## 01 HOME ▶ FRANKFURT

Meals on Board

Assemble at the airport and take-off to **Frankfurt**, a major financial hub in Germany.

## 02 FRANKFURT ▶ ROTHENBURG ▶ NUREMBERG

Dinner – 3 course Nuremberg Sausages

Your first stop is the famed **Rothenburg** ob der Tauber, a German town in northern Bavaria renowned for its medieval architecture. Wander along the half-timbered houses lined along the narrow, cobbled lanes of the **Old Town** and the surrounding town walls that boast well-preserved gate houses and towers with a covered walkway at the top. Next up is **St. James Church**, home to an intricate, late Gothic altarpiece by woodcarver Tilman Riemenschneider, while the **Town Hall's** 52-metre-high tower affords visitors with spectacular views. Thereafter, proceed to **Nuremberg**.

## 03 NUREMBERG ▶ MUNICH

Breakfast, Dinner – 3 course Pork Knuckle with Beer

Be blown away at first sight of the **Imperial Castle** of Nuremberg, one of the former residences of the Holy Roman Emperors which has been around for a thousand years. Then, check out the Renaissance artist **Albrecht Dürer's House**, before heading to the bustling square **Hauptmarkt** to find the imposing **Frauenkirche** and the gilded **Schöner Brunnen** fountain – the latter is said to grant a wish to those who turn the golden ring on the railings three times. Head to Munich to enjoy some retail therapy at

**Ingolstadt Village**, where you'll find a range of designer brands at discounted prices of up to 60% off.

Note: Ingolstadt Village is closed on Public Holidays and Sundays. Visit is subject to change without prior notice in the event of unforeseen circumstances.

## 04 MUNICH ▶ FUSSEN

Breakfast, Dinner

This morning, you may wish to join an optional excursion to Zugspitze, the highest mountain in Germany looming at 2962m above sea level. Make your way to the town of **Füssen** to see the **Neuschwanstein Castle** (view of the exterior only). One of the most popular castles in Europe, Neuschwanstein was built as a place of retreat for King Ludwig II and transformed into a medieval dream world filled with all of his longing and ideals. Spend the night in the enchanting town. *Optional: Mt. Zugspitze*

## 05 FUSSEN ▶ ST. GALLEN ▶ LUCERNE

Breakfast, Dinner - Swiss Fondue

Today we will cross into Switzerland and drop by the lovely town, **St. Gallen**. Explore the **St. Gallen Abbey District**, which has been listed a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site since 1983. Visit the city's landmark Baroque cathedral and its unrivalled medieval masterpiece, the **Abbey Library of Saint Gall** – one of the oldest and most beautiful libraries in the world. Travel on to **Lucerne**, make a stop at the **Old Chapel Bridge** – the oldest wooden bridge in Switzerland – and the **Lion Monument**. Enjoy a stroll through the **Old Town** with its unspoiled buildings covered with colourful murals.

## 06 LUCERNE

Today, spend the day at leisure to explore this charming town on your own. Alternatively, you may choose to go on an optional journey to Mt Titlis at your own expense.

## 07 LUCERNE ► BLACK FOREST ► HEIDELBERG

Breakfast, Chinese Dinner  
Delve into a world of legends and fairy tales as you enter the enchanting **Black Forest** in Germany. Spend some time for some quick shopping before continuing to **Frankfurt**. Take a turn in Frankfurt's charming **Römerberg** and **Altstadt**.
