Witness the iconic landmarks such as the bustling City Hall Square, the legendary Hans Christian Andersen Statue, and the majestic Christiansborg Palace. Pay a visit to The Little Mermaid sculpture, which draws inspiration from the beloved fairytale, and admire the ethereal Gefion Fountain. If traffic conditions permit, we'll also make an extra stop at Nyhavn, allowing you to capture picturesque photos of this charming canal district. Your day concludes with an overnight stay in Odense.

03 ODENSE ► AARHUS ► OVERNIGHT CRUISE

Breakfast, Dinner Depart from Odense and set your course for Aarhus, where you'll explore Den Gamle By. This remarkable attraction showcases a captivating assortment of meticulously preserved old Danish townhouses. As the day unfolds, prepare to embark on an Overnight Cruise that will transport you to Bergen, a charming city nestled along the southwestern coast of Norway.

04 OVERNIGHT CRUISE ► BERGEN ► HARDANGERFJORD

Breakfast, Dinner Upon arrival in Bergen, embark on an immersive City tour. Experience the lively Fish Market, wander the historic Bryggen district, and take in the city's panoramic views aboard the Fløibanen Funicular. Then, journey onward to the Hardangerfjord region, home to Norway's second-longest fjord, which spans 179 kilometers and reaches depths of 900 meters.

05 HARDANGERFJORD ► VOSS ► SKEI Breakfast, Dinner

Travel to the captivating region of **Voss**, where you have the option to embark on a scenic train journey aboard the Flåm Railway. This extraordinary train ride offers

an unparalleled visual feast of serene rivers, deep ravines, cascading waterfalls, and mountain farms seemingly clinging to the snow-capped peaks. Explore the UNESCO World Heritage-listed **Nærøyfjord** on a quiet and emission-free **Fjord Cruise** between Flåm and Gudvangen. The panoramic view of the beautiful and untouched fjord landscape is a memory for life!



06 SKEI ► GEIRANGER ► OPPLAND COUNTY

Breakfast, Dinner Embark on a scenic cruise through the UNESCO World Heritage Site, Geirangerfjord. Witness the iconic Knivsflå Waterfalls, known as the Seven Sisters, between Geiranger and Hellesylt. Travel the challenging Ørnevegen, also known as Eagle Road with its eleven hairpin bends and stone-supported mountain roads. Capture the stunning views from the Trollstigen Platform before settling in Oppland County for a tranquil night in the serene Norwegian countryside.

Note: The Trollstigen platform is not available during the autumn and winter months. Typically, the road remains open from late May until October, but please be aware that these dates can vary depending on the season.

07 OPPLAND COUNTY LILLEHAMMER OSLO Breakfast, Dinner

Make a visit to Lillehammer, and have the opportunity to view the city's major landmark, Lysgårdsbakkene Ski Jumping

site. Continuing to **Oslo**, the capital, our exploration begins at **City Hall**, showcasing Norwegian history. Admire the **Royal Palace** exterior, appreciate its neoclassical beauty, and explore the remarkable **Vigeland**

Sculpture Park, displaying over 200 life-sized sculptures by sculptor Gustav Vigeland

08 OSLO > REYKJAVIK Breakfast, Dinner

Breakfast, Dinner Embark on a flight to Reykjavik, Iceland, a popular destination. Begin with a rejuvenating experience in the renowned Blue Lagoon geothermal spa, known for its therapeutic waters amid striking black basalt lava. Continue your exploration, pass by Hofdi House and the distinctive Hallgrímskirkja Church with its prominent Leifur Eiriksson statue.

Note: If Blue Lagoon is inaccessible, we'll offer Sky Lagoon as an alternative.





09 REYKJAVIK

Breakfast, Dinner Today, we explore the Golden Circle, revealing Iceland's captivating natural wonders. Our journey begins at the Geysir Geothermal area, offering a glimpse of the incredible Strokkur geyser soaring up to 30 meters. Then, we head to Gullfoss, known as the Golden Falls, and finally, to the historically and geologically significant Thingvellir National





Park. Here, witness the gradual drift apart of the American and Eurasian tectonic plates, a marvel of nature.

10 REYKJAVIK Breakfast

Spend your day at leisure, relishing the freedom to explore at your own pace or opt for an exhilarating optional adventure called "Into the Glacier." This thrilling excursion will transport you to the unspoiled

wilderness and pristine landscapes of Langiokull. Iceland's second-largest glacier.

REYKJAVIK ▶ **STOCKHOLM**

Breakfast, Dinner Embark on a flight to Stockholm, Sweden's captivating capital. Visit Vasa Museum, housing the incredible Vasa ship. This 17th-century vessel sank in Stockholm's waters in 1628, spent 333 years submerged, and is now a unique relic. Afterward, wander through the Old Town, featuring the Cathedral and the Royal Palace.

Note: If circumstances prevent us from visiting the Vasa Museum, it will be substituted with an entry to City Hall, or will be replaced with alternative arrangements.
