DAY 1 HOME > CASABLANCA

Meals on Board

Assemble at Changi Airport and take-off to the cosmopolitan city of Morocco, Casablanca.

DAY 2 CASABLANCA > MARRAKESH

Dinner

Upon your arrival to Casablanca Airport, you will be transferred to **Marrakesh**, the most fascinating city, known as the Pearl of the South with its luxurious palaces and its glittering nightlife. Spend the rest of your day at your leisure.

DAY 3 MARRAKESH

Breakfast, Lunch, Chez Ali Fantasia Dinner

Join a sightseeing tour and explore the **Menara Garden, Koutoubia Mosque, the Bahia Palace and Majorelle Gardens**. After lunch, visit the famous Jemaa el-Fnaa Square, one of the world's most natural squares that has been inscribed on the

Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage. Here you will find the Old Medina and its bustling souk that sells all types of Moroccan goods. In the evening, you will have dinner at the **Chez Ali**, a restaurant renowned for its sumptuous Moroccan cuisine and exuberant Fantasia Show.

DAY 4 MARRAKESH > OUARZAZATE

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

This morning, you may take optional to get on a sunrise hot-air balloon ride from Marrakech to enjoy a bird's-eye view of Morocco's deserts and the foothills of the Atlas Mountains. After breakfast, depart to **Ouarzazate** via the high Atlas Mountain and see the 2630m high **Tizi n'Tichka**, which offers magnificent views. Visit **Kasbah Ait Benhaddou**, a spectacular fortress situated south of Morocco. It was utilised as a film location for movies such as Lawrence of Arabia and Gladiator. You will have some time to explore the narrow streets at your leisure.

DAY 5 OUARZAZATE > KALAAT M'GOUNA > TODGHA GORGE > ERFOUD

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Depart for Merzouga Desert and see the breath-taking desert landscapes and oasis with fantastic palm groves. Stop at **Kalaat M'Gouna**, a big town famous for cultivating roses. Expect to find many fine, rose-infused products here. The drive from Dades to Tinghir is spectacular. Explore the **Todgha Gorge**, a 300m wall carved deep into the High Atlas Mountains. After lunch drive to **Erfoud**, also known as the "Gate of Sahara Desert". This evening, take a **four-wheel drive** to the huge sands dunes of Merzouga and embark on a camel trekking adventure through the desert. The clean air and the beautiful sunset will take your breath away and provide an unforgettable moment.

DAY 6 ERFOUD > MIDELE > IFRAN > FES

Depart to **Fes** via Errachidia along the

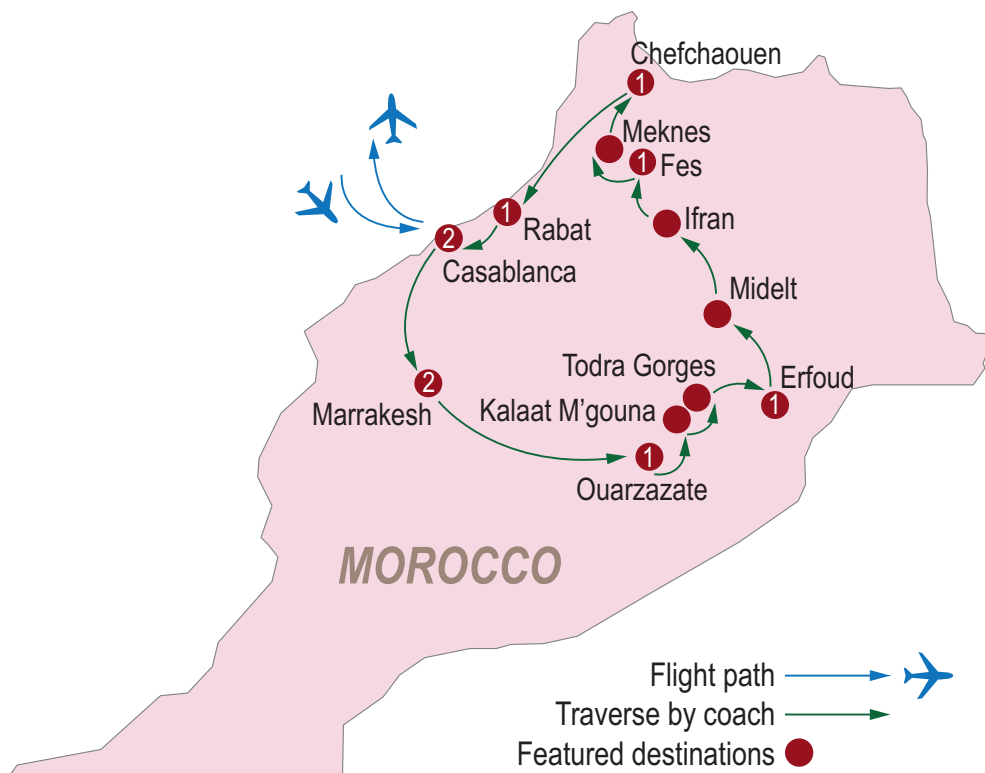

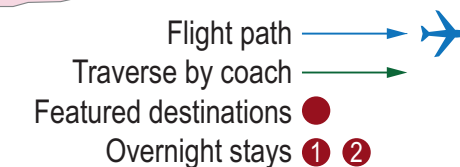

magnificent Ziz Gorges carved through volcanic rock, and through the Tizi Ntalghamit Pass to **Midelt**. Continue route passing **Ifran**, a charming ski resort for ski lovers, it is also known as "Little Lucerne in Switzerland". Drive to Fes, where you will check into hotel at the medina.

DAY 7 FES

Breakfast, Lunch, Chinese Dinner

Fes is one of the oldest imperial cities of Morocco as well as the spiritual capital of



the country. We begin at the blue gate - **Bab Boujloud Jeloud** and enter the most oldest part of **Fes El Bali**. While here, you will visit the **Bou Inania Madrasa**, **Qaraouiyyine Mosque**, the gremial handicrafts areas and streets, thousands of handicrafts shops and the tanneries of leather. In the afternoon, we will enjoy a panoramic view from one of the old hills of Fes from which you will see Fes from different perspectives.

DAY 8 FES > MEKNES > CHEFCHAOUEN

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Move on to **Meknes**, which is only 45 minutes from Fes, this iconic Isma'ilian town is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where

you can stroll round the architectural and cultural highlights such as the **Bab Mansour gate**, the monumental entrance to the imperial city and focal point of **Place El-Hedim**. Continue to **Chefchaouen** - Morocco's blue city, a beautiful town of the massif and the Iberian Peninsula. It is famous for its shady valleys Medina, its white houses with blue doors and wrought iron windows and tile roofs. Visit the **local markets** of Chefchaouen which are animated with traditionally dressed habitants and beautifully displayed coloured goods.

DAY 9 CHEFCHAOUEN > RABAT

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Drive to the imperial city of **Rabat** (approx. 250km), the administrative capital of the kingdom. Spend the rest of the day at your leisure.

DAY 10 RABAT > CASABLANCA

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast, your sightseeing tour will take you to see the **Old Medina, The Royal Palace, Hassan Tower** and **Mausoleum of**

Mohammed V. Travel to the **Kasbah of the Udayas**, a massive ancient fortress quarter built in the 12th century. Be captivated by its beautiful white and blue interior steeped in Mediterranean influence. Continue to Casablanca, the economical capital of Morocco. Visit the spectacular **Hassan II Mosque**, the largest mosque in Morocco whose soaring minaret anchors the city skyline. Exploring the exterior and gates of **The Royal Palace**, the **Mohammed V Square**, the residential area of Anfa and the Habbous district. Tonight, you will have dinner at Casablanca's famous **Rick's Café**. The popular movie "Casablanca" was shot in this restaurant.

DAY 11 CASABLANCA > HOME

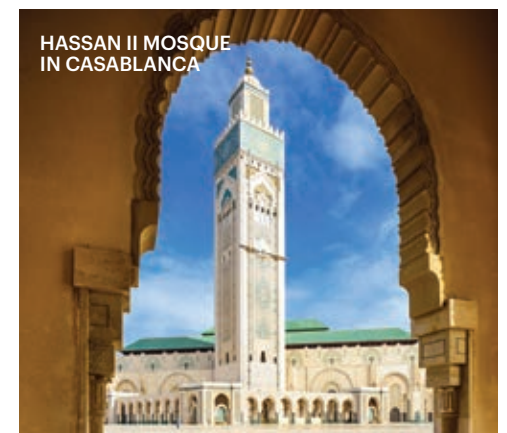
