# the wonders of asia

## Busan, South Korea

From Busan, venture to the coastal town of Gyeongju, described as “the museum without walls,” and scale the ancient steps of the Bulguksa Temple — a masterful rendition of Buddhist culture. Then tour tombs of kings and court officials dotting the landscapes of Tumuli Park.



## Okinawa, Japan

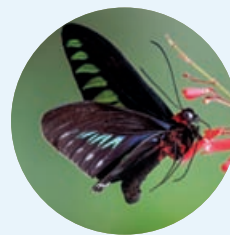
# cruise highlights

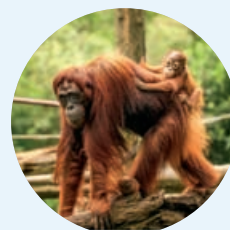
Visit Wat Trimitr and marvel at its massive gold Buddha before you enjoy the Grand Palace and behold the spectacular Emerald Buddha.
