast, Lunch*

Depart on your domestic flight from Auckland to the 'Garden City' of **Christchurch**. Upon arrival, travel south across the Canterbury Plains to the Whitestone town ship of **Oamaru**. Stop to view the mystical **Moeraki Boulders** then on to **Dunedin**, the Edinburgh of the South. Continue Dunedin city sightseeing including **Railway Station, University of Otago**, the **world's steepest Baldwin street** and impressive cathedrals.

## DAY 6 DUNEDIN > QUEENSTOWN

*Breakfast, Lunch*

This morning, head for the **Cadbury's Chocolate Factory**, where you can check out the Cadbury's World Experience, a 1-hour tour that shows you how chocolate is made and a liquid chocolate tasting. You can also munch plenty of samples and see how chocolate tempering is done. Next, enjoy **EU Exclusive Experience - Nature's Wonders Wildlife Tour** of the world famous Yellow Eyed Penguin and NZ Fur Seal colonies. Immerse in the natural beauty of the **Otago Peninsula** and the scenic coast along **Taiaroa Head**. Thereafter, visit one of Central Otago's most well-known orchards on the highway from Cromwell to Queenstown - **Mrs Jones Fruit Orchard** to sample and buy great variety of fresh or dry fruits, nuts and honey. Make a stop at the **Kawarau Bridge Bungy Lookout** the world's first-ever bungy jumping. Retrace the journey to Queenstown.

## DAY 7 QUEENSTOWN

*Breakfast*

Today is a free day to experience this magnificent resort town. Surrounded by majestic mountains, Queenstown boasts and incredible array of adventure & leisure activities in all forms. Perhaps a jet boat ride with Shotover jet or dinner across the lake at historic Walter Peak High Country Farm travelling on TSS Earnslaw, or travel to the top of Bob's Peak by gondola for spectacular views.

## DAY 8 QUEENSTOWN > MT COOK > TWIZEL

*Breakfast, Dinner*

Leaving Queenstown to **Arrowtown**, a delightful gold rush village nestled below the beautiful peaks that surround the sparkling Arrow River. Enroute stop at one of South Island **Salmon Farm**, chance to taste fresh salmon sashimi (own expenses). Thereafter, make our way into Mt Cook Region, view Australasia highest mountain Mt Cook at **Lake Pukaki**. If weather permits, take an optional helicopter ride up to Tasman Glacier at your own expense. Today you will overnight at **Twizel**, located in the heart of the spectacular Mackenzie High Country which surrounded by mountains, turquoise blue lakes and burnt umber landscapes will take your breath away!

## DAY 9 TWIZEL > CHRISTCHURCH

*Breakfast, Chinese Dinner*

Travel to Tekapo to visit the **Church of the Good Shepherd** on the shores of **Lake Tekapo**. Leaving the High-Country head to the farming district of **Ashburton**, visit **Farmer Corners' Alpacas & Lavender Farm**. Continue to Christchurch, hop on city sightseeing including **Bridge of Remembrance, Hagley Park, Botanic Garden, Mona Vale, Cashmere Hills** and **Cardboard Cathedral**.

## DAY 10 CHRISTCHURCH > HOME

*Breakfast, Meal on Board*
