**01 HOME ▶ VENICE**  
Meals on Board  
Assemble at the airport and take-off to **Venice**.

**02 VENICE**  
Dinner – Seafood Pasta  
Begin your day tour by exploring the heart of **Venice** via a private water taxi. Admire historic churches, winding canals, and picture-perfect piazzas on a guided tour of the city known as the Queen of the Adriatic. Step onto the iconic **St. Mark's Square**, where you will see the **St. Mark's Basilica**—an opulent, domed church built in the 11th century to house the body of St. Mark the Apostle. Take in the view of the stately **Doge's Palace**, built in the Venetian Gothic style in 1340. Marvel at the **Bridge of Sighs**, which serves as a link between Doge's Palace and the New Prison. Lastly, witness a glassblowing demonstration to learn about the city's most celebrated art.

**03 VENICE ▶ MILAN**  
Breakfast  
Journey to the chic northern capital of **Milan**. Admire the extraordinary **Gothic Duomo**, the **La Scala Opera House**, and the 19th-century **Galleria** with its impressive glass and iron-domed roof. Enjoy a free afternoon to explore Milan at your leisure or add an excursion to Verona, famous for being the setting of Shakespeare's "Romeo and Juliet."

**05 PISA ▶ CINQUE TERRE ▶ PISA**

Brighten your day with today's highlight, **Cinque Terre** – an enchanting cluster of villages perched on the rugged peaks along the Italian Riviera coastline. Enter this UNESCO World Heritage area by train to visit two of its most beautiful villages: **Vernazza** and **Manarola**. Immerse yourself in the charming atmosphere of these remote Italian seaside villages, which boast picturesque clusters of dwellings perched precariously on the coastline. Afterward, proceed to the famous city of Pisa and explore its attractions, including the **Leaning Tower**, the Duomo, and the Baptistry in the **Square of Miracles**.

**06 PISA ▶ SAN GIMIGNANO ▶ ROME**  
Breakfast  
Travel through the beautiful Tuscan countryside to discover the charming medieval town of **San Gimignano**, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1990. Venture to the center

of town to view its **Piazza del Duomo**, surrounded by medieval towers and the 13th-century city walls. You may add an excursion to Civita di Bagnoregio, a stunning hilltop village in Italy known as 'Italy's dying' town.
