02 ZÜRICH LUCERNE

Welcome to the sophisticated Swiss city of Zurich. From here, you can traverse through picture-perfect landscapes to reach the lakeside town of Lucerne. See the Lion Monument, Old Town Hall and Chapel Bridge, the oldest wooden covered bridge in Europe. Don't miss the chance to visit **Bucherer**, the largest duty-free store in Switzerland. Spend some time on your own in Lucerne before travelling to Interlaken, which lies in the shadow of the Jungfrau Mountain.

03 INTERLAKEN > MT. BUSSALP > INTERLAKEN

Breakfast, Dinner - 4 course Swiss Fondue with Wine Get ready for a day packed with exciting activities by boarding a specially designed Snow Bus for a comfortable ride up to Mt. Bussalp. Marvel at the stunning views of the snowy peaks of Jungfrau as you sled through various obstacle courses on the 7.6 km sledge run, which happens to be the longest in Europe. You may consider for a truly breathtaking experience, we recommend optional for a ride on Jungfrau Railways to Kleine Scheidegg, where you can take in the scenic valleys and Glacier Falls. As the night falls, indulge in a 4-course Swiss fondue combo dinner at the Swiss-themed Bebbis Restaurant. 04 INTERLAKEN > BERN > BROC > GENEVA

Begin your day by exploring Bern, the capital of Switzerland, and its charming Old Town. See the Cathedral of Vincent, Bear Pit, and Clock Tower, while taking in the medieval streets, ornate fountains, and arcaded walkways. Next, satisfy your sweet tooth with a tour of Maison Cailler in Broc, where you can discover the secrets of Swiss chocolate and sample a variety of their delicious chocolates. Then, travel to the sophisticated city of

Geneva for an orientation that includes views of the Old Town, Jet d'Eau, and the Flower Clock, which pays tribute to the city's centuries-old watchmaking traditions. Finally, enjoy some free time to explore the sights of this beautiful lakeside city on your own.

05 GENEVA > VEVEY > MONTREUX > LEUKERBAD

Breakfast, Chinese Dinner Begin your journey by visiting Vevey, often called one of the "Pearls of the Swiss Riviera". Take a moment to capture a photo of the Charlie Chaplin statue before enjoying the breathtaking view of a giant fork protruding from Lake Geneva. Next, venture to the Montreux region where you will marvel at the impressive fortress of Chillon Castle, located on a rocky islet in Lake Geneva, is considered one of Europe's finest. Finally, unwind in the mountain spa resort of Leukerbad where you can rest and rejuvenate for the night. Remark: Experience the magic of the Montreux Christmas Market, a special visit stops from Nov 23 to Dec 23, 2023.



Spend your free day indulging in the hotel's thermal pool, renowned for its naturally heated and mineral-rich waters, all while taking in the stunning backdrop of the Swiss mountains. We highly recommend our optional excursion to Aletsch Glacier, the largest glacial landscape in Europe. Situated in the eastern Swiss Alps and flanked by the Eiger, Mönch, and Jungfrau mountains, this incredible site is not to be missed. Optional: Aletsch Glacier

N7 BRIG ▶ ZERMATT ▶ BRIG

Breakfast, Dinner - Cordon Bleu Start your day with a visit to Zermatt, an old and idyllic village nestled in a deep valley, enclosed by steep mountains and situated right at the foot of the Matterhorn. Board the world's first fully electrified cog railway, and whiz through verdant forests and lovely meadows as you make your way up to the Gornergrat at 3,089m for the finest views of the Matterhorn. From the observation platform, located at 3,131 metres, you can enjoy commanding views of 29 summits over 4000 metres high. Finally, take some free time to explore Zermatt at your leisure.





08 BRIG ♦ CHUR

Scenic ride: Glacier Express
Breakfast, Dinner - Bratwurst
Embark on one of the world's
most unforgettable rail journeys
aboard the Glacier Express
toward Chur. Sit back and take in
the breathtaking alpine
landscapes as you cross
hundreds of bridges and travel
through the Oberalp Pass, which
sits at an impressive 6,700 feet
(2,044 m) above sea level. Once
you arrive in Chur, the oldest and
car-free mountain city in the
heart of the Alps, take a short





walk to explore its charming streets. Next, continue your journey to St. Gallen where you can visit the UNESCO-listed Abbey District. Marvel at the striking Baroque cathedral with its twin towers and take a stroll through the historical alleyways of the old town, including the striking Red Square.
