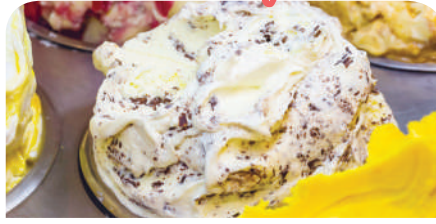
# Hidden Gems for the Foodies

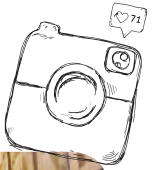


## Devon Café

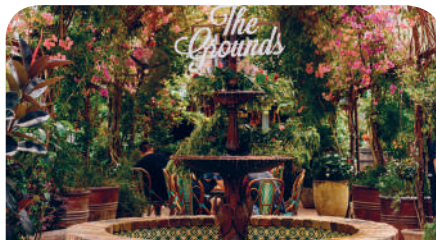


## Paddington Reservoir Gardens

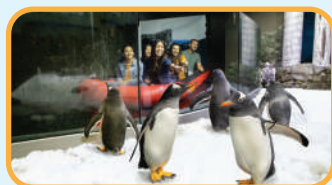
