01 HOME ▶ MILAN

Meals on Board
Assemble at the airport and take-off to **Milan**.

02 MILAN

Dinner - Veal Milanese
Ciao Milano! Set off on an orientation tour that takes you to **Sforza Castle**, a majestic fortress where noble lords of Milan used to reside. See the impressive **Milan Cathedral** and its façade resplendent with pinnacles and spires, then take a leisure stroll through **Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II** for some brief shopping. Continue to **Piazza della Scala** and stop by the lavish **La Scala Opera House** for some pictures. Spend the rest of your day at leisure. You may wish to make an optional excursion to the city of Lugano in southern Switzerland.

03 MILAN ▶ VERONA ▶ VENICE

Breakfast, Dinner - Squid Ink Pasta
This morning, travel to **Verona** to explore the home of Shakespeare's star-crossed lovers and visit the well-preserved **Roman Arena** that is still used for opera performances. Walk to recount famous moments in Romeo and Juliet's tale as you stop by **Juliet's famed balcony**. Journey to the floating city of **Venice** via a private water taxi, a unique transport for a city built on water. Start your tour around the ever-happening **St. Mark's Square**, where you will see the gilded basilica, **Doge's Palace** and the **Bridge of Sighs**. Visit a **Glass Blowing factory** to see how the beautiful, handcrafted glass is made by expert glassblowers.

04 VENICE ▶ FLORENCE ▶ PRATO

Breakfast, Dinner - Florentine Steak with Wine
Today, make your way to **Florence** and the beautiful region of Tuscany. A cultural and political focal point during the Renaissance, the city is endowed with a huge variety of Renaissance artworks and Roman ruins. Stroll around **Piazza della Signoria** and its historic monuments, cross the landmark **Ponte Vecchio** bridge, then admire the legendary **Duomo** and the iconic **Florence Baptistery of St. John**.

05 PRATO ▶ CINQUE TERRE ▶ PISA ▶ PRATO

Breakfast
Brighten your day with today's highlight, **Cinque Terre** – an enchanting cluster of villages perched on the rugged peaks along the Italian Riviera coastline. Starting from **Levanto**, we enter this UNESCO World Heritage area by train to visit three of its most beautiful villages – **Vernazza**, **Manarola** and **Riomaggiore**. Bask in the charming atmosphere of these remote Italian seaside villages that boast pretty clusters of dwellings perched precariously on the coastline. Continue to the town of **Pisa** where you will see the **Leaning Tower**, the **Duomo** and the Baptistery in the **Square of Miracles**.

06 PRATO ▶ THE MALL ▶ ASSISI

Breakfast, Dinner - Truffled Trout
Head to one of Italy's best-known luxury shopping outlets, **The Mall**, and enjoy savings of up to 70%! Check out some of Italy's high fashion biggest names such as Prada, Ferragamo, Versace, Armani, Furla and a host of other fashionable brands. After your shopping spree, move to your next destination: the stone-built, hilltop town of Assisi for the night.

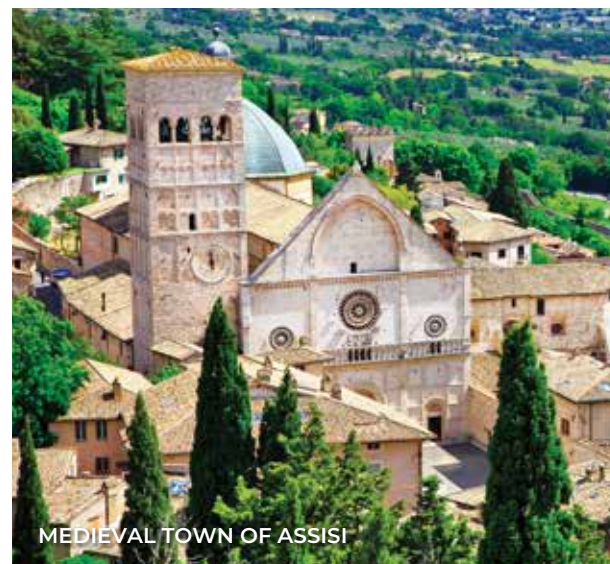
07 ASSISI ▶ SORRENTO

Breakfast, Dinner - Chicken Cacciatore
This morning, embark on an orientation walking tour of this charming town – **Assisi**, the birthplace of St. Francis. Admire the ancient **Basilica of St. Francis**, before strolling down to picturesque streets of **Piazza del Comune**. Next, journey along the cliff-top road to the picturesque coastal town of **Sorrento**, perched upon the southern cliffs of the Bay of Naples and looking out to Mount Vesuvius. Spend some time walking about the town, beginning from **Piazza Tasso** and admire the local traditional craftworks of wood inlay.

08 SORRENTO ▶ AMALFI ▶ SORRENTO

Breakfast
Today, make your way to Amalfi, a historic town situated along the picturesque **Amalfi Coast**. En route, stop by **Belvedere Positano** to admire the picturesque scenery of this authentic jewel anchored to the rock. Continue to **Praiano**, a charming fishing village and

seaside resort. Reach **Amalfi**, the oldest Maritime Republic of Italy, to see the Cathedral, then enjoy some free time at the lovely old town before returning to Sorrento.

Breakfast, Chinese Dinner
Journey south to the well-preserved ruins of **Pompeii** for a guided walking tour. Discover how Roman citizens lived 2,000 years ago, before Mount Vesuvius

erupted in A.D. 79. View the excavated Roman ruins of theaters, villas, temples, and baths. Head to the city of Rome for the night.

11 ROME

Breakfast, Dinner - 3 Course Roman Cuisine with wine

Be awed by the magnificent sight of the **Colosseum**, the largest amphitheater ever built. Visit the **Vatican City** – a walled enclave within Rome and feast your eyes upon **St. Peter's Basilica**, a Catholic shrine renowned for its Renaissance architecture. View 'The Pieta', a magnificent work done by Renaissance sculptor Michelangelo, as well as enter the **Sistine Chapel** and the **Vatican Museum** – entrance included for both attractions. Next, proceed to view the masterpiece of **Trevi Fountain**, the city's largest Baroque fountain before strolling to the locals' favourite meeting point, the **Spanish Steps**. Spend the rest of the day shopping at the high fashion street, **Via Condotti**.
