01 HOME ▶ MILAN

Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport and take-off to **Milan**.

02 MILAN

Ciao Milano! Set off on a walking tour to explore the city's spectacular sights. See the impressive **Duomo di Milano** cathedral and its façade resplendent with pinnacles and spires, then take a leisure stroll through **Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II** for some brief shopping. Continue to **Piazza della Scala** and stop by the lavish **La Scala Opera House** for some pictures.

03 MILAN ▶ VENICE

Breakfast, Dinner (Squid Ink Pasta)
Journey to the floating city of **Venice** via a private water taxi, a unique transport for a city built on water. Start your tour around the ever-happening **St. Mark's Square**, where you will see the gilded basilica, **Doge's Palace** and the **Bridge of Sighs**. Visit a **Glass Blowing factory** to see how the beautiful, handcrafted glass is made by expert glassblowers.

04 VENICE ▶ BOLOGNA

Breakfast, Dinner (Lasagna Bolognese)

Proceed to **Bologna**, immerse yourself in the heart of the town and uncover all the secrets hidden behind the main attractions. Begin your exploration from the majestic god of the sea who welcomes us in **Piazza Nettuno**, before continuing to admire **Basilica di San Petronio**, **Piazza Santo Stefano** and **Le Due Torri**. The **Quadrilatero Market** is a stop that cannot be missed in this tour and awaits us with colourful alleys full of flavours and aromas of culinary specialties.

05 BOLOGNA ▶ CINQUE TERRE ▶ PISA

Brighten your day with today's highlight, **Cinque Terre** – an enchanting cluster of villages perched on the rugged peaks along the Italian Riviera coastline. Starting from **Levanto**, we enter this UNESCO World Heritage area by train to visit two of its most beautiful villages - **Vernazza** and **Manarola**. Bask in the charming atmosphere of these remote Italian seaside villages that boast pretty clusters of dwellings perched

precariously on the coastline. Proceed to the famous city of **Pisa**, explore the town of Pisa where you will see the **Leaning Tower**, the **Duomo** and the **Baptistry** in the **Square of Miracles**.



06 PISA ▶ THE MALL ▶ SIENA

Breakfast, Chinese Dinner

This morning, head to one of Italy's best-known luxury shopping outlets **The Mall**, and enjoy savings of up to 70%! Check out some Italy's high fashion biggest names such as Prada, Ferragamo, Versace, Armani, Furla and a host of other fashionable brands. After your

shopping spree, explore the beautifully preserved medieval city of **Siena** to see the 13th-century marble **Siena Cathedral**; stop for photos at the shell-shaped **Piazza del Campo**, which hosts the biannual **Palio** horse race; and view the **Pubblico Palace**, a renaissance structure otherwise known as the Town Hall.
